We decided not to hold a firework display at another time, for example at Christmas or New Year's Eve as most of the costs are setting up costs, roughly £4,000. In addition, by the end of December, beginning of January, the area where the firework display is held becomes very damp and muddy and not suitable for thousands of people walking about in the dark.

Residents Object to More Allotments

Dear Sir,
The people who live in Hylton Close, were not best pleased when last week they received a letter from Durham County Council stating that our Town Council had submitted plans to create an additional 43 allotment plots on the open space at the end of the Close adjacent to St Oswalds Park. These are additional to the 60 plots, plus six pigeon lofts, that already exist in that location. This will lead to increased traffic in Hylton Close/Washington Crescent, which originally was constructed by the Aycliffe Development Corporation, as a cul-de-sac way back in the 60s. We already have problems with existing allotment traffic, which can only get worse if the 43 new plots are allowed to be created. Needless to say, the residents in Hylton Close, will be raising strong valid objections to the proposed plans, as we feel that we have been let down badly by our Town Councillors, none of which by the way, live anywhere near Hylton Close. Newtonian's Own Triathlon Charity Challenge

20 year old Newtonian Andrew Dewar recently took part in a charity challenge. From 25th to 27th September he completed a three day triathlon of his own design and raised over £1000 for charity. On the first day he swam the channel (distance 21 miles) in Newton Aycliffe Leisure Centre pool in 8 hours and 28 minutes. The second day he cycled from Hartlepool on the east coast to Maryport on the west coast (120 miles) in 9 hours 56 minutes, and on the third day climbed three peaks in the Lake District, including Scafell Pike, the tallest in England. Andrew swam at national level for Sedgfield 75 Swimming Club, coached by John Moore at Newton Aycliffe. He is now at the University of Warwick studying for a degree in Mathematics, Operational Research, Statistics and Economics. He was taking part in a charity climb of Mount Kilimanjaro in Tanzania, but that trip fell through so he decided to make up his own challenge. EMPTY SHIPS MAKE MOST NOISE

Dear Sir,
The inference in last week's Newton News - that being an 'Independent' makes you a 'purer', better Councillor - is insidious and false. The electors do not know what goes on in their name.

Take for instance, the last round of Council meetings. At the Environment meeting of 20th October, the Independent group disagreed with the Labour Councillors on only one matter of note - a letter from the Catholic Church asking the Town Council to put flowers along Central Avenue. It was going to cost £200 at most, so the Labour Councillors were predisposed to say yes; the Independent group block-voted no (they were outvoted).

The next week, at the Policy and Resources Committee of 27 October, the Independent group again agreed with Labour on everything of substance save one - a letter from St Clare's Church asking the Town Council for help with a new boiler. The Labour Councillors were predisposed to donate £200; the Independents block-voted for £500 (they were outvoted).

Now I am not quibbling about the fact that the Independents proposed nothing for the Catholic Church one week and £500 for the Anglican Church the next; no doubt they had their reasons beyond the fact that one of them (who declared an interest) goes to St Clare's Church.

What I want people to know is that on those two weeks the Town Council was debating its Budget for the next year. It considered its (excellent) Auditors' Report. It allocated budget sums to every one of its services. It declared its capital spending plans for 2010-11. It set its charges and fees for the next year. It sanctioned a budget

plan approaching £3 million. The Labour Councillors had been working on this with the Council officers for months. They had discussed and debated every detail - make no bones about it, the Budget was Labour's proposal for Town Council spending for the next year. And what did the Independent Councillors do? Remember that you elected them on a promise to slash Council spending (actually, by half, they promised).

Not one of them opposed it. No complaints, no suggestions, no comments. At both meetings it went through without challenge. And the following week, at Full Council (when ALL Councillors can attend), the Budget was formally accepted ... unanimously.

The Independent Councillors are forever airing their spleen in the Newton News. But in the Council Chamber - where it matters - few of them ever speak.

CAUGHT ON CAMERA

People who illegally dump their rubbish on roadsides and beauty spots across County Durham may get more than they bargained for! That's the stark warning from Durham County Council as the authority ups its surveillance at flytipping hot spots across the County.
As the Council expands its CCTV surveillance operations, in partnership with both the Durham Constabulary and the Environment Agency, people who blight the countryside with enviro-crimes are warned they are being watched closer than ever.
Durham County Council's head of Direct Services is Oliver Sherratt: "We take a zero tolerance approach to the minority that cause flytipping - it spoils the appearance of neighbourhoods and can be a safety hazard in our communities. As a result of our partnership approach, the number of incidents of

flytipping in the County is falling. Nevertheless, there have still been more than 2,500 over the last year and it costs us over £20,000 a month to clean up the mess."
The Cabinet member for Streetscene is Cllr Brian Stephens: "As a strong and forward-thinking partnership we will continue to pursue all cases of fly tipping to ensure those responsible are held to account for their actions. Flytipping is a criminal offence and we won't tolerate it blighting our County. We are asking members of the public to be vigilant and report anyone they witness dumping rubbish, please make a note of the vehicle details involved if you can, and we will do the rest."
To report a fly tipping incident you can call Durham County Council on 0300 123 7070. Currently the partnership has four cases pending prosecution.

TOWN STUDENT MEMBER OF UK YOUTH PARLIAMENT



Newtonian Tom Hunter is a Member of the Youth Parliament (MYP) for Durham. Basically, He was elected by young people across Durham with a majority of 1,356 votes in May to represent them in the UK Youth Parliament. Since then he has been busy speaking with constituents about what they would like to see happen in Durham and then taking his findings back to the Parliament North East regional meetings held every 2 months.

At the end of October he was in London and met Phil Wilson, who spoke about the "Back On Track" campaign which he fully supports), the redevelopment of the town centre and also his views on the debates we would be having the next day in the House of Commons chamber which were:
1 Should sex and relationships education be compulsory from primary school onwards?
2 Should university tuition fees rise
3 Should the school leaving age be raised to 18 in order to reduce youth unemployment?
4 Should we withdraw all British troops from Afghanistan by 2012?
5 Should transport fares for young people be protected from spending cuts?

During the third debate (Should the school leaving age be raised to 18 to reduce youth unemployment?) he gave his opinion on the topic and said "At the age of 16, young people can choose to start a family or whether or not we want to join the armed forces, so why can't we choose whether or not to stay on in education? Would it be fair for someone who actually wants to go to college to have their education disrupted by someone who doesn't want to be there? Would it not be a waste of the taxpayer's money to send someone who has no interest in getting an 'A' level to college? All this would do is turn "youth unemployment" into just general "unemployment". We should give young people a choice, because it's the fair thing - and the right thing - to do." Tom was applauded as he finished his speech and was relieved that it was over but also happy that he had been able to address the Youth Parliament. He had consulted his constituents on the topics before the event and, as their representative, voted: 1: Yes, 2: No, 3: No, 4: No, 5: Yes.

As well as being a Member of Youth Parliament Tom is a Member of Aycliffe Youth Council and Chairman of Greenfield Student Council. Tom asks the youth of the town to contact him if they have an idea or issues they would like him to bring to the Youth Parliament or would like to see something change in their local area. CANNABIS GROWER IN NEWTON AYCLIFFE CAUGHT

Last week Officers from Newton Aycliffe's Neighbourhood Police Team executed a Magistrate's Search Warrant issued under the Misuse of Drugs Act at an address in Skirlaw Road in response to community concerns suggesting that there was a cannabis grow located at the address ready for cropping. Officers found two areas containing cannabis plants in various stages of maturity. At the bottom of the garden a wooden shed was discovered to contain a sophisticated and professional hydroponic system containing in excess of 20 mature plants which were days away from being cropped; these have an estimated street value of £15,000 to £20,000. In an upstairs bedroom at the address a further 24 seedlings were found within an internal heated cupboard, ready to take the place of the mature plants when they'd been cropped.

The plants and growing equipment were seized by Police and two males were arrested; a 64 year old male at the target address and a 40 year old male who was located at another nearby location. Both males were arrested on suspicion of cannabis cultivation and have been bailed pending further enquiries and forensic examination of the equipment recovered. As a result of the information and intelligence gained from this operation further arrests are expected and the day's success has seen a significant disruption to the cannabis trade within Newton Aycliffe. Mark Edwards, Sergeant with the NPT, states "I hope our actions highlight how serious we take the issue of drug misuse and supply within Newton Aycliffe and all information received will be collated and acted upon."
