AS SIMPLE AS ABC

Council Vote for Aycliffe/Billingham Constituency

Our Town Council has reviewed and revised its position on the new Parliamentary boundaries proposed by the Government Commission. They now unanimously oppose any scheme which splits our community into two constituencies.

In a forthright presentation last Wednesday, Deputy Leader John Clare received the full support of the Council at an Extraordinary Meeting called to discuss the controversial plans to divide Newton Aycliffe.

John Clare gave compelling reasons to keep Great Aycliffe united in a new constituency which brought in Billingham, Eaglescliffe and Middleton St. George, rejecting our M.P.'s proposal which included Yarm, but lost parts of western Aycliffe.

The Town Council have now submitted their proposal to the Boundary Commission backed unanimously by all parties. Great Aycliffe Residents

Association support the Town Council in this bid which keeps Great Aycliffe united. They also support the suggestion that Aycliffe or Great Aycliffe be part of the new name, viz: Aycliffe & Billingham Constituency. Newton News contacted

our MP Phil Wilson for his reaction and he said: 'When the final Boundary Commission report returns to parliament I will be voting against it. Like the majority of people in Newton Aycliffe I want the whole of the town to remain

Steve Sproates is Artist in Residence at Greenfield an Arts and Science College. Steve obtained a BA in Fine Art at Goldsmiths' College, London and MA in Art & Design in Context at Sunderland University. He explores scientific concepts within his work in particular spatial relationships using geometry and constructions that are mathematically and intuitively generated seeking to explore elegance, symmetry and beauty. Steve is currently working in the Design and Technology department with an innovative team of teachers on a series of artworks that explore design within their geometric shapes.

Steve uses Greenfield's laser cutter machine to cut precision geometric shapes needed to build his designs. Steve explains, "the Laser cutting machine demonstrates the versatility of modern technology." The range of dynamic shapes used to construct the Logo will now be used to mount images of the students D&T projects. This creative collaboration has brought exciting opportunities to the school and has strengthened links with artists and partnerships with organisations such as Durham University. Greenfield are very excited about future developments with Steve.

together. The way in which the government wants to gerrymander parliament by forcing constituencies to fit an electoral quota rather than a community means that communities will be split. For example Ferryhill Station could end up in Bishop Auckland and Ferryhill in Durham City! Yarm being part of Sedgefield does not make any rhyme or reason. I think the people of Yarm would agree with that, but because of the electoral quota rule it may well have to stay with Sedgefield. None of this is satisfactory. That is why I will be voting against the Boundary Commission's proposals when they return to parliament. I have raised this problem with The Newton News in the past and have urged people to write to the Boundary Commission with their views.'

Keeping Warm & Healthy Festive Music at Woodham

As the winter months start to set in, and it gets colder, it is important to start thinking about how you are going to keep warm and healthy at home.

I can now relax in the warmth of my home. No more need to put the oven on to keep warm, no need to put the kettle on for dishes, hot water bottles, or to wash myself." Our aim is to improve people's health and wellbeing through helping them to live in a warmer home. To be referred to us, ask your GP, nurse or social care worker to fill in a referral card. POLICE ARREST LOCAL LOAN SHARK

A 52 year old man has been arrested on suspicion of illegal money lending, possession of drugs and money laundering following an operation by the England Illegal Money Lending Team in the Bishop Auckland area of County Durham this week. The Team, working in partnership with Durham County Council executed

a warrant at a residential property seizing cash and documentation. The suspect is currently in custody being questioned by officers from the Team. Durham County Council's Head of environment, health and consumer protection, Joanne Waller, said: "The council is pleased to be working with partners on such an important campaign, which I hope will save many people the pain and anxiety which can be caused by falling victim to loan sharks. Much of the information which helps campaigns like this one by the illegal money lending team comes from the public and I would like to thank residents in advance for their support." Nationally the Stop Loan Shark Project has secured over 190 prosecutions for illegal money lending and related activity, leading to 117 years worth of custodial sentences. They have written

off almost £40 million worth of illegal debt and helped over 16,000 victims. MAKING A DIFFERENCE IN AFRICA

Aycliffe Duo Take Aid from Aycliffe to Malawi

An enormous thank you to Newton Press, friends and family in Aycliffe and beyond for their generosity to the "Maize Appeal for Malawi". The grand total raised in two weeks was £1232., which paid for nearly 100 bags of maize. We also bought 30 rush mats, 140 writing books, 100 pens, drawing papers, sticky tape for a local primary school, paid for twenty children to start school and bought 9 hens!

The bags of maize were shared between two families because we saw such a great need. We also fed two orphanages and two mountain villages where we saw the worst poverty. Gratitude poured from these delightful people who knew for the next month they wouldn't have to worry about providing a daily meal for their families.

Our trip was full of incredible experiences both joyful and heart wrenching including children going without a meal on the day we visited Namirango primary school as no volunteers had turned up to cook.

We saw a girl trying to keep little more than a sole on her feet as the majority of Malawians never own a pair of shoes. A little boy, dirty and ragged led his young, blind, thin mother with one hand, begging with the other.

We witnessed the joy on the faces of those receiving maize, and clothing and met 9 students whose education was sponsored at £80 per year 2,200 aged 6-13 years attend Namirango Primary School with classes of 90 plus. Such numbers mean that two of the



older classes sit under a tree to be taught in temperatures of 90 plus degrees while the teacher writes on a portable blackboard.

The class rooms were bleak with nothing but a black board and chairs and desks on which 4 or 5 children squashed in and in one class there were 9 text books between 95 children!

The youngest children didn't even have desks and sat on the dirty, dusty floor! The children had nothing to play with in or out of class, no balls, bats, dolls-NOTHING. Children are supposed to wear a uniform for school but only about a tenth were in uniform and their own clothes were well past their best.

We are continuing our support for our 11 older students, but in addition over the coming years we can make a difference in this school, and helping those who live in the area.

The Malawian government provide primary education but parent/guardians have to pay a "school fund" of 100 kwacha per term, or 300 kwacha per year which is about £1.20. They are supposed to provide a uniform which costs about £8 plus shoes, a book, pencil and soap for personal use and for clothes, which amounts to £10 per year. Some parents/guardians are so poor they cannot even afford the 300 kwacha, so education is denied to their children.

Our vision is initially to help 200 needy children with the above allowing them to access education which is so important if they are to have a chance of breaking the cycle of poverty. If anyone would like to help provide the requirements for a child's education please contact Norma or Debra.

There are two million orphans in Malawi among a population of 14 million with grandparents, aunts, uncles and other extended family having to support these children but this can lead to even greater poverty. An average Malawian earns approx 47p per day to support their families. We discovered it is not cheap to live in Malawi with most groceries twice as expensive as here and a jar of jam four times as much! Food is so

expensive we lived on cheese sandwiches and no ordinary Malawian would ever shop in a supermarket.

Malawi is known as the "warm heart of Africa" and we know this to be true, being welcomed with open arms and hearts by everyone we met. We left with joy in our hearts and a definite purpose to continue supporting some of the poorest people in the world.

REPORT ON COUNCIL MEETING THURSDAY 1st DECEMBER

Great Aycliffe Town Council has been in the Newton News in recent weeks, not so much for what it has done, but – in a couple of letters – for whether we need it at all! But GATC is vital for our local democracy, and we abandon it at our peril. Great Aycliffe Town Councillors are elected by the people, and their role is to make sure that Council services are appropriate and value for money, and also to be the voice of the people speaking out for the community.

Thursday 1st December was one such occasion. The Town Council had already debated the Boundary Commission changes, but its decisions had been overtaken by events, so an Extraordinary Meeting was held to reconsider its position. After a presentation explaining the different proposals, the Council decided unanimously to request the Boundary Commission:

1. to maintain Aycliffe (North, East, West and Greenfield Midridge) as a single electoral unit.
2. to support a Great Aycliffe-Billingham

Constituency, largely as proposed by Mr Phil Wilson, MP, but excluding Yarm and including the Greenfield-Midridge area of Great Aycliffe.

3. that the name 'Great Aycliffe' should form part of the constituency name. This issue has been well-aided in the Press, and there can be few Aycliffe people who do not approve of these decisions.

The Environment Committee (held immediately after the Full Council meeting), considered the reports of a very successful Annual Allotments meeting, and of work on the Jubilee woodland, Byerley Park Nature Reserve, Bluebell Wood, School Aycliffe Wetlands and Aycliffe Nature Park.

The Council has also had a survey of all the Council's mature trees carried out.

The Recreation Committee met immediately after the Environment Committee. Members heard that usage and takings both on the Golf Course and in the Oak Leaf Complex were down on the same period last year (this is hardly surprising, given that unemployment

in the town is up 16% on this time last year).

The Councillors congratulated officers on the success of the Annual Firework Display, but asked that the sound system be improved for next year (and that the fair music be turned off during the actual display).

Members also heard that the post-excursions questionnaires had shown that 96% of respondents thought that the Senior Citizens' trips this year had been 'excellent' or 'good'. The Committee agreed that the destinations offered next year should be: Scarborough, Skipton, Windermere, Dumfries, and Blackpool, with the half-day trip going to South Shields.

Finally, Councillors decided not to participate in a Nestlé promotional campaign, which would have involved the Council offering free sessions at the Oak Leaf Complex; members decided that the Council should run its own promotional campaign instead.

As far as I am aware, all these decisions were reached unanimously.

Drink, But Don't Drive

- A drinking session the night before might put you over the legal limit the


following day. Keep this in mind and organise alternative travel plans for the next day.

Rodger said: "Drinking and driving has serious consequences. It is not only about your safety, but other road users. It is not worth the risk."



Changes to MOT Certificate

Each month your local car dealership and service centre, Ramsey's Garage, will bring you useful information on the car industry and some helpful hints and tips. This month they give us an insight into what your MOT certificate means and some important changes. Your Certificate is a record of the MOT database and it confirms that your vehicle, without being dismantled, meets the minimum environmental and road safety standards required by law. It doesn't mean your vehicle is roadworthy for the certificate's life and it isn't a substitute for regular servicing and maintenance. From the 16th October 2011 the MOT certificate has changed. The certificate will look different printed on plain paper in landscape format instead of pre-printed coloured paper. With the old style test, notification of failure was given on a red VT30 form, notification of pass on a green VT20 form and any advisory notes were on a separate amber form. This has been simplified to one certificate for vehicles that pass, with any advisory notes listed on this certificate. When your vehicle is tested, your test record is entered into a secure central database and you are given either an MOT pass certificate, or a failure notification. The certificate is your MOT test

receipt and details information held on the database. It relates to the condition of the testable items at the time of test and should not be regarded as: **Evidence of their condition at any other time;** **Evidence of the general maintenance condition of the vehicle;** **Evidence that the vehicle fully complies with all aspects of the law on vehicle construction and use.** The test certificate is no longer proof of MOT and should not be relied on as such. Only the computer database can prove a vehicle has a valid MOT. **Benefits of the New System:** Checking the validity of your MOT certificate is simple. Visit: www.direct.gov.uk/yourmotcheck When buying a car, with the new style advisory notes detailed on the certificate, you will have more transparency as a buyer. The system is more efficient for car garages, reducing paperwork and freeing specialists up to work on your vehicle. There are environmental benefits with less paperwork printed. MOT testing is vital to keep a check on the health of your car, as well as being a legal requirement, but it isn't a substitute for service and maintenance. Why not be honest and mature about OUR local needs and give our Council a remit to adjust the precept and on our behalf, and beady eye, properly provide for OUR agreed priorities by sharing costs, spreading the cost and thereby reducing costs? STOLEN T.V.'s!

LOTTERY CASH FUNDS NEW LUNCHTIME PROJECT AT GREENFIELD



AN OLD school gym has been transformed into a hive of activity during dinner breaks thanks to lottery cash. Greenfield Community College have used the funding to launch an Active Lunchtimes Project, currently consisting of 21 different lunchtime activities to encourage young people to keep their minds occupied and stay active during the break. "Some of the reasons for underachievement can be a lack of positive activities to keep young people engaged and focused before school and during breaks, so the project is aimed to address that". Head Teacher David Priestley added: "There's a number of reasons we wanted to introduce the lunchtime activity programme, the main being to encourage positive social development among young people in the college and to improve school behaviour generally. "It's also hoped to bring young people together, strengthening cohesion between students, which is taking a proactive approach to tackling potential anti-social problems in school. "I'm delighted to say this project is helping us achieve those and several other objectives, so we're pleased with the progress of the scheme so far."
