from Darlington, are retiring after a 22-year fostering career. They have been with Reach Out Care, which also has offices in Billingham, for seven years.

"We didn't start to foster until our own two children were grown up – I was late 40's and Dave was in his early 50's," said Diane.
"We actually adopted a

sibling group of six – we just about emptied one of the children's homes in the area. There was one little girl left - she was not related to the others and we always felt for her. We saw an article about her three years later and adopted her too.

"We then went on to adopt another sibling group of four but we have fostered many, children and also had several mother and baby placements. We have enjoyed a sometimes challenging but rewarding career as foster carers."

Peter and Karen Weaver, Newton from Aycliffe, received a ten year foster carer service award and Lorraine McAloon, one of the agency's social workers, also received a ten year service award.

"I started out as a foster carer with Reach Out Care, then became a support worker, then a fostering officer in the team and the company supported me to fulfil my dream of becoming social worker," said Lorraine.

The agency is the only one in the region to have Investors in People Gold accreditation.

## Cooking Oil Recycling | Visit from the Dentist Makes Durham Greener

Durham County Council is encouraging residents to recycle their used cooking oil at 12 household waste recycling centres throughout the county.

The new initiative, organised by the council in partnership with waste contractor HW Martin Waste Ltd, will enable residents to dispose of their used oil in a safe and environmentally friendly manner in specially designed collection tanks.

Cllr Brian Stephens, Cabinet member for neighbourhoods and local partnerships, said: "It's really important that people dispose of cooking oil safely and not pour it down the sink, because it can block drains, get into watercourses and threaten wildlife.

"By recycling the oil it helps to reduce landfill waste and produces an alternative energy source which is cleaner and greener."

Once the oil is collected, it is naturally recovered by eco-firm Living Fuels into a clean, green bio-liquid for use in renewable energy facilities which produce carbon neutral electricity for the National



Murphy. Living director, Fuels' operations commented: "We're delighted that people in Durham will be collecting their used cooking oil and recycling residents can be proud that they will be helping to improve the environment for us all.

"Just one litre of used cooking oil can power a laptop for 160 hours, or make 240 cups of tea. One full tank can power the average home for an entire year.'

Hodges, manager at HW Martin Waste Ltd, continued: "We are really

pleased that we've been able to bring cooking oil recycling to the household recycling centres since we took over their management in June.

"It makes a huge difference to local residents wanting to dispose of the oil in an environmentally friendly way and reduce the effects of pollution." Further information about

# West Park Lakes Explained

The West Park lakes were developed, originally, as boating lakes — when I first came to the town you could still watch people sailing their (amazing) models.

Even then, however, there was a problem with weed. The lakes are shallow and the water becomes warm. Meanwhile, the water is nutrient-rich:- fertilisers from farmers' fields, hydrocarbon runoff from local estates, bread people feed to the birds, and those birds' droppings, in that warm water, create an explosion of weed and algae growth in summer.

When I was elected to the Environment Committee in the late

1990s, the Town Council still periodically drained and cleaned the lakes, but it was an unsatisfactory business. The tractors cracked the base of the lake and aquatic life was destroyed. The watersoaked weed weighed so many hundreds of tons that it could not be transported away immediately, but had to be left to drain and dry out ... hence the awful smell.

Today, given new regulations about health & safety and movement & tipping of controlled waste as required under the Environmental Protection Act, it would be inconceivably expensive to clear the lakes - when we sought a price recently, we could not get even an estimate.

The turning point was environmental. One year, a pioneer duck had managed to nest by the lakes and, to protect the ducklings, local residents physically prevented Council workers from opening the sluice to drain the water. In a time of changing attitudes, we decided to turn the lakes from an artificial feature into a natural resource.

Instead of clearing the lakes, we began putting in a retardant - a bacteria which devours the nutrients. It is perfectly natural and absolutely safe. As you can see, it does not work perfectly – especially in a very warm summer such as this – but it does reduce plant growth.
The lakes, therefore, have become an ecological feature in their

own right, and part of the Council's biodiversity offer. When I inspected the lakes last week, they were beautiful ... as long as you were looking at them as an environmental, not an artificial, asset. The mats of weed covered less than half the surface, and were multi-coloured; if you had chanced upon such a pond on a country walk you would have taken a photograph! The water, meanwhile, was crystal clear, and teeming with all kinds of swimming things. Dragon flies and damson flies danced around the edges, and the lakes were covered with ducks, geese, seagulls and swans

Nature left to itself, of course, does not look manicured, and I can appreciate why people wanting an ornamental feature are disappointed. Every year we get a few complaints, some from people who are politically motivated, but others from people who simply do not understand what we are trying to do with the lakes. Last week's letter in the Newton News was typical, combining misunderstanding with misinformation. May I assure readers that there has NEVER been poisonous algae in the lakes. We did not take the boats off the lake because of the weed; we

revenue-take had fallen to pennies, we were paying thousands for staff – in a world anxious about child safety, it was impossible to get properly-checked, suitably-qualified staff, for just a few weeks, for a temporary unskilled job at holiday time.

Thus the lakes represent a success, not a failure. They are not a rare ecological resource but, given the location and the limitations, they are a remarkable achievement. If anyone wishes to speak further about this, either myself or the town council's qualified Environment Officer would be happy to visit to explain further. And – if anyone has a good idea as to how we might reduce the weed without wrecking the wildlife it supports - we will always be prepared to consider it. Apparently turning the upper lake into a reed-bed would work, but we decided that the cure was worse than the weed! Personally, I think that what we've got is the best we can have.

Beyond that, I really don't know how to address the perennial problem of people who go to the park wanting a disinfected boating lake, and who jump to the wrong conclusion that the lakes are 'dirty and diseased'

Perhaps people reading this letter can help to spread the word that the lakes are actually clean and eco-healthy! Counc. John Clare

Travel during school holidays is more expensive than any other period and from September, 2013, new government legislation will come into effect that will obligate schools to reject holiday requests for children to be taken out of school during term time.

Dear Sir, The letter in Newton News (week ending 9th August) about building on the Cobblers Hall Wetland reminded me of a meeting for local residents held by Sedgefield Borough Council

It was to establish a group of "Friends of The Moor Local Nature Reserve" to keep their eyes on the proposed facilities for this designated Local Nature Reserve (LNR).

We were given a glossy leaflet showing a plan of the reserve with fencing and viewing platforms.

The idea was to use the run-off from the new housing area in a 'SUDS' or 'sustainable urban drainage scheme'. This was to involve an underground storage chamber for any rapid run-off from the housing roads and

paved areas which would slowly release its water to the wetland keeping it healthy by preventing it from flooding and drying out. The planning permission was granted by SBC in August 2006, but the housing got delayed. SBC were taken over by Durham County Council and The Moor hasn't been improved. In fact the Wetland seems to be drying out as it becomes more overgrown.

There is no longer any open water, the moorhen is no longer seen and the skylarks no longer use the field where the housing is to go. I don't know any details of the latest proposals in terms of drainage, the 'SUDS' and the future of the LNR. Hopefully DCC and the Developers have a plan! Graham Stevens,

## **NEW FINES FOR CARELESS DRIVERS**

Fixed penalty notices for careless driving offences such as middle lane hogging came into effect last Friday 16th August 2013.

Following a government consultation announced in June, the £100 fine will be introduced for a wide range of careless driving offences tailgating including middle lane hogging.
The IAM advise that in car

distractions that cause you to swerve or drive badly could lead to prosecution, you don't have to inconvenience other road users to be issued with a ticket. Some typical examples of careless driving are:

overtaking on the inside;
driving inappropriately close to another vehicle;

• inadvertently through a red light; driving

 emerging from a side road into the path of another vehicle;

 tuning a car radio; when the driver was avoidably distracted by this action;

• selecting and lighting a cigarette or similar when the driver was avoidably distracted by that use.

IAM chief executive Simon

Best said: "If the police target the worst and most persistent offenders this could be good news for road safety. If, however, it just becomes another numbers game with thousands of careless driving tickets issued then the impact will be limited.

The IAM believes that driver retraining courses have a bigger potential actually improve poor driving than simply issuing a standard fine and should always be offered as the first stage of prosecution.
