Schoolchildren Visit Aycliffe Steel Factory



Pupils from Fishburn Primary School took time out to visit Finley Structures in Newton Aycliffe, to see the process of raw steel being made into a full structure.

The youngsters were first given a 3D demonstration by a structural engineer, showing them a virtual construction on screen, before going on to the shop floor to see the steel being fabricated by the most advanced computer numerically controlled (CNC) machinery.

They then saw steel being erected at Durham County Council's £10m North East Technology Park (NETPark) development, near Sedgefield. Their teacher Danny Eason said: "The whole afternoon covered maths, science and art, but also demonstrated team skills and people working together, so it was hugely beneficial for the children and they thoroughly enjoyed it.

The children will produce a short film about their visit for

their social media site. The visit was a joint-venture by Willmott Dixon, the firm responsible for building the science park at NETPark, and one of their major sub-contractors Finley Structures.

John Finley, managing director of the family-run Aycliffe-based firm, said: "Both Finley and Willmott Dixon are committed to involving the community on our projects and this was a fantastic reflection of that. The children enjoyed a very informative and practical lesson, both in our factory and on-site, and they were extremely responsive and inquisitive.

Finley Structures was formed in 2000, and the family-owned company moved to its current location at Aycliffe Business Park in 2003. The company provides structural steelwork to the construction industry, and in 2008 invested more than £1m in its production facility to manufacture in excess of 200 tonnes of steel per week.

CAR ACCIDENT WITNESSES WANTED

The Police are appealing for witnesses to a road traffic collision which occurred on Burn Lane, Newton Aycliffe at the mini roundabout at the junction of Westmorland Way at approximately 11.20am on Friday 1st April 2011.

We the electorate ought to use this opportunity to show our hunger for change. Say YES to AV, and say no to corrupt MP's, no to free duck houses, and no to unelected positions in the House of Lord's. Silt Removal from Burn to Prevent Flooding

Officers from the Environment Agency will be scooping out around ten tonnes of silt from The Burn in Newton Aycliffe to help reduce the risk of flooding to the town.

The Operations Delivery Team, which carries out the Environment Agency's work on the ground, has brought in an excavator to help them with the task this week.

Woodham Burn is at risk of flooding 438 properties, and the Environment Agency has assessed the watercourse to see what can be done to reduce the likelihood.

Operations Leader Gerald Lee said: "The start of the warmer weather means the start of our summer maintenance on the region's waterways.

"This ranges from removing silt, cutting the grass on flood defence banks, keeping an eye on the weeds growing in the water to removing fallen trees and obstructions.

"We carry out work depending on whether there is a risk of flooding and tailor the maintenance so that it is appropriate not only to the issue but to the wildlife and the wider environment."

In Newton Aycliffe, removal of the silt will help water to flow more easily and the team will also be removing a tree which is in danger of falling in to Woodham Burn and blocking the flow of the Burn under the A167 Bridge.
