TOWN COUNCIL TO FREEZE TAX AGAIN

The Labour controlled Town Council is set to freeze the Council Tax again for next year. Great Aycliffe Town Council froze the Council Tax for the current year and has continued to make efficiencies and savings whilst continuing its scheduled improvements and various works programmes.

Currently the Council Tax for Great Aycliffe Town Council is £204.10 for Band D and £136.07 for Band A properties. Cllr Bob Fleming Labour Leader on the Town Council and Deputy Mayor said "It is important to stress that the Town Council is not subject to Government restrictions on Council Tax, nonetheless in line with Government and Tax payer expectations, after prudently providing for inflation, contingencies, capital reserves in the Revenue Budget, and unavoidable budget growth and falls in income, the Council Tax freeze has been achieved without the need to make cuts to frontline services or



staffing levels in line with the 3 year medium term financial plan."

Our Town Councillors are to be commended for avoiding an increase in tax at the present time when everyone is about to face financial difficulties. We also hear they are currently considering a report from the Town Clerk on cutting items of civic expense such as Mayoral events and hospitality.

A decision will be made in time for proposals and discussions on the 2011/12 budget.

Dedication of The Royal British Legion Memorial Garden



On Thursday 4th November the Chaplain of The Royal British Legion in Newton Aycliffe, Rev. Linda Potter, formally dedicated the new Memorial Garden outside the club premises in Macmillan Road.

During the Service, attended by members and officials, prayers of thanksgiving were said for the work of the British Legion who support families of those who suffer as a consequence of war.

Six Standard Bearers lowered their flags and the Last Post, 2 minutes silence and Reveille was called, followed by the Dedication of the Garden by the Parish Priest.

The new amenity provides a nice outdoor patio for members and visitors to sit as well as providing a permanent site of remembrance to those who have given their lives in service to their country.

WHEEL SNATCHERS RETURN TO AYCLIFFE *IS YOUR CAR SAFE?*

Alloy wheel thieves have struck again in the West Ward of the town. Overnight on the 8th into 9th November two Ford Focus motor vehicles were targeted and their wheels removed.

On Beechfield, offenders have gained entry into a Black Ford Focus via the rear passenger window which was broken. An untidy search was carried out for the locking wheel nut attachment which the owner had believed was securely locked away in the boot of the vehicle. All four alloy wheels were removed and the car was left stood on bricks.

Nearby, on Oakfield a blue Ford Focus had its rear windscreen broken and thieves have removed the two rear wheels as a result, propping up the vehicle on bricks. A car jack, not belonging to the car owner, was left at the scene and has been recovered for forensic analysis.

Extensive enquiries are ongoing in the area and at this time reports have been received in respect of a white coloured Transit van that was seen acting suspiciously in Oakfield on the night in question. Police are keen to discover more about this vehicle and are appealing to local residents to

come forward with any more information.

Sgt Mark Edwards of the Neighbourhood Police Team at Newton Aycliffe again wishes to stress to vehicle owners the importance of removing their locking wheel nut attachments.

"Despite a high profile awareness campaign recently which the Newton News sponsored, owners are still leaving the tools in their cars which are assisting offenders in stealing wheels. I appreciate concerns that people have in regards to removing their locking wheel nuts should they break down whilst out driving or in developing a flat tyre. I am not asking people to remove their valuables full stop, only during those times when their vehicles will be left unattended such as overnight, especially as we delve deeper into the dark nights of winter. Leaflet drops are being conducted in the area by local Officers from the NPT and awareness cards printed by Newton Press are being distributed in the Oakfield and Beechfield areas.

THE GREAT FIRE OF AYCLIFFE

Two stunning photos of the factory fire last Friday taken by local professional photographer Lawrence Conyers of Anson Photography. He was on the spot at the time of the explosion and later the town was covered in black smoke as fire appliances from the area tackled the blaze. At first everyone thought it was Ineos that had caught fire which would have been even more serious, but it was revealed that Spillers Warehouse was the factory that exploded in flames, scattering debris all over adjacent properties including nearby houses and cars. One nearby resident reports: "We were on Clarence Chare when we first saw the smoke and flames above the houses so we set off home along Finchale Road and there was debris falling onto the cars and the roof tops of the houses also burnt paper, insulation material and canisters. As we passed Simpature shops crowds of people gathered looking to see what had happened and where the flames were coming from. We live in Watson Road so got home and parked the car joining people heading towards the old railway lines to see the fire and then heard explosions and dense black smoke appear.



The flames could be seen clearly with fire engines and firemen at work fighting the blaze. The

police were evacuating people away from nearby factories and asked us to leave the area as there was still debris falling from the cloud of smoke and a risk of further explosions. We were told to go indoors and make sure all windows and doors were closed. Living close was very worrying because if the fire spread or the wind changed direction there are two large chemical plants close by which would have made it a major incident. There was no smell at all on Friday but by Saturday a haze gathered over Simpature with an awful burning/smoke smell that irritated the eyes and throat. We were able to open our windows again on Sunday evening once it had all cleared".

A coordinated and well planned response to the fire has ensured the incident has been properly dealt with. At the height of the blaze a smoke plume extended to the North coast, 15 miles away. The Health Protection Agency were asked by the County Council whether air quality monitoring was needed to help their assessment, but on this occasion it was not. In the early stages of the incident, firewater contaminated with pollutants entered the River Skerne through Howden Beck and Demon's Beck. This caused significant white foaming downstream to Darlington. A large volume of contaminated water in Howden Beck was pumped out at the weekend. The Council continue to work closely with the company and the Fire and Rescue Service.

Best Crime Detection Rates in the Country

Members of Durham Police Authority are pleased to announce its Constabulary is performing well, with falling crime rates and good crime detection rates across County Durham and Darlington. Police performance was reviewed by the Authority at its quarterly meeting of the Effective Policing Delivery Committee and shown that the crime detection rate has increased by over 15% in the last year. This means that between April and September this year, 41% of all crimes have been detected. Police Authority Members welcomed the reduction in overall crime in the Force area which is now at the lowest recorded crime rates since the 1980's. All recorded crime fell by 14.9%, equating to 3,266 fewer crimes and members were pleased to see reductions in burglary, vehicle and all violent crime, plus drug related incidents and criminal damage. Peter Thompson, Chair of the Police Authority said: "These performance figures are extremely impressive and I hope that the residents of County Durham and Darlington are reassured to know that we are doing everything we can to keep them safe - and that they really are safer. "The Authority has consistently listened to local people and set challenging targets for the Constabulary based on this feedback, thereby ensuring that the things that matter most to our communities are being successfully addressed. "Fear of crime is a national issue, which is usually inflated in the national press. Locally, as these figures illustrate, Durham Constabulary is doing an excellent job and one which we are working hard to help them maintain. "On behalf of all residents I would like to say a big thank you to the Chief Constable and everyone connected with the Force for these magnificent achievements in these very challenging times".

BUSINESS FINED £1,335 FOR ILLEGAL ROADSIDE NOTICES

Businesses in County Durham are being warned to check that their outdoor advertisements have the necessary planning consent in place.

The warning comes following the County Council's successful prosecution this week of the proprietor of Pity Me Nursery near Durham City for the unlawful display of advertisements at two roadside sites in the vicinity of his premises.

The adverts are contrary to the Town and Country Planning Act. Mark Green was fined £1000 and was ordered to pay Council costs of £335.

The Council's portfolio holder for Regeneration and Economic Development, Cllr Neil Foster commented "The Council is always very keen to work with local businesses to try to find a solution to their advertising requirements. We are acutely aware of the difficult economic times within which we operate and have no desire whatsoever to take action that may be perceived to prevent businesses from being successful.

"It is important to understand the context within the county and one of the key attributes of its splendid landscape. The Council feels that quite often this is being harmed by the appearance of roadside signs.

As a result when businesses fail to respond to planning officers requests to remove advertisements which have been found to have been displayed unlawfully, we will not hesitate to use all measures, including the initiating of prosecution proceedings, to preserve the high environmental quality of the County."

"A CASE OF ENTRAPMENT" SAYS WITNESS READER

Dear Sir,

In response to your article last week regarding the selling of alcohol to underage drinkers I would like to comment.

Whilst I agree there is definitely a problem with teenagers getting their hands on alcohol it's not from the pubs on the town but from supermarkets and irresponsible parents.

I was in the Huntsman with a group of friends on the night operation COALVILLE took place; the "underage drinker" the police sent into the pub clearly looked over the age of 18 (this is not just my opinion but the opinion of everyone in the bar at the time) so what's the point of them choosing 'someone who looks legal to entrap well intentioned licensees?

Furthermore, why did it take three plain clothed officers to accompany the underage drinker, then a further five uniformed officers to charge the bar person and two more to sit outside in a vehicle. A total of TEN officers! One of which looked at most 14 years old, he would have been refused entry into the pub if I had been behind the bar.

Ten officers to entrap a well intentioned bar person who I know regularly refuses to serve underage drinkers who take a chance at being served, talk about a waste of resources!

In addition one of the pubs who didn't serve the "underage drinker" had been contacted by the bar person from the Huntsman to ask if they had been raided, which obviously tipped them off that they were probably next on the list.

On the other hand the business I run on the Business Park has been plagued by people parking cars on our private land and obstructing our goods loading doors. I've been trying to get something sorted about this with the Police for probably over 3 weeks now; what's happened? I've had a phone call from an officer who wasn't sure what he could do about it!

The parking still continues; at present I can see at least eight cars parked either on double yellow lines, on footpaths, or areas which are supposed to be green areas.

Crackdown on Scrap Metal Theft

Traders in South Durham are barring the way for metal thieves after signing up to a crime crackdown.
 Metal merchants in the Sedgefield, Wear Valley and Teesdale areas are being encouraged to bring in extra checks to prevent people selling on stolen lead and other materials.
 Visitors to Denham Metal Merchants, in Shildon and Bells, in Bishop Auckland will now have to provide proof of their identity if they wish to sell on scrap metal.
 They will also have to demonstrate that they are the legal owner of any vehicle they wish to have scrapped.
 The measures have been introduced as part of an ongoing operation organised by the Safe Durham Partnership and led by police and licensing officers from Durham County Council.
 Inspector Ed Turner, of Durham Constabulary, said: "The help and cooperation of local traders is vital if we are to succeed in cracking down on metal theft."
 "We want criminals to know that we are making every effort to prevent them from operating in County Durham."

Denhams is also displaying signs warning of the consequences of handling stolen goods.
 And staff at the dealership have been issued with special torches that can be used to reveal unique markings identifying the source of the metal.
 Police and licensing officers will be paying regular visits to each of the participating firms to carry out site inspections and offer advice to the proprietors.
 The operation, which has been running for three months, also includes stop and search exercises, when drivers of vehicles carrying scrap metal are asked to produce paperwork demonstrating their load is legal.
 So far, eight people have been arrested and two vehicles seized as a result of the inspections.
 Anyone with information about the theft and illegal sale of scrap metal should contact Durham Constabulary on 0345 606 0365 or Crimestoppers on 0800 555 111

11 Medals for Aycliffe Swimmers

Six swimmers from Sedgefield 75 Swimming Club travelled to the Aquatic Centre, Sunderland to compete in the North Eastern Regional short course swimming championships. For the first time both galas took part at the same time with the 50m pool split in two and the age group championships at one end and the senior/junior at the other. Hannah Featherstone (11), Matthew Bradley (12) and Sam Dixon (13), were competing in the age group event and between them came away with 11 medals. Matthew won 4 gold medals in the 100m Freestyle, 100 and 200m Breaststroke and 200m Individual Medley and silver in both the 200m Freestyle and 100m Backstroke. Hannah won gold in the 100m Freestyle, silver in the 200m Freestyle, 200m Backstroke and 100m Butterfly and finished in 5th place in the 200m Individual Medley.
