Readers will remember that, a while ago, there was alarm that the Boundaries Commission (which was redrawing the Parliamentary constituency boundaries) might split Great Aycliffe between two constituencies. The Boundaries Commission

between two constituencies. The Boundaries Commission has now reached the second stage of its consultation, which is to publish all submissions received, and to invite comments on those submissions.

To be fair, this is a bit of a 'nothing' stage. The Commission has not yet published any revised proposals, and I cannot see many people being bothered to trawl through the thousands of responses merely to make comments on other people's comments.

The next REAL stage of the review will come later this year when the Commission publishes its revised proposals, and gives us eight weeks to respond.

For the moment, however, if you were one of those people who intended to respond but never got round to it, this current stage does give you another chance to have your say after all.



## HELP SCHEME IS AT HAND FOR YOU TO SWITCH TO DIGITAL TV

NEWTON NEWS READERS URGED TO WATCH OUT FOR INFORMATION PACKS



Older and disabled people in Newton are being urged to look out for Switchover Help Scheme information packs which are landing on their doorsteps this week.

The Switchover Help Scheme is writing directly to people that are eligible for help and most eligible people in Newton will receive their first letter and information pack through the post any day now.

The pack, which is also available in a range of alternative formats, explains all the options available to eligible people and contains important information on how they can get help to convert one TV to digital in time for switchover which begins 12 September. Most people will be asked to

Most people will be asked to pay £40 towards the standard option of help which includes:

- Easy to use equipment to convert one set
- An approved installer to supply and install the necessary equipment, and
   A 12 month aftercare
- A 12 month aftercare service including a free helpline

The service is free for people who are eligible and who also receive pension credit income support, income-based jobseeker's allowance or income-related employment and support allowance. Other options and equipment are also available at an extra cost and are

outlined in the information pack.

People are eligible for the

- Help Scheme if they are:
   Aged 75 or over, or
   Have lived in a care home for six months or more, or
- Get (or could get):
  o Disability Living
  Allowance (DLA), or
  Attendance or Constant
  Attendance Allowance, or
  Mobility supplement, or are
  registered blind or partially

sighted

On 12 September, the Tyne Tees region will begin to switch to digital. Everyone will need to convert their TV to digital by that time if they are to continue watching their favourite programmes. Emma Speed, Help Scheme Manager for the Tyne Tees TV region said: ""The message we want to give eligible people is that there is no need to worry because help is available. If you someone you know entitled to help from the Help Scheme, then all you have to do is watch out for information pack which will be sent any day now and either give us a call free on 0800 408 7654 or return your completed form by post to get the help you are entitled

The BBC run Switchover Help Scheme has been designed around the needs of older and disabled people. Equipment has been chosen to be easy to use, and contact centre, delivery staff and installers have all been trained to understand and respect older and disabled people. All installers are vetted, carry identification and will never call without having made an appointment. People can find out more information about the Switchover Help Scheme from their packs or by visiting helpscheme.co.uk. To check their switchover date and options for getting digital TV, they can use the Digital UK postcode checker at digitaluk.co.uk

Analogue signals will be switched off in two stages. The dates for switchover in this area are:

Stage 1 switch off will take place on 12th September. Stage 2 complete switch off will take place on 26th

September

## WINSTON CHURCHILL AWARD FOR LOCAL THERAPIST

Local man, Garreth Murrell, has been awarded a Winston Churchill Travelling Fellowship. Travelling Fellowships are awarded to British citizens from all walks of life to travel overseas and bring back knowledge and best practice to benefit others in their UK professions and communities.

Gareth will travel to the USA and Canada to research the use of Neuro Linguistic Programming or NLP with Veterans who are suffering with Post-Traumatic Stress Disorder (PTSD) and other combat related issues.

The enhanced knowledge and renewed enthusiasm will directly benefit his colleagues, friends and family and he will be able to train others skills to develop further new skills through his example.

To quote one of the Fellows: "There really is no other learning opportunity like it and it has revitalised my creativity and enthusiasm."

NLP looks at the way we think and process our thoughts (Neuro), the language patterns we use (Linguistic) and our behaviours (Programming) and how these interact to

have a positive (or negative) effect on us as individuals.

NLP was developed in the USA in the early seventies. Around this time the Vietnam war was at its peak and it was found that some of the techniques being developed in NLP therapy was useful for veterans returning and suffering from PTSD.

The purpose of Gareth's trip is to research the best uses of NLP techniques currently being used with veterans from conflicts such as Vietnam, Iraq and Afghanistan. It is also to share experiences with working with veterans.

Gareth set up and now runs the UK charity Veterans at Ease after suffering from PTSD serving in the British Army for ten years. He was involved in operations in Northern Ireland and was one of the first soldiers into Bosnia in 1992 with the Cheshire Regiment.

Since the charity was founded in 2010 eighteen veterans and 4 of their wives have been helped to deal with the devastating effects of PTSD and other combat stress related issues.

This is a great opportunity, not only to increase my



knowledge around this very emotive subject but is also a fantastic opportunity to meet new people, make friends and build international relationships.



## **DURHAM COUNCIL SUBMIT BID FOR BINS CASH**

The County Council has announced it is to apply for Government cash to further boost recycling rates. It is to formally express an interest in receiving funding through the Government's Weekly Collection Support Scheme.
The authority is currently in

the process of harmonising collection arrangements across the seven former district council areas and introducing alternate weekly collections throughout the

county. The system, which sees waste collected one week and recycling the next, has been operation in the Derwentside area for some time, where it has helped increase recycling and reduce the amount of waste sent to landfill.

A waste and recycling survey carried out in December 2010 showed that 74 per cent of residents in the Derwentside area felt the service had improved since alternate weekly collections were introduced.

The changes are expected to save the authority in excess of £9m and potentially up to £12m over the five-year period to 2017.

The council is expressing an interest in Government

funding to provide a weekly collection of segregated food waste on a trial basis. The money available would only fund collections in part of the county.
The food collected would

be recycled at an anaerobic digestion plant in the county

to provide electricity.

If the bid is successful, the food collection service would be provided on a trial basis in part of the county

Terry Collins, Durham Council's director County of neighbourhood services,

said: "The move to alternate weekly collections will have significant benefits for both residents and the public, through major financial savings, an increase in recycling and a reduction in waste sent to landfill. "However, a

separate collection of food waste would further increase our recycling performance, would remove biowaste from the waste stream and reduce treatment costs as well as providing a clean source of electricity generation in the county.




