



to response the correspondence in the last two weeks regarding the opening of the new Lloydspharmacy adjacent to Pease Way Surgery, I

wanted to clarify one or two În order to secure a contract

with the Primary Care Trust (PCT), a pharmacy company usually has to demonstrate that a new pharmacy is "necessary or desirable" within a neighbourhood. The PCT will then consider whether a new pharmacy would improve service provision for the residents of that neighbourhood and approve or decline the

application. One of the exceptions to this necessary or desirable test applied when a pharmacy will open for 100 hours per week or more. The reason for this exemption was to improve access to pharmaceutical care principally late at night and at weekends, or in case of emergencies. This is how both Tesco, and more recently Lloydspharmacy, have been able to open new pharmacies within Newton Aycliffe.

I can only support the sentiment of T. Latham's letter to you last week - the choice of where to take your prescription is YOURS! We have had some patients who have thought that they have had to change because they have heard that Pease Way Surgery have opened "their own" pharmacy. Pease Way Surgery have no connection with Lloydspharmacy who are a very large pharmacy chain in their own right.

Alliance Pharmacy was bought out by Boots the Chemists some years ago and now they are both owned by the same company. Neville Pharmacy has been an independent pharmacy since it's opening in the 1950's and we are proud of our history and tradition of serving the population of Newton Avcliffe.

We seek to surpass the expectations of all of our patients and try and make it as easy as possible for our patients to stay fit and healthy, for example by offering free advice on medicines, free prescription collection and delivery and stocking a wide range of over the counter medicines for common illnesses.

However we also welcome the addition of another pharmacy in the town as this improves patient choice, and if this contributes to improving the health of our area then it can only be a good thing.

As always, whenever a business is not providing a good service it will suffer a loss in trade and a pharmacy is no different to any other business.

Syd Howarth, chaired the meeting on behalf of GARA and started by given a brief history of how the association came into being. Much to the disappointment of many in the church, our MP Phil Wilson had sent his apologies, having been delayed in the House of Commons, but did send a message of support.

Each member of the panel introduced themselves, giving a background to their role and what they could and couldn't do, and then the floor was opened to questions.

Members and public had come from across the town and the range of questions asked reflected a diverse range of concerns;, damage to a large number of saplings in Woodham, vandalism and theft from allotments, improved security in an area of sheltered housing, problem with noise from neighbours. The appropriate panel members answered concerns, offering advice and suggesting possible action we could take as individual residents.

Problems of adults buying alcoholic drinks for those below legal age were also raised as some felt the drinks were simply being passed into the wrong hands. The police had a very clear message, underage drinking anywhere on the town would not be tolerated and this point, the haul of drink that had been seized over the last few weeks was put on display in the entrance hall.

It was clear that residents felt that a number of services had become fragmented, when should 999 be used, when was the 0345 number more appropriate for the police? How did the DCC neighbourhood wardens fit into the scheme of things?

A lot of concerns were raised throughout the two hour meeting; however a meeting can only be a start.

The Chairman said: "It was a very useful meeting and the distinguished panel fielded the questions well. Despite our ongoing problems it was reassuring to hear our town has the lowest crime figures in the County. The Police will continue their efforts to provide a quick response to reports. Vigilance is important and the Police need and appreciate any help from the general public. Thanks to all who attended the meeting. We are considering calling similar meetings as part of our strategy to keep residents informed of important happenings in our community".

If we want to make improvements, we have to individually and communally, take action to help, as well as hold to account, those responsible for dealing with these matters.

He told Newton News: "Mistakes have been made in the past and the club, and fans, have suffered so I know I will be on trial until they see tangible evidence the club is progressing. I know the challenges we face, and it's a challenge I'm relishing.

"One of the biggest criticisms in the past is failing to listen to the fans, and that's why we're talking to the Supporters' Trust and other fans to get their opinions and hopefully improve that relationship. Mr Singh is appealing for supporters to get behind the club and have faith in what his new regime is trying to achieve.

"We're desperate for the fans to get behind this," says Mr Singh. "We know all too well the empty promises and false dawns which have let our supporters down so badly in the past, so we can't blame them for being sceptical.

"I'm making no empty promises or wild predictions. My only promise is that this is a real, genuine effort by me and my new team to get Darlington Football Club back on its feet. There is no quick-fix, it's not going to happen overnight, we're well aware of that. It's a long-term job but that's why we have long-term plans. To make it work, though, we need the support of our fans now.

"I have the finances in place to secure the club's longterm security, but everyone knows that season ticket sales are absolutely crucial for the cash flow and for us to plan for the coming season, so we're urging our fans to buy their season tickets as soon as possible to help the club - they can certainly be assured that every single penny of their money will go directly into the
