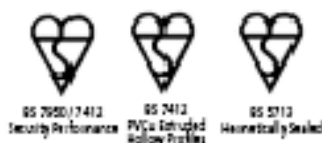

Editorial Question Unanswered

In this issue George Gray justifies voting for land transfer, but only in his own ward where greens and open spaces remain in public control, thanks to previous objections made by the Town Council.

He missed the point over the main concern which is for those areas, elsewhere in the town, where large pieces of land are being transferred. All Councillors from the town were urged to keep these areas of land in public ownership whether it was in their ward or not.

It appears only the Independents stood firm while Labour Councillors were told which way to vote by the Party. Why did the Labour Councillors feel bound by the whip when the Borough Council is being dissolved?

It is difficult to understand the inconsistency of the Borough Council in this whole argument over the land. They agree to some areas being kept under public control and not others. When you buy a house you only get so many yards surrounding your property. You do not normally get ownership of adjacent common land. The question of why the Borough wish to give any public land away remains unanswered.

This newspaper has always supported the transfer of council houses as it promised a better deal for tenants, but can never understand giving public land to a private company.

Greenfield students were out in the Town Centre on Tuesday conducting a survey of their own on what improvements could be made to the shops and general environment. Armed with clipboards they visited the market, St. Clares Church and the new War Memorial. The students were encouraged to talk to shoppers and come up with ideas and suggestions. In due course they will produce their findings which will make interesting reading.

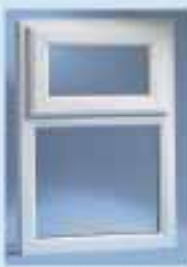

RENT RISE FEAR

Dear Sir,
I write re the letter in your paper week ending 13th March, 2009 on Housing Association rents. Alan Warburton an Independent Councillor states he has been informed that one of the Housing Associations is charging £73.30 per week plus Council Tax for a two bedroom flat.
I live in a Housing Association 2 bedroom flat and as of 6th April, 2009 my rent alone is going from £68.98 per week to £76.93 which is approximately a 11.5% rise. This together with my new Council Tax coming in at £113.00 per month.
Part of my rent is to pay for a landscape gardener at £6.24 per week which is a joke in itself. When the gardener does come round all they do is cut a small patch of grass at the front of the properties and then use a hedge trimmer to cut down overgrown bushes.
I also pay for a 'caretaker' at £2.43 per week. I've seen our 'caretaker' at work he picks up the odd crisp packet and puts it in a bin bag. A statement with my new rent increase says that if I think I am paying too much I can fill in a form and it will be put forward to a Rental Assessment Team. But, this team can also decide if they think you aren't paying enough rent and it can be increased, which puts you off making enquiries.
Mr Warburton suggests asking a new landlord for all repairs to be done from day one but what about people who have lived in these flats for years? I have asked for a new kitchen, but they don't answer the question. The windows are double glazed with timber frames, and all the beading between the glass is all coming away and one of my windows has 3/4"

of water between the two panes of glass. When I reported it I was informed it was priority 4 and would be repaired within 6 months. I think my best move would be to fill in a Housing Form for Sedgefield Borough Council and try to get a house rather than a flat and benefit from a garden which I can maintain myself at less than £6.24 per week.

Through these hard times they only want to spend money on a silly Head sculpture than on our housing needs so why should I vote again? They are cutting back on vital services for the people of Aycliffe. They would rather spend the money on a sculpture than give it back to us via council tax reduction. The Council waste money on refurbishment of Parks removing play equipment and replacing them with things that kids don't want. They took good stuff away and replaced it with poor items. My kids loved the slide and climbing frame and now they don't want to go to that park.

TRAPPED IN OUR HOMES AFTER 6 p.m.

Dear Sir
 I read with great interest the article by Arriva in the Newton News and their apparent plans to improve bus services, particularly those which run through Newton Aycliffe. As a resident of School Aycliffe, I find the bus service through our village inadequate to say the least. There is one bus an hour (number 16) into Newton Aycliffe, and one bus

an hour into Darlington. This, in itself, is not an issue as one bus an hour is reasonable. However, the service ends at 6.00pm after which you cannot get a bus to or from School Aycliffe. Since the Chestnuts estate was built on the other side of School Aycliffe Lane a number of years ago, the population of the village has increased dramatically. Surely we are entitled to a regular bus service throughout the day and late into the

evenings with so many council tax paying residents in the area.
 As parents of responsible young adults aged 17 and 15, we try to encourage our children to be more independent, and make their own way to and from the places they wish to go to. However, the lack of a bus service in the evenings means we have to mollycoddle them by taking them to the door, and picking them up again. The nearest buses run either through Heighington or by Newton Aycliffe railway station. Either way, it involves walking over a mile to get a bus, along an unlit stretch of road in either direction. There are many families in School Aycliffe so this is not something which

only affects my family, and we are not alone in our concerns. I wrote to Arriva last year expressing my feelings on the matter, and aside from the fact that they did not read my letter properly, the reply was simply that it was not economical to run the 16 in the evenings. That may well be the case, but with 8 buses an hour running through Newton Aycliffe into Darlington, couldn't one of these buses be re-routed in the evening to incorporate School Aycliffe and Heighington? Overall, Arriva do an excellent job and run a very good service, but it is unfair to cut out a whole area after 6.00pm. I would urge the residents of School Aycliffe to write to Arriva requesting that they review our bus service, especially those of you with children. Even if your children are very young now, there will come a time when they wish to be more independent, and you will want to encourage them to be so, rather than relying on parents to ferry them everywhere.
