ELECTORAL COMMISSION MAKES BIG ERROR ON BOUNDARY CHANGES

One Town Ward Missed Completely

The Boundary and Electoral Commission are recommending that for 2013 the Great Aycliffe area be represented by 7 Unitary Councillors in accordance with representations made by Great Avcliffe Town Council and the Great Aycliffe Residents Association, (GARA).

The only real change is that part of Shildon which also shared an extra councillor with Newton Aycliffe will no longer be included. Middridge will come in with Newton Aycliffe and the wards will be Aycliffe North, the Dales & Middridge a two member division, Aycliffe Central a threemember division, Aycliffe East a two-member division (7 in all). This proposal makes sense and seems to be welcome by all interested parties.

For the Great Aycliffe Parish review (Great Aycliffe Town Council) the Council were seeking just 3 wards each running with the Unitary Council wards with 13, 8 and 9 Councillors respectively for the 3 wards, (30 Councillors for the Town Council).

But the Electoral Commission and the Boundary Commission have rejected this in favour of no change to 8 wards and 30 Councillors, remaining basically the same. This is in line with the Great Avcliffe Residents Association

But eagle eyed, former Mavor Of Aycliffe, Arun Chandran, who drafted the GARA case to them, has pointed out to the Commission the glaring error that the Council is currently 8 wards and 30 Councillors. Arun has notified them immediately of this administrative error so that they can correct it. The report and map covering the Great Aycliffe Parish will have to be re drafted! He has also alerted the Town Council of the error. 





partnership has resulted in the lowest incidents of fly-tipping for four years. However, last year there were still more than 7, 600 reported incidents, and that's not acceptable. Not only is this a crime and blight on our landscape, it costs a great deal to clean up and, in some instances, can have severe environmental consequences

Together Durham County Council and the Environment Agency will use their powerful partnership to map out flytipping hotspots, carry out surveillance and then pursue prosecutions using all available legislation

as well."

The Portfolio Holder for Strategic Environment, Cllr Brian Stephens says dealing with this issue is a high priority, "We already know by working with the Environment

Agency on this we can reduce this countywide problem, and if anyone is in any doubt, here is some hard evidence. Last year we investigated more than 1,340 incidents, issued 380 formal warnings, with the police getting involved on 33 occasions. In addition, 37 files were submitted for prosecution decision, leading to court action or fines.'

Kate Halka, the Environment Agency's Swat Fly-tipping project manager said: "We will continue to work with Durham County Council to combat the issue of fly-tipping. The success of our joint working approach sends out a clear message to anyone thinking of fly-tipping. You are being watched, so dispose of your waste responsibly and within the law, or risk a criminal conviction."

Where are the Savings on Changing to Unitary?

Following on from my letter last month in Newton News, I have seen a survey regarding councils in the North East and the number of staff being paid

Newtonians will be interested to note that Durham County Council has the largest number of staff over that salary level with 97 employees earning a combined annual salary of over £8¼ million. This does not include unelected and unaccountable public sector quangos like the trust structure of the National Health Service where it has been reported recently that the annual cost of all quangos is currently £170 billion a year compared to £24 billion in 1997/8 when new Labour came to power.

The numbers are huge and its difficult for people to relate them to their everyday life, but knowing that the County Council have two people earning over £63,000 for every 5,000 residents and that quangos cost every man, woman and child in the country £3,000 each per year, helps to put it into some perspective.

The jury is still out on the success or otherwise of the local government reorganisation in County Durham and, as I have said before, it is important that politicians are held to account for the claims of savings that were promised would be achieved by the abolition of the Borough Council.

With all the latest media coverage on public sector cuts because of the cost of bailing out the banks, the huge reduction in the tax monies flowing into government and the growing public sector, it is vital that the emphasis is on cutting bureaucracy and quangos. Much like Lileen Cuthbertson letter in last week's Newton News, I would not like to see the most vulnerable people in our society suffering because of the need to reduce the scale and cost of the public sector. There are far more productive areas to concentrate on that will not have an adverse effect on people's lives.

Shaping the Future of Care

by our M.P. Phil Wilson

Government recently published the green paper "Shaping the Future of Care Together", which looks at the options facing us regarding the future care of the elderly. The document has led local residents to contact my office. I want to clarify that a green paper is a document published by the government when it wants to consult with the public on an issue of major change or of great importance before legislating. The green paper will not be voted on itself.

Why is "Shaping the Future of Care Together" important? In future 20% of people will need care that costs less than £1,000 during their retirement, but equally, 20% will need care that costs over £50,000, and people currently have no way of predicting their risk or

protecting against it.
When the current system was designed in 1948, life expectancy was 66 for men and 71 for women. Today it is 77 for men and 82 for women - and it is still rising. Today, more people are over the age of 65 than there are under the age of 18.

Care affects everybody and even if we do not yet need care ourselves, we know someone else who does or help pay for it through our taxes. Two thirds of women and half of all men will need help with ordinary daily life at some point.

The system will not be able to cope with the future care pressures in its current form and we need to reform the funding system. If we don't take action now there will be more and more people going without the care and support they need, with ever-greater uncertainty and unfairness for

families. The Government has suggested three options for funding a National Care Service which

need to be discussed, hence the

green paper. **By Partnership**, in that, everyone who qualified for care and support from the state would be entitled to have a set proportion for example, a quarter or a third – of their basic care and support costs paid for by the state. People who were less well-off would have more care paid for - for example, two-thirds – while the least well-off people would continue to get all their care for

By Insurance, by which, everyone would be entitled to have a share of their care and support costs met, just as in the Partnership model. But this system would go further to help people cover the additional costs of their care and support through insurance, if they wanted to. The state could play

different roles to enable this.

By a Comprehensive system everyone over retirement age who had the resources to do so would be required to pay into a State insurance scheme. The debate we need to have is about how we balance what it is fair for everyone to pay, against the need to protect some people against having to pay a huge cost. As this would be a significant reform, we would expect the introduction of the new National Care Service to be phased in over a number of
