An 18-year-old from Darlington was found on fire in disused premises as a group of youths tried to steal live electrical cable. He suffered burns to his body which were said at first to be life threatening but the youth is now stable.

The incident happened about 2pm on Saturday, June 5th, at Durham Structures, Hilton Road, Newton Aycliffe. A second man, 19, also from Darlington, was arrested, interviewed by officers and released on bail.

The Police said: the young man could have died and He will have to live with the consequences of his crime for the rest of his life.

There have been a number of these types of burglaries recently and the Police emphasise the thieves are putting their lives in danger.



"BRING BACK THE BOATS" says Former Mayor



Former Mayor Maud Gray is calling on the Town Council to re-introduce boats to the West Park Lakes near Stephenson Way. She has been told by the Council they cannot afford the Park keepers and there is also an issue with the health and safety of boaters as the lake has lots of Algae and chemicals in the water. This was a popular feature of West Lake Park some years ago, but the Council decided to close the facility and the boats are now locked up in the shed. Around the same time the Council put a stop to the small motorised cars for toddlers presumably again due to

the high cost of staff and insurance. "We have also lost a putting green and it is a shame, especially in the summer holidays when we should be encouraging families to use our parks" said Maud. "I remember the time we employed extra staff in the summer for play schemes and everyone enjoyed the boats and cars. I would like the Council to look again at the budget and bring these amenities back, even just for the school holidays." added Maud.

Maud visits our parks often and she believes the Council don't promote the facilities enough or try to make them visitor friendly. "We have some beautiful parks which are a credit to the town and the Council who maintain them, but we would get better use of our recreational areas if we looked at things such as I have mentioned and provide a few picnic benches" said Maud.

We received the following response from Cllr Brian Hall, Chairman of Recreation Committee

In 2007 the Council's Best Value Working Group considered the usage and cost of staffed parks games facilities, including boating and kiddy cars. A comparison of the cost to provide the service and income received was disproportionate. The income level for all of the parks was less than £3,000 whereas the cost of providing the service was over £40,000. The hire of boats in 2006 produced an income of £578.25.

The Best Value Working Group considered alternative proposals and reported to the Council's Policy and Resources Committee. The outcome, ultimately approved by Council, was the withdrawal of staffed parks activities and alternatively an investment in fixed equipment, which removed the need to provide staff for the boating lake, Simpature tennis courts/cars and St Oswald's putting green and cars. Investment was then made in the parks:

Simpature 'kiddy car' track replaced with an infants play area and the refurbishment of the tennis courts to provide two resurfaced courts and double multi-use games area - to be used by the public free of charge.

County Plan Appears to Sideline Aycliffe

Since the County Council published its grand plan readers have contacted Newton News to enquire where Newton Aycliffe figures in the review and asking if our County Councillors are fighting our corner?

It appears any expansion is to take place in the north of the county close to Durham City which is destined to become a "Boom City".

5000 houses will be built around Durham City and the spend on new roads around it is costed at around £95 million. Spennymoor, Bishop Auckland and Barnard Castle town centres will also become more "vibrant".

No mention of Newton Aycliffe with the largest population and the biggest Business Park in the County Council's area! It appears at first look our town has been sidelined and downgraded. However we hear from our Town Council leader, Bob Fleming, that they are going through the proposals with a fine tooth comb and will be making strong recommendations.

Perhaps they should be calling in those County Councillors representing Newton Aycliffe to explain what they are doing to ensure we get a fair share of any new development plans. Of course all this is talk, reports and consultation at the moment. Any development will take years to complete even if the money is available which in the present economic climate is doubtful. Readers can see the lengthy proposals, and make comments, on the County Council website.
