Runners on Their Marks for Aycliffe 10K Race
Runners of all ages and levels of experience will be hitting the streets this month for the annual Aycliffe 10K road race. COUNCIL WEBSITE REVEALS OPINIONS ON HOT TOPICS

Visitors to a north east council internet website are helping the authority keep its finger on the pulse of public opinion on a wide range of 'burning issues'. Every month, Durham County Council posts a 'quick poll' question on its website seeking the public's views on a wide range of topics, both local and national. And Council Leader Ken Manton said the results have been both "helpful and revealing."

"The quick poll questions reflect topical issues which are in the news or of widespread concern and are often submitted by members of the public themselves," he added.

"They have touched on matters ranging from Council Tax reform, gambling laws and drinking hours to smoking in public places and identity cards.

"A response rate of between 1,000 and 2,000 votes is not uncommon and bearing in mind that previous MORI public opinion polls we have commissioned to determine public attitudes in the County have used a random sample of around 1,400 people - albeit more 'scientifically' selected - we believe the results provide us with a reasonable snapshot of how people view various issues of the day."

The County Council's internet website, which has been judged one of the top 20 local government sites in the UK, can be found on www.durham.gov.uk

"The results of our quick polls provide us with a helpful and revealing insight into the way people view issues which affect their everyday lives, and we would welcome suggestions for future poll questions," said Coun Manton.

Local Trainer Sets the Pattern for Success

South West Durham Training Ltd in Newton Aycliffe will run the only recognised pattern and model making apprenticeship in the North East as the industry looks to attract new recruits to meet a growing order book.
There was once a substantial base of pattern makers working in the region's foundries but numbers gradually declined as work moved overseas. As numbers dropped so too did training opportunities with fewer and fewer young people entering the profession.
But now, with an ageing workforce, the industry needs new skills to meet a growing order book and S W Durham Training has stepped in to deliver a vocational training programme geared to the needs of employers that will help to develop the next generation of craftsmen.
The Apprenticeship has been developed by S W Durham in partnership with the Patternmakers and Mould Manufacturers Association (PMMMA), the Institute of Cast Metal Engineers and several local pattern makers. Training will be delivered by Casting Technology International (CTI) in Sheffield, which runs the UK's only other recognised Apprenticeship in the Midlands.
"Patternmaking is part of the North East's industrial heritage but, as local companies keep telling us, there is a real gap in training that needs to be addressed," explains Bob Waller, chief executive of S W Durham Training.
"There's no recognised training scheme - and hasn't been since many of the big foundries stopped running Apprenticeships - so very few young people are entering the profession. If the industry is to sustain itself then clearly this needs to change."

The new course, which will take between two and four years to complete at intermediate and advanced level, will take Apprentices through a range of core manufacturing, engineering and IT practices with Apprentices working towards NVQ and City and Guilds Level 2 and 3 qualifications. Training will then be tailored to the needs of the pattern and model making industry and will include preparing sand moulds and cores for casting and using wood for pattern and model making. There will also be several modules in Computer Aided Design and Computer Integrated Engineering which have increasingly replaced the traditional manual skills of the pattern maker whose main material was wood.
Interpat – a precision pattern and tooling company based in Newton Aycliffe since 1980 – is one of the companies hoping to benefit from the Apprenticeship.
"With some of the major foundries outsourcing jobs abroad there's been an obvious decline in training opportunities," explains Stan Wise, Interpat's commercial manager. "Our existing workforce has an average age of 45 and it has been increasingly difficult to recruit younger tradesman with the skills we need. The logical solution to this was to create a new Apprenticeship of our own.
"Patternmaking has changed significantly in recent years with the development of computers and the new Apprenticeship will combine IT skills with the traditional mould making skills of the patternmaker."

The Council is not telling you that they have the money to carry on with home improvements without having to borrow large amounts of money.

All privatisation does is create good jobs for the chosen few as seen from company balance sheets.

The Chief Executive of Sunderland Housing Company doubled his salary to £142,000 a year and his partner and a nephew are directors at £90,000 a year.

The council workers who transferred jobs are not always taken on by the new companies at their present rates and only 35% of workers were still earning what they were with the Council.

Talk of tenants being on the board and looking after tenants interests is rubbish! Boards are governed by Company

Law and what is discussed is confidential and not for public scrutiny or discussion. Council tenants will find that all the housing security they had with a council tenancy disappears when a private company buys and controls Council housing.
