Durham County Councils' planning committee have granted permission for major employment generating proposal at the Thyssenkrupp Tallent premises on the Business Park.

The proposal involving a 15,250 square metre extension to the company's existing site, will see a major investment in the area by the engineering company who manufacture distribute and chassis parts to leading manufactures such as Ford, Volvo Land Rover, BMW and Honda.

The company currently employs around 900 staff at its Newton Aycliffe premises which will increase with a further 120 new jobs created as a result of the new development.

A luncheon club for the elderly in Newton Aycliffe is tucking in thanks to funding from Great Aycliffe and Middridge Partnership. (GAMP)

The Area Action Partnership (AAP), one of 14 set up by Durham County Council in 2009, has funded improvements to make access and toilet facilities more wheelchair friendly.

Funding of £7,188 has also been used to upgrade kitchen facilities including the purchase of a dishwasher and work to upgrade the heating and lighting systems.

# FLU JAB REMINDER FOR NORTH EAST **PATIENTS AND CARERS**

With only one month to go until the start of the annual flu vaccination campaign, the region's NHS is reminding all at risk patients and carers to make sure getting their flu jab is top of the to do list in October.

GPs are currently writing out to all eligible patients and carers across the north east to invite them in for their annual flu jab in October and letters will be falling through people's letterboxes over the next few weeks.

If you have recently moved home or changed GP practice and are eligible for the free flu jab then you may need to check with your new practice that you are on their mailing list. This is particularly important for the main carers

of older or disabled people as carers cannot be identified through medical records.

People who need the free flu jab include:

- All pregnant women Anyone aged over 65
- Anyone who lives in a
- residential or nursing home
- Anyone over 6 months with a long term health problem such as: o diabetes
- o a chest problem or breathing difficulties (such as asthma, bronchitis or emphysema)
- o a heart problem
- o kidney disease or liver
- o a neurological condition (such as Parkinson's or motor neurone disease)

o a problem with the spleen

Dr Tricia Cresswell, deputy medical director at NHS North East said: "As people get back to work after the summer break it is important that those who are at risk flu remember to from get their jab as soon as it becomes available in October

to ensure they are protected

(such as sickle cell disease)

or if the spleen has been

or treatment (such as cancer

"If you think you are eligible for a jab and haven't heard from your GP by mid September then the best thing to do is contact your GP practice, check whether you need the jab and ask about making an appointment.
"Over the past few years

we've all seen just how serious flu can be, with people of all ages needing hospital treatment, many in intensive care. We don't want anyone to get ill from something which can be avoided and that's why people should check with their GP sooner rather than later.'

Stocks of vaccines will be arriving at GP surgeries towards the end of September so if you, or your child, fall into one of categories above then please make sure you respond to your invitation letter and book your appointment

# **COMMUNITIES GIVEN PLANNING POWERS**

New powers to give local unprecedented people influence to determine the future of their areas are to be tried out in 36 more areas, unfortunately not in Newton Avcliffe vet! These are among the first to test out "neighbourhood planning" a radical new power being introduced in the Localism Bill, which will give local people a real voice in deciding on new development in their area. For the first time, neighbourhood planning will allow communities to shape their own vision for their community, from deciding the locations of shops, offices and schools to setting standards of design for new housing and protecting green spaces of value to the community. In areas where local

people want to see homes and businesses built. neighbourhood planning will allow communities grant a blanket permission planning for development to go ahead without developers having to make separate applications.

The community has the final say on whether a neighbourhood plan comes into force. If more than 50% of people voting in a local referendum support the plan, then the local planning authority must bring it into force.

Neighbourhood planning is designed to return power to local people and local businesses on planning decisions in contrast to the top-down regional strategies being scrapped by the Government.

Planning Minister Greg

Clark said: "For too long local people have been shut out of the planning process with no real voice to affect decisions about the places where they live. Unpopular regional strategies communities bullied into development and this fuelled resentment growth. towards Neighbourhood planning will hand power back to communities to decide the vision for their area as they see fit, encouraging people to plan positively for their future. This is localism in action and the enthusiasm across the country for neighbourhood planning shows how keen

communities are to get involved."

The 36 areas announced are the next wave of 'front-runners' to test out neighbourhood planning, bringing the total to 126 across the country. Each front runner's local council is being given £20,000 to support work on neighbourhood planning and free advice from planning experts will be available for the local community. Examples of work to get underway include a Town Council preserving cultural heritage and another area concentrating on building affordable housing.

Areas in County Durham are conspicuous by their absence. The nearest to us is North Tyneside and Alnwick!

It begs the question if Newton Aycliffe were one of the fortunate areas to have this power, would the current overwhelming objection to the wind farm be heard? The difficulty could also arise when there is a division of opinion on a particular development - would we have to hold a local referendum?



"We have had rare isolated incidents on deliberate vandalism in our car park. As and when this is brought to our attention we do our very best to identify and support the victim with footage and also liaise with the police.

We do have CCTV operating in our car park which are predominantly static cameras unless our Security Guards manually move the lenses. They do this regulary throughout the day and night and carry out random car park scans to ensure nothing untoward is going on.

I can also confirm that we have 24hr security cover so we are always monitoring the store and car park.

The biggest issue we have had recently is young adults joyriding, especially late at night. We have been working with the police to resolve this and I can confirm that we have had some success in identifying culprits resulting in police involvement. They have also increased their patrols on our car park to help eradicate this problem which appears to

Hundreds of children and young people in County Durham are benefiting from unique education enrichment programme thanks to various funding pots.

Michelle Postma, Extended Schools Co-ordinator for schools across Shildon and Newton Aycliffe, is working in partnership with the Martin Gray Football Academy to deliver courses to more than 500 youngsters across the two school clusters.

The sessions include football coaching with former Sunderland and Darlington pro Martin Gray, while his qualified teachers also work with the children and young people using football as a vehicle to engage them into education.




