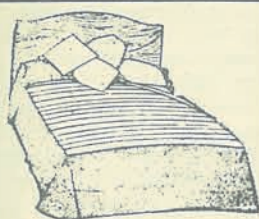

COMMUNITY RADIO PROBLEMS SOLVED

THE RECENT problems between the board of Aycliffe Community Radio and its manager have been solved, with Mike Searle being re-instated.

Mike was dismissed following a number of incidents which gave dissatisfaction.

The board re-considered the manager's position with the help of the National Union of Journalists. Mike has been made aware of

his mistakes and will continue in the job for which he was appointed.

The station has gone through a sticky period in the last few months with staff upsets.

It has not been helped by the

extra work involved in extending broadcasting hours and removal of premises.

Mike found he had to spend time on the air when he should have been selling advertising to bring in revenue the station desperately needs.

The chairman of the board, Granville Gibson, said he was delighted that Mike was back and that the air was cleared. "We now look forward to a more settled future," said Rev. Gibson.

And ACR has a lot going for it with the possibility of being granted a transmission licence this autumn. This will enable the station to be received by everyone in the area through every type of radio. There is also the chance they could pick up some lucrative advertising contracts.

But the chairman is still of the opinion that, in the end, the community will have to subsidise the radio, to some degree, through rates.

A recent survey showed 75

percent in favour of a levy to help finance ACR. "Our listening figures are excellent and the response to all we do is fantastic," said Rev. Gibson.

ACR is looking for a more active advisory panel and invite names of regular listeners from which to make the selection of members. If you are interested please send in your name and address.

AYCLIFFE ON WHEELS PROVES A SUCCESS

The ADC are delighted with the success of their "Aycliffe on Wheels" event.

Thousands of people made the trip to the industrial estate on a weekend which though blustery on Sunday kept mainly fair throughout the weekend.

The many exhibitions and events entertained the crowds and kept the industrial estate looking busy all the time.

The whole object was to promote the industrial estate and show outsiders the many advantages of operating from Aycliffe and trading with its tenants. Some businessmen have already benefited from the project, and a few have received orders.

As always on occasions like this there have been a few criticisms: poor publicity, lack of signs, events too far apart, insufficient toilet and refreshment facilities,

are among the main complaints.

All the comments made have been heeded by the organisers who promise to improve on the experience they have gained from this first attempt.

And it is good news to hear they are hoping for a similar event next year, but the final decision rests with the ADC board.

"It was a very successful event and I have every confidence, given the support of local industrialists, that we can use this event to the advantage of Aycliffe," said Ian Wiggott of the ADC.

It was apparent that not as many local firms took part in "Aycliffe on Wheels" as one would have expected — indeed some of our most prominent companies were conspicuous by their absence. It is hoped they will see the value of this occasion and at least give token support should Aycliffe on

Wheels be repeated.

The whole idea of using empty factory space should be exploited to the full.

There are various events which cannot be held in Aycliffe due to lack of suitable premises. It seems a good idea to show off factories by allowing them to be used by the community. It also serves to "knit-in" the industrial estate with the town.

Even outsiders could be invited to use the factories for exhibitions, trade fairs, etc. Aycliffe is ideally situated with easy access from major roads, rail and airports.

Visitors would benefit from the open spaces and easy car parking facilities so often poorly supplied in the normal exhibition centres.

The town would gain good publicity and in serving the visitors bring in extra cash.

Seventeen countries competed for the coveted prize at the Zakopane Folklore Festival.

"Northern Folk" is the brainchild of Phillip Conroy and is comprised of St. Leonard's Irish Dancers and Ceilidh Band from Silksworth, Sunderland — for Ireland; Members of the Newton Aycliffe Pipe Band — for Scotland; and the Kingsmen Sword Dancers from Newcastle University — for England.

Their last visit to Zakopane was in 1979, gaining several awards, but this year the "Golden Award" was the culmination of 2½ years of hard work and rehearsal by all the members.

Seventeen countries were repre-

sented, among them being Senelaga, Hispana, France, Italy, and the host country Poland. The Gold Award is for the best presentation of folklore, variety, content and continuity.
