

OUR MP SEEKS YOUR VIEWS ON WIND FARM

Eon are proposing a wind farm between Newton Aycliffe and the A1M. The number of turbines range between 25 and 45. If the number is more than 26 it will be the largest in England.

Wind farms are very controversial at the best of times, but the wind farm envisaged by Eon is huge. Each turbine could be three times the height of the Angel of the North.

There are several wind

farm applications going forward at the present time in the area, but the one planned by Eon is by far the largest if it goes ahead. This will not only impact on the landscape of Newton Aycliffe, but also on Chilton, Mordon and Bradbury.

We all understand the need for renewable energy and County Durham is well on the way to reaching its 2020 renewable energy target long before that date. In my view, wind farms are acceptable as along as they do not dominate the local landscape. If all the applications going forward are accepted I believe that is exactly what will happen.

I raised the matter with the Prime Minister last week in the House of Commons. He has arranged a meeting for me with the Planning Minister to see what consultation local communities can expect because of the massive nature of the proposed wind farm.

The Prime Minister said that the installation of wind farms should lead to financial gain for the area and I want to explore with Eon and the Planning Minister exactly what that means.

People may feel that compensation paid to the local community or residents may be sufficient for the imposition on the landscape, but hosting the largest wind farm in England should mean significant compensation.

Wind farms are controversial, so I would like to hear your views on the possibility of the largest wind farm in England on our doorstep. 

People work hard to buy homes away from areas where had behaviour exists I know of a large £250,000 house which has been let to a regular turnover of problem families who have been expelled from other towns.

None have ever worked to live in such grand surroundings, yet they never cut the grass or keep the property in good order. I wonder if the Editor would be happy if his home was next door to such a family? Does he have opinions on people who avoid work? I know good workers who got on the property ladder to buy their home only to find others in their street who do not work, live on benefits and have the same quality home.

I also know of people who have seen how easy it is and took the same route. Why should they work when everything is available to them without any effort?

In Manchester someone had the idea that if you move bad tenants from Moss Side into good areas they would become better tenants by following good examples. In fact the opposite happened and smaller pockets of Moss Side has now spread throughout the city.

I hope this letter highlights my concern that people

who work hard to live in BW nicely kept areas deserve consideration. The belief that all people who rent property are bad tenants is obviously wrong, but you must accept that a lot of people who rent do not care about their neighbours or the houses they occupy.

Name & address supplied Ed: We have to remember that some tenants through no fault of their own cannot work and have to rely on benefits. Those that can work and won't, are soon to be penalised by new government initiatives.

More than a Blot on the Landscape

As we face the proposed 45-turbine wind-farm, we will no doubt be told that they are environmentally imperative. A wind power turbine, states the website of renewable energy trade association RenewableUK, saves each year 2,000 tonnes of carbon dioxide (CO2), 'the key greenhouse gas culprit'.

Are wind turbines any use?

But will wind turbines help the government as it seeks to cut our CO2 emissions by 336 million tonnes by 2050? How much, relatively, is 2,000 tonnes of CO2?

It is not very much.

It represents the amount of CO2 produced by 14 return air flights to New York (there are 37 flights from London to New York every day).

A wind turbine saves less CO2 over its entire lifetime than the lorries on our roads produce in a single day.

In the meantime, production of the cement and steel used to build a wind turbine creates going on for 4,000 tonnes of CO2, so a wind turbine has to work for two years before it 'pays back' the CO2 created in its own construction.

And – because the wind does not blow consistently, of course – we have to keep traditional power stations online and available for when the wind is not blowing. Since these are used intermittently, they are therefore not run at maximum efficiency, and thus produce proportionately more CO2 ... there is a strong argument that building wind farms actually results in more CO2 than if we had simply kept a coal-powered generator running full-time at maximum efficiency!

'ROCs' and the Renewable Energy racket.

According to Wikipedia there are 3.153 wind turbines in the UK with 5,204 Megawatts (MW) of capacity. A further 2,500 MWworth are being built, 6,000 MW more have planning consent and some 9,000 MW are awaiting planning approval.

Why, if wind turbines are so useless at reducing CO2, are they so prevalent?

The government has to meet a Renewable Energy target, and needs to encourage suppliers to use more renewable energy.

To do this, it issues one ROC (Renewable Energy Certificate) for every megawatt hour (MWh) of green energy a company supplies. Electricity suppliers are given a target of ROCs they need to be able to produce by the end of the year. If they fail to produce enough ROCs, they are fined for the shortfall. Electricity companies, therefore, are interested in buying ROCs, which can fetch up to £47 each on the open market.

It is this subsidy which makes wind turbines an attractive investment. The average turbine generates power worth about £150,000 a year, but can earn subsidies worth up to a further £200,000. One of Britain's most effective wind farms. Burradale in the Shetlands, for example, has two turbines which generated 7,194MWh in 2010, bringing in £345,000, on top of the money earned from selling the electricity.

Meanwhile, since the transition cables on the National Grid have insufficient capacity to transfer the power around the country, wind farms in Scotland are making too much electricity and had recently to be closed down for a day - for which they were paid even more than they get when they are working.

So now we know why wind farms are so popular. Not because they are a successful ecological alternative, but because they offer $somebody-for\ a\ relatively\ modest\ outlay-the\ opportunity\ to\ be$ part of a multi-billion pound bonanza. A bonanza for which we, the electricity consumers, are paying. A national rip-off

We could save as much CO2 as a wind turbine by insulating 1,400 homes. At a one-off cost of £1.2 million, this would cost us about a third of what we pay for a wind turbine over its lifetime, and would actually SAVE us money by reducing our electricity bills. Wind farms do not help the environment, only big business. They are not just a blot on the landscape – they are a national rip-off.

We ought abolish the subsidies and see how many are built when they have to produce electricity in a normal competitive commercial market.



FAIRNESS RESTORED TO HOUSING BENEFIT SYSTEM

New Housing Benefit rules come into force today bringing fairness back to the Local Housing Allowance system and cutting the cost of the Housing Benefit bill which has been rising continuously for a decade. From today the Coalition Government will cap Housing Benefits for private sector tenants from a staggering £104,000 in some cases to an absolute maximum of £20,800 a year for a four

bedroom property.
The reforms will help put an end to the rapid growth seen in private sector rents and will lead to fewer people being put off work because they fear losing their generous housing benefits.

Iain Duncan Smith, Secretary of State for Work and Pensions said:

"The failure to reform Housing Benefit has left us in the absurd situation where some benefit claimants could claim over £100,000 a year to live in large houses in expensive areas. This is unacceptable when hard working individuals and families are struggling either to find affordable private rents or pay their mortgages. "Even after the reforms.

Housing Benefit will be able to meet rents of £20,800 a year so there is no reason why anyone should be left without a home. With a massive deficit, tough choices have to be made – but we have pushed ahead with these changes in record time to bring fairness back to the system so that hard working families no longer have to subsidise people living in properties they themselves could not afford.

"Our Discretionary Housing Payment Fund will provide a safety net for those who need it, with an additional £190m being invested over four years to smooth the transition.

The measures coming into force today apply to new claimants. Existing claimants will be protected at their Local Housing Allowance rate for up to nine months from the date their claim is reviewed by their local authority. This will allow claimants time to adjust to any reduction in Housing Benefit entitlement and in practice means many existing claimants will not be affected until after January 2012.

And to help implement the changes Ministers have temporarily extended the discretion of local authorities to make direct payments to landlords in return for lowering their rents to affordable levels - aimed at allowing more claimants being able to secure new tenancies or stay in their existing homes and that landlord's will maintain a stable and reliable income. The full measures coming into force today are:

- There will no longer be a five bedroom Local Housing Allowance rate. Weekly Local Housing rates will not exceed £250 for a one bedroom property; £290 for a two bedroom property; £340 for a three bedroom property; £400 for a four bedroom
- property.
 The £15 excess will be removed as soon as the Local Authority reviews a claim Claimants will no longer be able to pocket any excess money after their rent is
- Non-dependants living in households of Housing Benefit claimants will see their deduction increases take effect from April 2011.

• Disabled people with a longterm health condition who need overnight care or live with someone with similar needs, may now be able to claim Housing Benefit for a private rented property which has an additional bedroom

for a non-resident carer.
