## Washing Machines to be Made in Aycliffe

Ebac's New Facility Will Create 200 Jobs

Washing machine manufacturing is returning to the UK with a dedicated new production facility developed in the North East, creating more than 200 jobs. Around 4 million washing machines are bought in the UK each year, all of them imported. Ebac Group, the company establishing the new facility believes its plans can provide an economic boost by replacing those imports with appliances made in the UK. Ebac Group Ltd is to develop

the new products in a £7m venture, made possible by £1m from the Regional Growth Fund, announced today (19/10/12).

and air coolers, has spent recent months preparing the project and is now ready to start work, doubling the company's workforce. Ebac's Group Managing

Director, Pamela Petty said: "This exciting new venture is a huge boost to manufacturing in the North East of England, because it opens up a new market for us, creating jobs and making County Durham home to the UK's only washing machine manufacturing facility.

"We have spent months exploring not only the feasibility of manufacturing washing machines, but also

the processes involved and we very confident of having high quality, competitive product on the market within the next two years. The money from the Regional Growth Fund makes all of this possible and will quickly reap returns

and will quickly reap returns for the economy.

"It's good for Ebac, it's good for the North East and it's good for the country."

Ebac chairman John Elliott added: "During my 50 years in manufacturing, the trend has been for jobs to be lost in the North East. It is great to have this chance to bring to have this chance to bring sustainable jobs for County Durham people. "If we are to resolve the UK's

economic problems, we need to start making things again and support for projects such as this is a huge step in the right direction."

The successful implementation of a washing machine manufacturing facility will also prepare the way for Ebac to produce other domestic

appliances in the future.

Mr Elliott said: "The new facility will definitely be situated in County Durham, which has been the home of Ebac since I founded the company in 1973. This has a strong and willing workforce upon which we know we can draw to man the new operations and my decision to place the company into a Foundation earlier this year was influenced by my desire for the business to stay

The Olympics ideals of respect, excellence and friendship have underpinned the values of our school and so we are proud to celebrate our achievements with the Olympic torch, carried by Greenfield student Sam Dawson, on permanent display at school. These recent celebrations of all that the school achieves for its students was endorsed by OFSTED inspectors who reported of Greenfield Community College, this is a good school.

## Good Inspection Report from Ofsted

Greenfield Community College was inspected by OFSTED on 3rd – 4th October 2012. Inspectors observed teaching and learning in 30 lessons together with a number of brief visits to other lessons. In total around 15 hours of teaching were observed.

Inspectors met groups of students as well as staff and governors. They observed the school's work and examined a range of documentation, including in relation to the safeguarding of students. They also scrutinised information relating to students achievement, behaviour and attendance. Their verdict was that the overall effectiveness of the school is good.

In reporting on achievement the judgement was

They observed that students make good progress and examination results have improved. Students identified with special educational needs typically make at least as much progress as other students. They are well supported within and outside of lessons. Students benefit from participation in a wide range of extra-curricular activities. Sport and the visual and performing arts are particularly

Inspectors judged the quality of teaching is typically good and sometimes outstanding saying that students respond well to the high expectations of teachers. When looking at behaviour Inspectors reported that students are considerate and well mannered. Behaviour around the school site is good and students respond positively to the school's high expectations and are proud of the school and its orderly and pleasant site. Behaviour in lessons is usually good and sometimes outstanding. Students have a good understanding of how to stay safe. Incidents of bullying are rare and are dealt with rapidly and robustly by staff.

Inspectors also reported on the leadership and management of Greenfield. They judged "this is a very well led school. The headteacher and leadership team have taken effective action to raise standards and the school is in a good position to continue its improvement". They particularly commented that, "The Time4Success initiative is proving highly successful in enhancing students' reading and literacy skills and in raising their spiritual, moral, social and cultural developments. School leaders are rigorous in monitoring all areas of the school's work including students' progress and the quality of teaching.

Ofsted explained that a good school, such as Greenfield, "is effective in delivering outcomes that provide well for all its students' needs". Students are well prepared for the next stage of their education, training or employment".

Greenfield Headteacher David Priestley said "We are very proud of what we are achieving together as a school community and will continue to strive for even higher standards.





## Spooks and Ghouls in Your Car?

There's more than just spooks and ghouls to send shivers down your spine this Halloween. The transition from summer motoring to dark, early autumn mornings can be equally scarey. Adjusting to the changing conditions can be difficult, it's all too easy finding your self in a situation which could easily have been

avoided. Don't be found wanting, saying... 'I should have'.
On cold, dark, autumn mornings discovering a flat battery can be a nightmare, yet the ensuing dissruption can easily be avoided. If your battery is more than five years old, check if it's coming to the end of its life. Over the wettest summer on recored your battery may already have shown warning signs. Don't wait until it's too late, the first frost will be sure to catch you out. Owning a set of jump leads and battery chargers is essentail at this time of year. Also, remember to check your wiper blades and replace every two to three years.

When it comes to tyres, be sure and look for any signs of buldges

or cuts. Ensure tyre pressuers are checked regularly. It's also important to check the depths of your tyres.

Ramseys garage recommend you repalce your tyres once the tread falls below 3mm.

Due to consecutive bad winters, more drivers are now choosing to change their car's tyres to all weather tyres. Consider how small changes in the weather can lead to big changes on our roads. Morning dew can lead to wet leaves on minor roads, creating slippery conditions. Sharp frosts can be leathel, drive with care at all times.

Windscreen damage is more visual, but putting off reparing those small chips can lead to bigger problems later. Repair any chips from summer as soon as possible. Small chips can quickly turn to more serious damage especially when the temperature begins to fall.

I can't stress enough the importance of using good quality screen wash, always make sure it's fully topped up - we use far more during winter. There's nothing worse than driving down a dark motorway discovering your water's empty.

Last but not least, think about the conditions. Leave plenty of

time for your journey and consider the space between you and the next car in front. During autumn the low morning sun can also lead to long tailbacks with sudden braking. Drive with the conditions in mind.

## What Are You doing on Guy Fawkes Night?

County Durham and Darlington Fire and Rescue Service is asking the public to help them save lives this Guy Fawke's night. Senior Community Safety Officer Andrew Allison said, "The Fire and Rescue Service receive an increase in calls during the period leading up to November 5th.

They are often to extinguish bonfires that have been built in dangerous places or that aren't being supervised by adults. Dealing with these types of incident can often delay us from attending real emergencies where there may be lives at risk.

We are asking the public to not have bonfires at all and to visit an organised fireworks display. Buying fireworks is expensive and you will never create the kind of display seen at organised events.

It is very easy for injuries to happen around bonfires. when younger children are involved and they also tend to annoy neighbours due to the smell of the smoke getting into houses. Our advice is – don't have a bonfire!"

If you do decide to have a bonfire and set off some fireworks then the Fire and Rescue Service ask that you follow some simple guidance.

• Always follow the firework

code and read carefully the advice on each firework.

- Only buy fireworks over the counter from reputable retailers.
- Only burn timber on your bonfire. Plastics, laminates and other man made materials will give off potentially toxic gases that could cause health problems and will damage the environment.
- Supervise the bonfire at all times and make sure you have some way of putting the fire out - buckets of water, garden hose, etc.
- Keep children away from the fire and supervise them at all
- Let your neighbours know beforehand so they can close doors and windows
- Don't try to use petrol or other accelerants to get the bonfire started – it may get out of control very quickly.
  The Firework Code can be

It would be very interesting to see what Arriva's reaction would be should somebody take the initiative and actually start a small bus service around the areas that they have withdrawn from, after all 300 signatures on a petition can't be wrong!
