Rotary Appeal to Help Earthquake Victims

The whole world has been stunned by the loss of life and devastation caused by the earthquake in Japan. Thousands killed and countless families made homeless from the worst quake and tsunami in Japan's history. It is difficult to comprehend the effect of this in the UK which never suffers this type of disaster, but it is equal to half of the population of Newton Aycliffe being wiped out and the whole of the town flattened.

Imagine if everything was swamped by a wave the height of Churchill House. 500,000 people are homeless, 10,000 are missing, thousands swept out to sea, and there are over 3,500 known deaths. The Rotary Shelterbox charity was featured on TV this week as one of the first to be on the scene providing shelter. John Burrows a Newton Aycliffe Rotarian is the Shelterbox co-ordinator for the North East. He reports that 5000 Shelterboxes are being

sent to Japan this week. Each Shelterbox costs £590 and contains: A ten man tent, 10 ground mats, 10 blankets, 10 ponchos, 10 mosquito nets, Multi fuel or wood burning stove, Cooking pans, 10 plates, 10 bowls, 10 mugs, Cutlery, Tool pack, Childrens pack, Water containers and purification filter. Last year alone over 45,000 boxes in total were sent to Haiti, Pakistan and 15 other countries. Today in the world over 500,000 people are sleeping in Shelterbox tents. There are in excess of 500,000 people made homeless by the earthquake and Tsunami in Japan, that is equivalent to twice the population of Newcastle upon Tyne Shelterbox already has a team on the ground in Japan, with some 600 boxes available for distribution, another 5000 boxes have been committed to the


All in all a great effort by Woodham, showcasing the dedication of staff and the blossoming talent of Aycliffe's young people.

disaster. The Rotary Club of Newton Aycliffe have immediately sent £1180 for 2 boxes. Just as we helped Haiti Newtonians are being asked to contribute to an appeal to provide shelter for those Japanese families who have lost everything and have nowhere to live. The town's Rotary Club launched the appeal this week

with the support of our MP and Town Mayor Dorothy Bowman. Our MP Phil Wilson said: "We have all been shocked by the pictures from Japan and the devastation caused by the earthquake and tsunami. The North East of England has strong links with Japan, with about 50 Japanese companies working in the region. Hitachi has selected Newton Aycliffe as the site for their train building plant creating hundreds of jobs. I therefore believe the least we can do is launch an appeal through the Newton Aycliffe Rotary Club and Newton News to raise funds for the victims of the natural disaster in Japan. I welcome the Rotary Club's appeal and hope everyone contributes what they can towards it." Please give generously to help those families in Japan who are suffering so much at this time. A gesture of support from us no matter how small will give them hope and encouragement. Tesco is helping the appeal with collection buckets near the Customer Service area. CUTS FORCE CAB TO HALVE SESSIONS

The Citizens Advice Bureau in Newton Aycliffe will be forced to close its doors for 2 of its 4 sessions from April as a result of cuts to funding. Chief Executive, Pauline Chambers said that due to cuts to our core service funding we are unable to operate the number of advice sessions we currently operate. As from the 4th April the CAB will only be able to operate one drop in gate way advice session each week which will take place on a Tuesday 10am - 1pm. Appointments will be available during these hours with additional appointments on a Tuesday afternoon 1 - 4pm and a Wednesday & Friday morning 10am - 1pm. We will also operate a telephone gateway service on a Friday morning 10am - 1pm. A gateway interview is a short diagnostic interview where a client enquiry will be assessed and an appointment made where necessary to see an adviser or specialist worker. This number to ring is 0844 499 4123 and this line should be answered every Friday morning between 10am - 1pm. However, volunteer advisers may be able to answer calls during other opening hours where possible. Business Development Manager, Donna Stewart is currently discussing the possibility of obtaining

funding from local County Councillors from their Neighbourhood Budgets to keep the Aycliffe CAB offices open another day from April. Mrs Stewart said that although Great Aycliffe Town Council have kindly given a donation of £500 to the service for next year, and any donations we receive are more then welcomed and appreciated, we still need to raise between £7500 to £15,000 per year to fund the cost of a weekly fully staffed advice session. The Great Aycliffe & Midridge Partnership have awarded a grant of £2000 to help fund the cost of the CAB volunteer training program and Managers are thrilled to receive this support as this ensures that new volunteers can be recruited and trained to give advice in their local community in the coming year. The CAB service is always looking for members of the community it serves to train with them as advisers or clerical officers and have a number of roles available for those who want first rate training and on the job experience. YOUTH WORKERS HOPING TO MAKE A DIFFERENCE IN NEWTON AYCLIFFE

The Great Aycliffe and Midridge Partnership (GAMP) is funding two new detached youth workers who will be working across the town to support local youngsters.

The youth workers will work with secondary schools and police to find areas of the town where young people hang out and will be on hand to help them find fun activities they would like to take part in. They will also hold events at schools and clubs to pass on information about activities happening in the local area.

David Stow and Laura Makin took up their posts at the end of February and will be managed by Durham County Council's Positive Activities for Young People team. It's hoped that, by engaging with young people, the project will help to tackle unemployment and anti-social behaviour.

GAMP is backing this project because it meets the partnership's priority to provide activities for young people.

Brian Riley, GAMP coordinator, said: "A key priority for GAMP is

addressing the problem of activities for young people and this project encourages them to take part in sport, youth clubs, music and other positive activities.

"Some youngsters can be extremely hard to reach but hopefully we can work with them to alleviate problems affecting them in the local area."

Diane Major is Delivery Manager for Positive Activities for Young People. She said: "Having two experienced youth workers for Newton Aycliffe is vital for the youngsters of the town, particularly those socially excluded groups who have difficulties accessing services."

The project will run for a year and events for young people will take place at the following locations:

Mondays, Woodham School between 12 and 2pm and Cobblers Hall between 4pm and 6pm.

Wednesdays, Greenfield School between 12 and 2pm and Simpature, Boating Lake, West Ward between 6pm and 8pm.

Newtonian 'Mans' Machine Gun in Afghanistan

A woman from Newton Aycliffe, is toughing it out right on the front line alongside soldiers from D Company, 5 SCOTS Battle Group, to tackle insurgents in Afghanistan.

Corporal Andria Macmurray (31), is a Combat Human Resources Administrator at the tiny patrol base Attal, in Helmand Province. Her job is essential to maintain the manning and pay of the troops and also to ensure that the soldiers get home for their mid tour leave.

In addition to her main job, Andria has to take her turn in manning the machine gun in the watch tower, which defends the base from attack, and act as guard commander. For the majority of her six month tour she has been the only female at Attal, living and working alongside her male compatriots.

She said: "It's quite tough sometimes being the only woman out here. I really miss my family and small things like having a hot bath, getting dressed up and the girly gossip. The blokes have really made me feel part of the team though, and we all get on really well."

The road that runs past patrol base Attal is essential for the surrounding communities to transport their produce to market and for big trade convoys to reach the towns. D Company 5 SCOTS are providing the crucial security in the area to keep this life line open.

Andria, who joined the army at 16 said: "We are really gaining the trust of the local people and they come to us

This is her eighth tour of duty. She has previously deployed to Croatia, Bosnia, Kosovo, Iraq and now Afghanistan. As well as coming first in a cross country running tournament in Cyprus, Andria has also climbed Table Mountain in South Africa and sailed around the Greek islands with the Army.

Andria hopes to transfer to the Royal Alexandria Nursing Corps, saying: "I want to contribute and really help people where I can."


