TOWN TEENAGER'S STORY OF GREAT NORTH RUN EXPERIENCE

Emma Cox a regular reader of Newton News was so impressed by her brother's account of his experience in taking part in the Great North Run she has sent it for us to print. Anthony, aged 19, doesn't know his sister has contacted us and we take pride in recording his personal achievement.

"This year's Great North Run was my first ever half marathon, other than a practice 13 mile run 11 days previous. I ran in aid of Teenage Cancer Trust and I trained for 6 months without any injuries. On the Tuesday before the race I managed to go over on my ankle hurt my ankle and spent the next 4 days doing as little as possible, using lots of ice and tiger balm, hoping it would hold up for the run.

On the night before the race I attended a charity event for Teenage Cancer Trust runners. They had entertainment, free pasta and inspirational speeches and videos. It was a great motivation booster for the following day.

At 8am my alarm went off. The big day was finally here! I had porridge before the taxi arrived to take us to the start line. On the way we passed crowds of people. My friend and I, who was also running, headed to the baggage busses and then made our way to the start line where we waited for over an hour for the race to begin. During this time we enjoyed soaking up the atmosphere and laughed our way through the warm up along with around 50,000 others.

When we saw the elite men appear on the screen and their names were announced, we knew the start was close and when they set off, a massive cheer echoed around Newcastle. The moment I had been waiting for, for so long had finally arrived!

A whole 15 minutes passed before we even reached the start line then the running began. The first couple of miles felt good, downhill towards the Tyne Bridge. As we entered the tunnel just before the bridge, the shouts of 'OGI-OGI-OGI, OI-OI-OI!' sent shivers down my spine. That was a moment I would never forget as it enhanced the experience for everyone. I then passed over the Tyne Bridge - a great feeling running over this iconic bridge which I often drive over.

For the next 9 or so miles, I steadily made my way through the masses of people, often using the central reservation in attempt not to lose much time.

On the way I passed many inspirational runners such as a man carrying a fridge on his back, firemen running in full uniform and a man pushing his father in a wheelchair. People lined the roadside and the Teenage Cancer Trust cheering point at mile 8 gave me extra encouragement. When I finally reached the start of South Shields with the shops along the left hand side, I couldn't help but think of my Mam. When we visited South Shields for days out as a kid she always mentioned how this place reminded her of growing up. This was the first of many times I felt a lump in my throat. I hoped I was making her proud!

Once I made it down the very steep hill just before the 12 mile mark, I was constantly looking out for my family on either side of the road waiting to cheer me on as I passed. About a mile later and with around 400m to go, I heard my sister shouting my name and saw her holding an inflatable Teenage Cancer Trust baton. I ran over and took it from her so I could show people as I crossed the line who I

was running the race for. I finally crossed the line with the clock at 2:14:04 and with an official time of 1:59:01. Considering it was my first real half marathon, I was very pleased with my time. However, I couldn't help but think how much quicker I would have ran had I not needed to dodge so many people! As soon as I stopped running, my ankle and foot seized up and I could barely walk on it. I was so relieved it held up for the whole time I was running. The bandage, tiger balm and painkillers did their jobs! I slowly headed to collect my goody bag and medal before waiting at the reunion point for my family. When they arrived I was greeted with big hugs and made to pose for photos. We made our way to the Teenage Cancer Trust charity tent then collected my bag and headed home. It took almost 4 hours to get from South Shields to my Uni house 2 miles from Newcastle City Centre! All in all I had a great day and one that I will never ever forget. I have managed to

raise over £2000 for Teenage Cancer Trust and hope to raise more in years to come. My inspiration to help this great charity came from an amazing friend of mine who is suffering from terminal cancer at the age of just 21. I hope I have done you proud, love you mate!"

I will hopefully be seeing you all on 18th September 2011 for the 31st Great North Run!



WOODHAM STUDENTS VISIT BELSAY



Last week, a Woodham Year 10 group visited an exhibition at Belsay Hall, Northumberland. In stark contrast to other art exhibitions running in galleries, 'Extraordinary Measures' is set in the beautiful surroundings of Belsay Hall castle and gardens, where visitors wandered from the period house through the gardens to the restored castle, finding hidden artwork like a treasure trail. Everyone was in agreement that not only was the place stunning, but the artwork was excellent. The show featured the work of established stars of the art world - Ron Mueck, Mariele Neudecker and

Mat Collishaw as well as up and coming artists.

The theme of the exhibition was the manipulation of scale, from Mueck's hyper-realistic and perfectly proportioned figures to street artist Slinkachu, whose miniature figures are left like the Borrowers to their fate. After Slinkachu creates a scene with his miniatures, he leaves them to fend for themselves. Usually they are stolen, eaten by animals or blown away by the wind; all that is left is the photograph.

At the top of the winding stairs in the tower of the ruined 14th century castle, Mat Collishaw's zoetrope is mesmerising. As

one of the earliest forms of animation, Collishaw proves with his leaping fish, flapping butterflies and smashing of bird's eggs, that the technique is still as spellbinding as when it first came about in the 19th century.

The trip was a big success; the students were introduced to exciting artists working today and have even been inspired to create a collaborative group piece based on Slinkachu's miniature figures which they will leave around school.

Outstanding Sports Kids at Greenfield Young Hopefuls Raise Cash

On Monday evening, 20th September staff and governors at Greenfield were delighted to welcome George Courtney, President of Bishop Auckland Schools Football Association and 1986 and 1990 referee for the FIFA World Cup, to present sports awards to an impressive number of pupils who had achieved outstanding performances. The winners were Alex Cocking, Emma Colbourne, Linzi Davis, Izzy Gardner, Joe Haines, Connor Halford, Adam Hickey, Jessica Higgins, Rachel Layfield-Carroll, Chloe Lodge, Adam Randall, Francis Wade, Raven Waters. This was followed by a presentation evening on Friday, where the department received the title of "Most Outstanding Contribution to PE" in the Sedgefield area. Chair of Governors Peter Bergg said "We are proud of the opportunities and achievements that physical education and sport provide for pupils at Greenfield".

Afternoon teas, home-grown veg, visits from VIPs, and lots of tombola prizes – the Young Hopefuls in Newton Aycliffe worked hard to make their first ever fund-raising event a success. The young people are part of ROCSOLID, a supported housing charity at Hope House in Burnhope. They planned and organised the event as part of their successful Youth Opportunities Fund bid, designed to finance a confidence-building outdoor activities weekend in the Lake District. Our MP Phil Wilson and Town Mayor Counc Dorothy Bowman called in for cuppas to show their support for the Young Hopefuls who live at the project because of their vulnerability. Hope House is home to Reach Out Care Fostering Services and Reach Out Care Support Services. Directors Dot and Derek Butler created the six ROCSOLID flats and launched the charity to help young people leaving local authority care succeed as adults. "Sometimes care leavers end up unsupported in bed and breakfast places and we wanted to give them a better chance of making a success of living independently," said Dot. "The charity has grown and young people come to us from all parts of the region for a variety of reasons. We've had young couples, single parents and babies, care leavers and young people with mental health or drug and alcohol issues. "Each young person has a key worker and they are taught life



skills such as budgeting and cooking and we aim to have everyone into employment, education or training. We're staffed 24/7 and work alongside many other agencies." The charity also runs three satellite houses nearby as move-on accommodation. Young people in the houses continue to be part of the Young Hopefuls and receive ongoing support. There are nine young people at the project and there is always a waiting list. Operations manager Mandy Shaw said the Young Hopefuls had worked hard planning and baking for the event. "They sold produce from the project's vegetable garden at Hope House and our support workers have helped them bake. We've had some good success stories since we started, including a dad and his baby who now have their own home and a young woman who is now working in a local Social Services department. "Another great thing is that some of the Young Hopefuls help feed homeless people on the streets of Middlesbrough and Newcastle as part of another project at Hope House." COUNCILLOR FAILS TO APOLOGISE



NEWTONIAN FACES HER BIGGEST CHALLENGE

Lesley Thompson (52) has lived in Newton Aycliffe most of her life, and her parents were among the first to settle in the town.

She runs 'Special Friends Pet Care', dog walking, training, pet sitting and house sitting. Lesley had breast cancer in 1996 and raised funds for cancer charities, absailing from the roof of the hospital, London Marathon, Great North Run, Windsurfing, Coast to Coast walk, to name a few.

In 2008 she trekked to Everest Base camp for the British Heart Foundation also summitting Kala Patar (5545m) helping to raise over £200,000.



BHF is a charity close to Lesley as her Dad died of a heart attack at the age of 59. Last year she decided to go back to Nepal and trek to the North and South base camps of Kanchenjunga, the 3rd highest mountain in the world. This was a 23 day trek in the remote region of Nepal, spending several days at high altitude.

There were only 2 on the trek, herself and a man from London, looked after by porters and Sherpas. On the evening of the day they reached the 1st base camp, the 10th day, the other person died in his tent aged only 36. "This was the most traumatic experience of my life and at first we thought it was altitude sickness, but it was a heart condition". said Lesley.

Her latest trek presents a greater challenge than those before, trekking for 6 days up the mountain and 2 days down, reaching an altitude of 5895m, 19342ft. She leaves on 29th January 2011 returning on 8th February.

Lesley has 4 months to

train and needs to be at her fittest. My training so far has included a week in the lake district, climbing Skiddaw and Helvelyn, running, swimming and getting my boots on and walking at every opportunity. She is paying for travel, equipment and accommodation costing £1,950. The total amount needed is £3750, which leaves £1800 to raise in sponsorship and fundraising. "I hope to raise as much money as possible for the BHF's fight against heart and circulatory disease which is still more likely to kill you than any other serious illness, including cancer." said Lesley.

Lesley has organised a fundraising night on 28th October at the DSRM Social Club Longfield Road, Darlington with live music, pie and peas supper, raffle and bottle tombola. Tickets are £5 each and Lesley has a 'Just Giving' page on the internet <http://original.justgiving.com/lesleythompson6>.

SBH Apply to Build Homes In Aycliffe

Sedgefield Borough Homes has asked permission to build 14 new affordable homes in response to regional shortages of family housing.

sbh manages 8,500 homes formerly owned by the now defunct Sedgefield Borough Council, and wants to build the houses on two sites in Newton Aycliffe.

They plan to build three two-bed and three three-bed houses on land at Clarence Chare and Palmer Road and eight two-bed houses at Baliol Road, north of Aycliffe Business Park.

The houses would replace "problematic" and "under-used" garages with much needed housing for families on the county

wide housing waiting list.

In a report to the council, sbh said the garages, built in 1963, are in a poor state and at Clarence Chare have experienced anti-social behaviour from time to time. A spokesman said sbh would work with garage tenants to provide parking for their cars. The company said there was a major need for two and three-bed houses in the area.

The company received 76 applications for each of the 19 two-bed homes it put on the market last year with almost 370 prospective tenants saying they would prefer two bedrooms.

Recently, the company advertised six three bedroom homes receiving an average of 32 applications per house. The application follows a report from the National Housing Federation which found a shortage of social homes in the North East.

In response Durham County Council pledged to address the dwindling supply. Glynn Hall, head of housing for Durham County Council, said: "Our priority is to work with Housing Associations to supply an increased range of more affordable housing while, at the same time, encouraging an increase in the overall housing supply."

"There are more than 16,000 households on the county wide housing register and this number is increasing. Addressing that remains a high priority for the council."

Wayne Harris, Executive Director says, "This is a very exciting for us. After years of diminishing stock from the Right to Buy, we are now hopeful of increasing sbh' housing stock and providing much needed high quality, energy efficient housing accessible to local people."

NEW SERVICE FOR YOUNG PEOPLE NEAR YOUTH CENTRE

Cabinet are being asked to approve plans for new 'hubs' which will provide combined children's services across the county.

The Children's Trust are proposing to create integrated Children and Young People's Service teams across County Durham.

Cllr Claire Vasey, Lead Member for Children and Young People, said: "The new centres will bring services closer to local children, young people and their families and will help staff work together more effectively."
