

# A GOVERNMENT ACTIVELY **DESTROYING THE NORTH-EAST**

#### by Town Councillor John D. Clare

On 17th April, local MPs - including our own Phil Wilson MP - secured a Wilson MP – secured a debate on the north-east economy; they had lots to criticise the government about:

DRACONIAN CUTS in benefits – JSA, ESA, LDA, working tax credits, housing benefit etc. – will affect the north-east disproportionately, because we have a high proportion of people on benefits – 37% of the people in Aycliffe are 'workless'. These cuts represent a significant cut in purchasing power which will affect the region's economy. 2. SAVAGE CUTS in local (£125million

cuts over four years) and the proposed restoration of the Business Rate (which in County Durham could cut a further £80million a year from the County Council's budget) will further damage

the economy.

3. A FURTHER BLOW to the north-east is the government's change in how it allocates NHS funding. Hitherto, regional funding has been based on the level of deprivation; from now on, it will be based upon how long people live. This decision will consciously move money away from the poorer areas (such as the north-east) where people are unhealthier and die younger, and give it

to richer areas where people are healthier and live longer.

4. THE GOVERNMENT'S **DECISION** to press ahead for regional pay differentials

which will see public sector workers in the northeast earning much less for the same job than their equivalents in the south – threatens to decimate our region. Falling public sector wages will in their turn drive down private sector wages. Regionally negotiated pay will wreck national negotiating structures, weaken unions, and reinforce the 'bright flight' already tempting our able young away from the region. Most of all, it will take £billions out of a north-east economy already stagnating from lack of demand.

5. IN THE MEANTIME,

I fear the north-east is set to suffer from the government's housing policies. I certainly don't expect busloads of migrants to start turning up with their suitcases. But I do suspect that the rent differential will gradually encourage a 'housing creep' effect as families are forced to move northwards seeking cheaper housing. The danger is that we end up with a 'Made-In-Chelsea' zone inand-around the metropolis, with menial and service workers hidden away in lodging houses, and their along with the families disabled and unemployed coping as best they can in the boondocks of the north, outof-sight-and-out-of-mind.

6. MEANWHILE, this Tory government is doing nothing to stimulate business in the north-east. It has abolished One North East, lost £129 million of European funding for the region, and allocated a paltry £10 million to local enterprise partnerships.

London and the southeast accounts for 84% of the government's planned infrastructure spending, compared with only 6% for the three northern regions and an unbelievably minuscule 0.04% for the north-east.

Thus, whilst it is taking £billions out of our northeast economy in benefit cuts, reduced Council funding and regional pay arrangements, the government is utterly failing to direct back any funding to stimulating

growth.

7. THIS SITUATION is exacerbated by the fact that, just to the north, the devolved Scots government is pursuing a vigorous policy to attract business and industry. has already secured Amazon and Gamesa at the northeast's expense. Given this,

the decision to locate the Green Investment Bank in Edinburgh is a body-blow for the region. Things are especially dire

for Newton Aycliffe, which intra-regionally finds itself on the border of the Teesside Enterprise Zone, which includes Darlington and extends right to the edge of our industrial estate. Thus we face an uphill struggle trying to attract industry to come to our Business Park, because you can get a grant if you set up just a few miles away. David Cameron warned us

before the 2010 election that he intended to target the north-east, and he has been as good as his word. The southeast has got fed up of what-it-sees-as continually bailing us out, has decided that it wants to keep the money it earns IN the south-east, wants to stop all this 'redistribution' to the poor and the regions ... and has elected a government which stated explicitly that was what it would do if it came to power.

The frightening thing is that barely a fifth of the government's planned cuts have yet been implemented; there is worse to come.

### SMALL GROUPS CANNOT ACT ALONE UNDER NEIGHBOURHOOD PLAN

Dear Sir,

I write to correct an error made in a letter recently about 'Neighbourhood Development Orders' (NDOs).

Contrary to the opinion expressed in the letter, groups of residents cannot, by the Localism Act, band together to secure an NDO for their immediate community.

The area recognised in the Localism Act as a 'neighbourhood' is exclusively a parish – in our case the whole Parish of Great Aycliffe. The relevant sections in the Act, if you are interested, are 61E, F and G (particularly clauses 61F4 and 61G3b).

It is wonderful that communities are already coming together to discuss what they would wish the Neighbourhood Plan to include for their area. But

the letter was incorrect in its suggestion that a group of residents will be able to prescribe a specific development in their immediate area.

There will indeed be meetings, in each community, to allow local people to say what they would like to see. However, people need to be realistic that community aspirations must ultimately be encompassed within a whole Parish perspective.

The Neighbourhood Development Plan the represents best opportunity in a generation to define the kind of place we wish our town to become. But if we are going to get the most out of the process, we need first to appreciate properly the parameters within which we must work.

Rule 243

DO NOT stop or park:

- near a school entrance

- opposite or within 10 metres (32 feet) of a junction, except in an authorised parking space near the brow of a hill or hump bridge
- opposite a traffic island or (if this would cause an obstruction) another parked vehicle
- where you would force other traffic to enter a

- in front of an entrance to a property
- on a bend


