£1.2m EXTENSION TO PCP CENTRE GETS UNDERWAY



Last Friday, 24th July was a big day for town charity, the Pioneering Care Partnership (PCP) at Cobblers Hall as the turf cutting ceremony launched the building of a new £1.2 million extension to the Centre.

The project is funded mainly by a Community Assets grant from the Office of the Third Sector and Working Neighbourhood's Funds. Patron of PCP, Lord Foster of Bishop Auckland, led the ceremony along with County Councillor's Brian Stephens, Neil Foster and members of the PCP Board of Trustees and staff.

The PCP has worked in partnership with the County Council and the former Borough Council to develop this Centre of Excellence and once the work is completed, the centre will be leased to the PCP by the County Council for a peppercorn rent for the next 125 years.

Chief Executive of the PCP Jane Hartley said 'I am delighted this development and the partnership with the County Council has secured the future of the centre

so that we can continue to provide services and support to local people'.

The Centre is to become a Centre of Excellence providing more facilities for local people to improve their health and wellbeing through exercise and activity classes, group activities, therapy and rehabilitation services. The centre will also include an Employability Suite providing training and IT facilities, meeting rooms and office accommodation to support people to develop their skills, health and confidence to move towards employment.

Facilities will be available to many different organisations and groups to use to deliver their services and activities and will also enable the PCP to deliver more activities and classes for the general public currently compromised due to lack of space. There will also be extended car parking and café facilities within the centre to cope with the increased footfall. The extension is due to be completed in March 2010. Organisations wanting

COUNTY GETS £5M TO IMPROVE BUS SERVICE

Major bus routes in County Durham are to benefit from a £5 million improvement programme. Durham County Council has been awarded government funding for the scheme – called Transit 15 – which will help to strengthen the county's public transport network, reduce traffic congestion and enable people to enjoy better access to jobs and leisure opportunities. The scheme is also aimed at

encouraging more people to travel by bus by providing a faster, more efficient service. The council will work in partnership with bus operators Go North East and Arriva to further improve the reliability and frequency of bus services and provide passengers with easy-access, low-floor buses. Work to improve parts of the road network, such as junctions and bottlenecks which can cause delays for buses, are to be carried out

and some new bus lanes are to be created. The main bus routes to benefit from the £5 million Transit 15 funding all run between Durham City and the following locations: **Bishop Auckland; Birtley; Crook; Coxhoe; Stanley; Consett; and Sherburn.** Coun Bob Young, Cabinet Member for the Environment at Durham County Council, said: "I am absolutely delighted with the

announcement of an additional £5 million of funding from the government. It will allow this important scheme, linking key residential areas, to be fast-tracked. "The funding, through the Local Transport Plan, helps one part of our drive to deliver efficient, reliable and sustainable transport fit for the 21st century. It is particularly important just now in helping to address the effects of the recession to get people to where they want to be, whether it is to work or to shops and other services. "We are currently looking at the design and cost of work to be carried out in relation to road

network improvements and the creation of bus lanes and will carry out consultations on the proposed improvements in the autumn." Construction work would be expected to start in early 2010. The overall improvements to the public transport network in County Durham will bring indirect benefits to bus users in Newton Aycliffe as many other bus routes link in with major routes in and out of Durham City. Junction improvements planned between Croxdale and Durham will also help bus routes to and from Newton Aycliffe.

Who Would Steal from a Charity Shop?

Dear Sir,
For the past 5 years I have worked as a volunteer with Sue Ryder care at the Aycliffe shop. The charity is a national one and provides compassionate care to people with end of life or long term needs. I can say truthfully that I thoroughly enjoy the work. The two extremely hardworking managers and the rest of the volunteers are fun to be with and make a great supportive, caring team. What really disheartens though me is the amount of theft taking place. A variety of goods frequently goes missing, from a dolls house worth about £100 to a t-shirt selling for about £1.95. Today I learnt that a beautiful leather jacket had been stolen, after being on the shop floor for less than 10 minutes. If sold it would have earned the charity about £40 and when new would have probably cost 4 times that amount, maybe even more. Does the thief intend to wear it or sell it on E-bay?

It is no good my saying, "I cannot believe this!" because unfortunately I do believe it, I see it all too often. What is it about those committing theft that makes them take from a charity shop and so take from those much more in need than them?

In this economic climate most of us have to tighten our belts, but to steal from a charity! Well, need I say more? I know many Newtonians will be shocked at this letter. I have lived here since 1978 and know most of us to be honest and decent. I have met many such people while living and working on the town. Those who give to Sue Ryder Care do not do so to allow thieves to have a profitable time. They donate because they believe in the good work the charity does. Remember that next time you feel like helping yourself remember the words my Gran used to say . . . "HE'LL GET HIS COME UPANCE". Name and address supplied

Newton Aycliffe FC staged a hugely-successful fundraising evening with two North-East football legends last weekend. More than 150 guests were entertained by former Newcastle star John Beresford and Sunderland legend Kevin Ball (pictured with Aycliffe coach and ex-Sunderland player Brian Atkinson), inside a huge marquee outside Newton Aycliffe Sports Club, last Friday night. The football legends were highly entertaining, while comedian Jimmy Bright also proved a big hit, stepping in at the last minute to replace Rudi West.

Gary Farley, the club's chairman, said: "Every single person in the marquee had a hugely enjoyable night, so from that point of view it was a resounding success. "The eventual turnout was a little disappointing, but it was still enough for us to generate some much-needed funds for the football club, thanks largely to local lad Ross Turnbull, who donated a number of items for the auction, which raised a

little over £1,000. "I'd like to again thank everyone who attended on the night and everyone who supported it. We have proved yet again that we're more than capable of hosting large-scale events and pulling them off, and those who decided not to bother going certainly missed out." Meanwhile, Aycliffe stepped their pre-season up a gear this week when they held Northern League Division One big spenders Spennymoor Town to a 3-3 draw in front of 285 people at Moore Lane Park on Tuesday night. Paul Broome, Mark Wood and Dan Mellanby were all on target to cause a bit of an upset against Spennymoor, hot favourites to win the Northern League title this coming season, who only drew level with a late equaliser from the penalty spot. "It was a good exercise for us and a good gauge to see where we're at," said boss Allan Oliver. "Spennymoor are a quality side and we needed a big test before we started the season off. Thankfully we did OK – we still have a lot to do, but it was very encouraging."

Aycliffe claimed their first win of the pre-season last Saturday with an 8-0 victory at home to Wigan Robin Park, of the North-West Counties League, in front of just over 100 people. Michael Cairns (2), Philip Caley (2), Paul Broome (2), Mark Wood and Elliot Gardner were all on the scoresheet. Aycliffe continue their preparations for an historic, inaugural Northern League campaign with another home pre-season friendly against former Wearside League rivals Teesside Athletic this Saturday (August 1st), kick-off 3pm, before the season curtain-raiser at home to Hebburn Town next Saturday. Parking at Tesco's

In response to the article regarding wasp treatments being charged by Durham County Council.

As reported in the last edition, they are the ones responsible for delivering pest control.

When we were under a Borough Council, there was indeed a "free" service for pest control to council tenants, housing associations, private tenants, & owner occupiers, but this responsibility falls on Durham County Council, hence the charge.

I have been a pest controller in Newton Aycliffe (private) for the past 21 years and have come across this problem (since the council change over) where elderly residents and council tenants are being charged for wasp treatments.

Most people have been told by the Council to pay over the phone via credit card, or call into the council offices and pay in advance.

They are being told that it can take up to 10-14 days before they come out to deal with the problem, but there are people out there that don't have a credit card, nor do they have transport to go to the council offices to pay this charge, so just how are they to pay?

It really saddens me to read an article like this, especially as the person concerned was blind.

Has this council no respect or sympathy at all?

I was called out to treat for Bees in an elderly gentleman's home only last week by a nurse on call, and responded within 10 minutes to find the gentleman's kitchen full of swarming bees. After reassuring the gentleman, he asked me how much? My answer was "Nothing" as I'm only to glad

to help in an emergency.” And do you know that after the job was done I was really happy with myself, knowing this gentleman would sleep peacefully that night. I would like to believe that in cases like these it’s good to help others. Yes, I’m in business to make a living, but it makes me happy to

help when I can. If you feel you are getting no where with the council, or you don't know what to do next, look for alternative pest control. Please don't try and destroy a wasp nest by yourself without proper equipment and protection.

COUNTY COUNCILLORS VOTE THEMSELVES AN INCREASED ALLOWANCE

An independent panel has recommended a new range of allowances for the roles and responsibilities undertaken by Members of Durham County Council.

In its submission for Local Government Reorganisation in 2007, the former Durham County Council suggested Members receive a basic allowance of £20,000 per annum when it came into being on 1 April of this year, replacing the former county council and seven district councils.

However, the Independent Remuneration Panel has recommended that the 126 ward members of the region's biggest authority should receive a basic allowance of £13,300.

By not pursuing the original submission for allowances, savings of over £1 million will be made by Durham County Council if the panel's recommendations are accepted.

In reaching this decision, the panel gathered evidence from a range of councils, from meetings with elected Members and reviewing the expected range of responsibilities for Members. The panel felt strongly that it would be difficult to ignore the wider economic climate

and general heightened awareness of allowances paid to those holding public office but recognised the significant responsibility and roles undertaken by Members of the new council.

The new allowances were considered against other comparable authorities which identified a range of allowances up to £15,816 per annum.

The County Council will now consider the Independent Remuneration Panel's conclusions and recommendations when it meets on 31 July.
