ROMAN HELP TSUNAMI VICTIMS

Avcliffe based Roman Limited, the UK's leading shower manufacturer, is raising vital funds for a Children's home in Sri Lanka, which was left devastated by the Asian Tsunami. Roman has decided to adopt the charity in this the firm's 20th birthday year.

The North East coastal town of Mullaitivu was crushed by the huge tidal waves that hit the region back in December, leaving a trail of devastation in its wake. It was Aloy and Juliet's | speech of the 23rd June detailed knowledge of the area that persuaded Roman to take this project on.

Aloy said: "We are thrilled that Roman will help us to rebuild the lives of these girls, many of whom lost everything in the Tsunami. The North East coast of Sri Lanka bore the brunt of this natural disaster leaving communities completely shattered." Roman's managing director Gerry Osborne said, "Most people have been affected by the Tsunami, in one way or another. We want to raise enough cash for these

children, who have already lost their parents, to have a decent standard of life at least and help them to recover from their terrible ordeal. We are sure people will continue with their generosity by donating to the fund." Over the next year Roman staff will raise money by holding a series of events on a continuous basis such as completing the Three Peaks Challenge, a 5-a-side soccer tournament, "Stars in Their Eyes" style Karaoke, cricket matches and numerous other events.




