

On Saturday 9th July, Newton Aycliffe Library was privileged to welcome the famous author, Anne Fine, to their Junior Book Club.

Anne is a distinguished author, with over forty books to her credit including Madame Doubtfire. She is twice winner of the Carnegie Medal, Britain's most coveted children's literature award, and has also won the Guardian Children's Literature Award, the Whitbread Children's Novel Award twice, and a Smarties Prize. She won the Publishing News Children's Author of the Year Award in 1990 and again in 1993. In 2001 she was named Children's Laureate.

Sixteen reading group members (plus parents and borrowers) were engrossed by Anne's relaxed approach. She answered lots of questions from "how she became an author" to "where her inspiration comes from". She was a breath of fresh air and encouraged the children to read as much as possible now and leave the writing for later.


