Hitachi Sign Contract to Build Train Factory

Hitachi has signed the contract with Merchant Place Developments for the construction and fit-out of a rolling stock manufacturing plant in Newton Aycliffe.

The contract paves the way for the construction of Hitachi's first train factory in Europe, which represents an investment of £82 million to create its state-of-the-art manufacturing hub in the North East of England. Hitachi Rail Europe receives a £4 million grant by the Department for Business, Innovation and Skills to support the build of the factory.

Alistair Dormer, Executive Chairman and Chief Executive Officer of Hitachi Rail Europe said: "The close of contract with Merchant Place Development signals a new phase in Hitachi's commitment to the British rail industry.

By investing substantially in our train factory, we are creating employment opportunities for a large number of engineers and technicians in the North East of England, which has a strong tradition of

engineering skills. We are keen to fill our order books, building trains here in the UK - for use in Britain and for exporting to continental Europe."

The factory will initially be used to build the Super Express Trains for the Great Western Main Line and the East Coast Main Line, with the potential to be used for other orders such as building Crossrail rolling stock in the facility, should Hitachi Rail Europe be the successful bidder. Hitachi places great emphasis on employing locally where possible and the factory will create long-term employment for 730 people. This figure includes a Research & Development department. It is expected that 200 jobs will be created during the construction phase of the factory.

"This is the formal element of bringing Hitachi Rail Europe to the North East. We have taken the design of the plant to a detailed stage and have been in discussions with suppliers and contractors so that we are ready to move ahead with the development programme," says Geoff Hunton, Director, Merchant Place Developments. "I believe this says much about our region, our skills base and the connectivity to Europe and beyond through our ports in particular. It also says a great deal about our investors who have been very loyal to this project since we first acquired Amazon Park five

years ago.

It is these investors who financed the purchase of the site rather than the traditional institutional funding route and without those investors we would not be where we are today. It is also a tribute to the team effort that brought this very significant inward investment to Newton Aycliffe notably through the help we have had from Durham County Council,

Students Receive Letter from Baroness

NATIONAL SMILE MONTH 20th May – 20th June

FACT – artificial sweeteners are "stickier" than sugar, causing acids in man made drinks to adhere to teeth for longer resulting in more damage.

BEWARE of drinks labelled "diet", "low sugar" or "no added sugar".

READ the small print on man made drinks – culprit chemicals to avoid are phosphoric acid and citric acid. Sugars will be labelled ending in – ose, for example glucose, sucrose and fructose.

TOP TIPS for keeping a healthy, happy and confident smile are as follows:-

Be well informed about threats to the health of your teeth and gums.

Ask questions about the health of your mouth at your regular dental examination and hygiene appointments.

Give bacteria the brush off, spend 2 minutes twice a day and get your dentist to show you how to remove plaque thoroughly and effectively.

Brush teeth before meals, snacks to remove bacteria that will produce acid from sugar.

Business Durham and cross-party political support headed by Phil Wilson, MP for Sedgfield.” The close of contract between Hitachi Rail Europe and Merchant Place Developments enables the developer to award further contracts for the build of the plant. Currently, an archaeological exploration is being carried out on the site, which will take approximately three to four months. Hitachi Rail Europe is keen to ensure that any historical remains are uncovered and preserved. Construction of the plant is expected to start at the end of 2013, with the factory scheduled to go into production in 2016. The Super Express Trains will go into full passenger service in 2017. The site in Newton Aycliffe best fits the company’s business requirements for its factory, including good access by road, rail and ship, highly skilled workforce in the vicinity. Since contract award by the DfT, Hitachi Rail Europe has been working with Merchant Place Development and the architects to design all aspects of the factory, so that further contracts can be awarded to sub-contractors over the next few months.

The u13's lost away to Darlington at Feethams, chasing 116 for victory in 20 overs, Aycliffe managed to reach a creditable 77 for 5 with good contributions coming from Adam Lamb and Jack Lowery, who both batted well to each score 21 runs.

Contaminated Fuel

In February this year I purchased £40 of diesel from Tesco Newton Aycliffe and my car broke down within 3 miles. A lengthy investigation by the repair garage and a diesel engine specialist eventually diagnosed that all 4 diesel injectors had been contaminated. The garage retained samples of the fuel, the fuel filter and produced a written report. My repair bill was £1000. I contacted Tesco Customer Services who dismissed my complaint out of hand. I replied asking them to investigate properly and with an offer to supply them with a sample of the suspect fuel, the fuel filter and the specialists report. Tesco have sent 2 further letters dismissing my complaint on the grounds that no-one else has complained, “so it can’t be their fault”. They refuse to investigate the matter and ignore my evidence and questions.

Incredibly the most recent letter ends by stating that they hope I will continue to shop with them. I feel sure that their refusal to take my complaint seriously, is because they do not want to encourage others to think a complaint about fuel quality could be successful. Now that I am aware that other customers have also experienced the same problem and received similarly dismissive treatment from Tesco, I feel that the customers of Tesco should be made aware of the risk of purchasing fuel from this outlet. I’m also wondering whether there is any way that those of us who have been affected by this can find a route to achieve redress from Tesco. 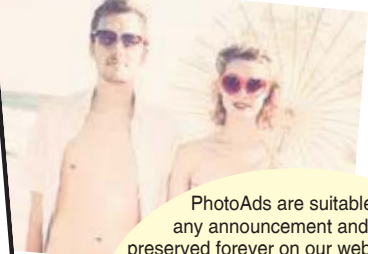
