RELIEF AS A.D.C

RUMOURS CONCERNING the possible closure of Churchill House, and the loss of local administration of the ADC's business to Peterlee have been squashed.

A re-organisation of Aycliffe and Peterlee Development Corporations will take place later this year with a change in structure based on both towns.

Neither town will become the HQ and the work of the Corporations will remain much as it is now but with a re-arranged departmental structure.

It is likely that there will be redundancies in both Aycliffe and Peterlee, including some within the Corporations' management

team, and details of these redundancies will be discussed with the staff unions.

The decision on re-organisation was taken at a special meeting of the Corporations' Board. followed a report to the Corporations by the former general manager of Washington Development Corporation, Steve Holley, who was asked to look at their structure with a view to advising on changes which should be made in the light of their likely dissolution in 1985.

Efficient

Following this a number of reorganisational options were prepared for the Board. These were designed to ensure that the Corporations' task of bringing industry to Aycliffe and Peterlee would be continued efficiently until the end of 1985, taking into account increases in staff turnover, reduction in manpower and the employment needs of the two communities.

Staff members and their trade union representatives have been briefed on the Board's decision and the details of the new structure will now be finalised. No date has yet been fixed for the re-
