No Public Toilets in Town Centre Plans

Great Aycliffe Residents' Association obtained the following statement under the "Freedom of Information Act"

Your request for information on public toilet provision at Newton Aycliffe Library, has been considered and I can advise you as follows.

Newton Aycliffe Town Centre is privately owned by a company called Freshwater. The redevelopment proposals were the subject of public consultation more than a year ago and this included a phasing of certain parts of the centre. The County Council is involved with the relocation of the library both on a temporary basis and a permanent basis.

The re-modelling of the Leisure Centre is approximately 3-5 years away in the draft programme and this depends on other matters being completed in the meantime.

The question of toilet provision has only been discussed in general and has not reached the stage where this would be discussed in the context of the Leisure Centre development.

This is the Way to Run a Council

Dear Sir,
A maverick Mayor elected after promising to slash council spending, clear the streets of jobs and ditch politically correct services, is the torchbearer for how towns should be run. On his first morning as Mayor of Doncaster, Peter Davies cut his salary from £73,000 to £30,000 then closed the council's newspaper for "peddling politics on the rates". Now three weeks into his job, Mr. Davies is pressing ahead with plans he hopes will see the number of

town councillors cut from 63 to just 21, saving taxpayers £800,000. Mr. Davies said: "If 100 senators can run the United States of America, I can't see how 63 councillors are needed to run Doncaster". He has withdrawn Doncaster from the Local Government Association and the Local Government Information Unit, saving another £200,000. Mr. Davies said, "They are just talking shops. Doncaster is in for some serious unwinning. We are twinned with probably nine other cities around the world and it is just for people to fly off and have a binge at the council's expense".

The mayor's chauffeur-driven car has also been axed by Mr. Davies and the driver given another job. Mr. Davies, born and bred in Doncaster, swept to power in the May election with 24,244 votes as a candidate for the English Democrats, a party that wants tight immigration curbs, an English Parliament and a law forcing every public building to fly the flag of St. George. He has promised to end council funding for

Doncaster's International Women's Day, Black History Month and the Lesbian, Gay, Bisexual and Transgender History Month. He said, "Politicians have got completely out of touch with what people want. We need to cut costs. I want to pass on some savings I make in reduced taxes and use the rest for things we really need, like improved children's services". Mr. Davies has received messages from well-wishers across the country and abroad as news of his no-nonsense approach spreads. Now it's our chance to spread this most sensible way to run a Council. Are we Getting Our Share of £162m?

Dear Sir,
 Re: County Council £162 investment next year.

The election of Councillors to the Unitary Authority should have resulted in Aycliffe being better represented which is why when I stood myself. I tried to impress upon residents the importance of voting for people who will represent you well. The £162 million announcement made on the front page last week only highlighted bad news for here. We have eight County Councillors but not one sits on the County Council Cabinet which might explain the lack of investment in Aycliffe next year, apart from the Library. We have 26,000 residents, yet we appear to have been treated as some tiny backwater village.

I can't get worked up about this announcement, but what I can get worked up about is the £68 million earmarked for services for children and young people. It's not the question of it being deserved or not but rather the lack of any semblance of services for elderly people! There is a definite lack of interest in our elderly people, in particular the Cubby which was

supposed to be part of phase 1 of the new town centre.

I am not alone in tackling this issue as I have the full support of Bob Fleming Leader of the Town Council and a large number of experienced councillors who have also indicated their support for immediate action for the Cubby.

Instead of making the Cubby a priority, our elderly residents have to suffer the indignity of sharing a delapidated hut to socialise and hold meetings.

They should get a suitable place of their own and I share their bitter frustrations at being denied one. The lease for the land on which the Cubby stands is owned by Durham County Council who could make it happen if they so wished. The questions needs to be asked of those people who represent the town and should be making the Council sit up and take notice of the needs of the elderly people here!

It is vital Aycliffe Unitary Authority Councillors get themselves together? They must demand that DCC provide a purpose built building for the Cubby on the original land which DDC owns. This would

give them an ideal opportunity to show their worth. It's all very well saying when I get on the Unitary Authority I will work for you, when the voting and meeting records tell a different story.

In the early 1990s Fiona chaired the Druridge Bay campaign to stop nuclear power and sand extraction on the Northumberland coast. She then moved to work for the Liberal Democrats, firstly as a press/political officer and then until 2004 as a parliamentary researcher and press officer to Alan Beith MP. In 2001, Fiona acted as an International Polling Station Supervisor in the elections in Kosovo, working for the Organisation for Security and Cooperation in Europe (OSCE).

Fiona was first elected as a Liberal Democrat Member of the European Parliament



for the North East of England in June 2004. In June 2009, Fiona was re-elected as an MEP for the North East for a second term. She currently heads the delegation of UK Liberal Democrat MEPs in Brussels.

UNIVERSAL PHONE CHARGER + CUTS WILL BENEFIT EVERYONE

It happens all the time - you forget your phone charger but cannot borrow a friend's because it's not the right type. But soon this nightmare will be over. Under pressure from the European Commission the ten leading manufacturers of mobile phones have agreed that from next year they will all use the same type of charger. According to North East MEP Fiona Hall, it was the threat of legal action which forced phone makers to see sense. The Liberal Democrat Euro-MP described the current confusion of electrical connections used to power the 70 million mobile phones

in use in Britain as a waste of money and resources. "This outcome shows how effective it is to have a single European market. No one country alone could have brought this about, but collectively it has been possible to bang heads together and secure a long overdue change for the better." The new charger will be based on the familiar micro-USB cable already used in some mobile phones. And there is more good news for mobile phone users going on holiday this summer, as the European Parliament has forced substantial cuts on the price of text messaging and other data roaming services

whilst abroad. From July, the price of a text message sent from abroad will fall to just €0.11 (9p) and the cost of outgoing phone calls will be restricted to €0.43 (35p) a minute excluding VAT. Incoming phone calls can only be charged at €0.19 (16p) a minute, excluding VAT. Said Fiona: "These new cuts to mobile phone tariffs will substantially reduce the cost for North East people on holiday within the EU. "Mobile phone providers failed to make sufficient price cuts voluntarily so it has been necessary to force them to offer more transparency and cheaper services."

THE SMELL RETURNS

The awful smell coming off a farmer's field on the Eldon Road hit the town again last weekend. There were complaints a few weeks ago and we thought the problem had been resolved, but we had lots of calls this week asking if the gut retching smell could be stopped. We are aware that similar problems have occurred at other farms near Darlington and the Borough Council have taken action with statutory nuisance notices issued to the

farmer who must discontinue spreading the waste which produces such a disgusting, putrid smell. Failure to comply could result in legal action being taken as the Council are taking the matter very seriously. We need Durham County Council to do the same as they admit to having received several complaints. However an officer informed our local Councillors that the Environmental Health Department are unable to do anything about it.

They were advised that spraying would begin at Eldon. It is treated sewage (now that it can no longer be dumped at sea it is being sprayed on the land) and complies with all the necessary policy and procedures. A meeting is convened for September with representatives covering the North of England to see if something can be done to amend the procedures governing the spraying. Darlington Council are not waiting and have taken action now when it is needed.

The Electoral Commission, the independent elections watchdog, is reminding potential voters that now's the time to make sure you are on the electoral register ahead of the forthcoming General Election and English local elections. Local authorities are

currently sending out registration forms to households across the country to make sure the registers are up to date so that everyone who is entitled to vote can do so.

"More people vote in General Elections than in other UK elections - but you can't vote if you're not on the electoral register," says Electoral Commission Chief Executive, Peter Wardle.

"Our next General Election must be held by June 2010, so everyone should take a few minutes to complete the registration form when it arrives. Remember: you're not automatically entitled to vote just because you pay council tax or have voted before. Make sure nothing stops you from having your say on who represents you".

I refer to comments made by two correspondents Cllr Gerald Lee and Mr Barry Cox in which they both accuse me of not checking my facts on the Minimum Wage.

Can I refer them to the Employment Opportunities Bill sponsored by no less than 12 Tory MP's with the support of David Cameron should they win the next election. Cameron has stated: "all good things must come to an end - the minimum wage being one of them".

I quote from Hansard the official minutes of Parliament as follows: -

Employment Opportunities Bill

A Bill to introduce more freedom, flexibility and opportunity for those seeking employment in the public and private sectors.

Section 2 of this Bill National minimum wage opt out clause (1) any person who would otherwise qualify for entitlement to the national minimum wage, as defined in the National Minimum Wage Act 1998 (c. 39) may elect to opt out from such entitlement. This would amount to employer's actually inviting people who are working to opt out, in effect forcing them not to accept the minimum wage.

The Bill received the first


reading on the 10th February 2009 introduced by Mr Christopher Chope and is now rescheduled after the Parliamentary recess.
