S.D.C. HANDICAP THE DISABLED

says Chairman of Swimming Club

TOMMY ELDRETT, newly appointed Chairman of the Swimming Club for the Disabled, stated today that Sedgefield District Council have little or no regard for disabled people in Newton Aycliffe.

In a strong protest to Newton News Mr Eldrett condemned the mean attitude of the Council which charges the club £475 a year for one hour a week pool time.

As a result he is obliged to beg money from various town organisations to pay the hire charge. "If it wasn't for the generosity of people at G.E.C., Tallents, the Inner Wheel, and

others, our disabled swimmers could not enjoy one of the few sporting activities available to them," said Tommy.

It has been the job of Tommy Eldrett, and before him his hard-working predecessor, Elsie Kennedy, to beg for the necessary cash to pay for the hire. "It is humiliating," said Mr Eldrett. "We are the only club for the Disabled in the North who have to pay to hire the pool and it adds insult to injury when you realise we use it at a time when the pool is not normally used," he added.

Tommy Eldrett has asked Newton News to bring the matter to the attention of our readers in the hope that public opinion can change the attitude of the District Council.

"Disabled persons need every assistance to participate in sporting activities. My time should

be spent in helping them enjoy the swimming and to encourage others to join or help. As it is I have the constant worry and humiliation of raising cash," said Tommy.

Mr Eldrett has requested free use of the pool, but has been told by Mr Mullins of SDC that he won't get it, and a terse reply from a member of the Recreation Committee that "Everybody pays."

It is a shame that some individuals in positions of influence cannot adopt a more humanitarian approach to their jobs. Is it reasonable to expect our District Council to make a gesture on behalf of the ratepayers in this "Year for the Disabled." Would there be a public outcry on this waste of ratepayers money?

Aren't there more instances of expenditure which the ratepayer would consider wasteful before the welfare of disabled people?

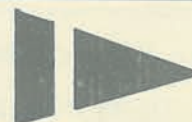

South West Durham Community Health Council represents the public of South West Durham, i.e. the area currently administered by Wear Valley District Council and Sedgefield District Council, in all aspects of health care in the National Health Service. Their headquarters are at 10 Market Place, Bishop Auckland. Tel. Bishop Auckland 5013.

Community Health Councils are a new feature of the National Health Service. They are totally independent and aim to obtain the best possible health services for each community. They are to represent your interests in the health service.

The Community Health Council will tell authorities what YOU — the local people — feel about the health services and press for improvements where you think there are deficiencies.

The Council will also tell you about improvements and major changes in services before they happen and ask for your opinions on the proposals.

You can assist by seeking the views of people within your sphere of influence on health care in South West Durham. Are hospital services, surgeries, clinics, dental, optical and pharmaceutical facilities adequate? How can they be improved from the public's point of view? Are there special problems involving the aged, mothers with children, the disabled, the mentally ill and mentally or physically handicapped etc? Are public transport facilities to and from health service premises adequate?

The Council will examine the way the Health Services function, to assess their effectiveness in meeting the requirements of the community.

Only by learning your needs and views can the Council hope to influence health care planning activity in South West Durham, and make it responsive to your needs.

The Community Health Council cannot investigate your individual complaint but we need your suggestions and criticisms and we can give you advice and help in making a complaint.
