"NEW LOOK" CORPORATION PLAN FOR 5,000 MORE JOBS

AYCLIFFE AND PETERLEE Development Corporations were married this week and together they pledged themselves to bring 5,000 new jobs to the new towns.

And £500,000 will be spent on promotion to fight off the competition.

Chairman Michael Straker outlined the intentions of the Aycliffe and Peterlee Development Corporations claiming they were the most ambitious ever considered in the region.

The following is an extract from the chairman's speech:

"It is clear that we all became rather complacent about job attraction when times were better," he said. "In fact in the new towns we were probably better organised than most to get companies in from the United States, Japan and Scandinavia.

"Now all that has changed. We have countries such as Eire marketing, and marketing highly competitively, all over the world. Wales and Scotland, with their

Development Agencies, are showing what they can do as well.

"We unhappily are still very fragmented in our approach. Every promotional agency seems to have a different system of dealing with an industrialist.

"Even our two new towns which have been closely linked for years have been marketed separately to an extent where it is certainly possible that a prospective industrialist who visited one town could be told nothing about the other — and could have been lost to the region as a result.

"We are putting our house in order by recruiting the additional marketing and promotional people we need to make our team one of

the most professionally strong in the country.

"And from today, all our efforts — and they are considerable, with £500,000 a year to spend on promotion — will be geared to marketing both towns together.

"We are far more likely to be able to meet the needs of an industrialist by offering a greater choice than we are by talking about only one town.


"This region is facing its hardest task ever in regaining the tens of thousands of jobs lost in the recession. Not only has unemployment soared here but the rest of the country and most of Western Europe is facing problems as well. If we are to succeed we must be able to compete with the best in other countries, regions and towns.

"I believe that we can now do that and take our message, not only throughout Britain, but to the

USA, Japan and Scandinavia, confident that, with the support of the other development agencies in the region, we can bring back results with 5,000 more jobs for this area."


Roller skating sessions organised at Boys Club

DERRICK FIRST PAST THE POST!

The first 'Winner' of the Aycliffe 1000 Guineas scheme to help new business start up has moved into a new factory on the industrial estate.

Derrick Cole, a former works manager, has taken the plunge on his own manufacturing kitchen work surfaces for trade and private customers — and is finding business so good that within a few days of starting up he has taken on his first employee.

Loric Worktops, his new company, started as just a dream six months ago.

"I live in Aycliffe and was works manager at a factory in North Yorkshire. I wanted to work for myself and thought I could see a market potential for the manufacture of industrial benches and kitchen worktops in the

region," said Derrick.

"But although I knew I wanted to be in business and knew what my product would be I really didn't have the business know-how to set up on my own.

Luckily Derek then heard about Aycliffe Development Corporation's Key Course — a training scheme to help and advise people wishing to go into business for themselves — and enrolled for the 20-week course.

"It gave me all the information I required and finally persuaded me that I could make it on my own," said Mr Cole. "And it was another Aycliffe scheme that got me started."

A few months ago, Aycliffe Development Corporation launched their "1000 guineas campaign" — where a small business taking a

new factory can have £1,050 worth of help in setting up. Expensive essentials like telephone and electricity connection charges, heating fuel, legal costs, stationery and a factory name plate are paid for by the Development Corporation.

"Money is very tight when you're starting a business," said Mr Cole. "The 1,000 guineas helped me a lot."

Now Loric Worktops is in business in a 2,000 square foot factory in Whitworth Drive, Aycliffe. But by no means has everything been done for Derek Cole. He has made up examples of the laminated, oak edged, and man-made marble kitchen worktops he will be manufacturing and showed them to kitchen centres throughout the region.

"The orders are starting to come in and I have taken on a young

trainee to help me out." Loric Worktops will also supply private customers and make up worktops to their specifications.

"More and more people are improving their homes and I think this is a sector of the market which will grow," said Mr Cole.

Garry Philipson, managing director of Aycliffe Development Corporation, said: "Loric Worktops is an example of the kind of small business that can be established given the right kind of interest and help by an agency such as ours."

"We have devoted a lot of time and effort to initiatives like Key Course and the 1,000 Guineas and clearly it is beginning to pay off."

"I believe that Derrick Cole will be the first of many businesses, that we have literally grown for ourselves, starting in Aycliffe."

Where are our take-away food shops?

Shildon has the highest ratio of take-away shops per head of population in the area.

Another Indian take-away shop is to open soon, despite objections raised by the Town Council, residents and other shop owners likely to be affected.

Why does Shildon have so many take-away shops? The answer lies in the fact that Aycliffe is only two miles away and a lot of their custom comes from that source.

The reason shops open in Shildon is the very low rents being asked there for commercial property.

It is easy to rent a shop for £10 a week in Shildon, while the same shop in Aycliffe would cost £150.

Low prices

Obviously this type of shop will attract Newtonians. The prices are good because the overheads are low. Parking is easy and the variety of foods available include Chinese, Italian and Indian.

All these services we should have on our doorstep, but never will because of high rent imposed by our landlords.

We can boast two Chinese and only three fish and chip shops. Shildon with only half the population has more than twice as many take-away shops.

Shildon Town Clerk Mr Tom Toward agreed they were attracting Aycliffe people and not just for take-away food. "Prices in all

Shildon shops are lower," said Mr Toward.

Speaking to the take-away shops we find they would be pleased to open in Aycliffe if the rents were more reasonable.

It is obvious these food shops, which operate on fairly low costs, are not able to afford Aycliffe rents, and while Newtonians travel to them for cheap take-away foods they needn't bother.

The proof of the take-away is in the eating.

Caravan company

Glentworth Caravans are opening a two-acre site on Aycliffe Industrial Estate in the new year for the sale and service of caravans.

The company will be operating from Groat Avenue with facilities for the manufacture of car trailers and the sale of caravan accessories. Glentworth are also to sell camping supplies and equipment.

The director has recently successfully concluded negotiations with three French caravan manufacturers and will be their sole agents in the North of England.

"These caravans are of excellent quality and are not only light to tow, but light on the pocket," said a spokesman.

CAPT. MRS LINCOLN M.B.E. RETIRES

The retirement service for Capt. Mrs E. Lincoln, MBE, held at the Recreation Centre last month was a very emotional occasion.

The service of thanksgiving for her ministry in Newton Aycliffe was attended by friends and well wishers from all over the country.

Tributes to her work were given by Frank Sherton and Derek Foster, MP. Presentations were made by the Town Council, ADC, and Harry Bilton on behalf of the

residents.

Frank Shenton, representing the Council of Churches, in a brilliant speech, praised the common sense Christian attitude of Mrs Lincoln, which quickly cut across argument and hypocrisy.

He compared her with the Pope as "Pontiff", another name for "bridgemaker." "Mrs Lincoln continually built bridges between differing points of view," said Frank. He also referred to the

tremendous amount of work she completed over her 21 years in Newton Aycliffe. "Though she had expressed some disappointment in never having her own citadel, it need never worry her, because the whole of Newton Aycliffe was her church," said Mr Shenton.

MP Derek Foster recalled the first time he met Mrs Lincoln "and it is particularly odd that two Salvationists, both tea-total, should meet in the Big Club," said Mr Foster. But he shared Mrs Lincoln's view that a salvationist, and also a politician, must go where the people are to be found.

The Mayor of Great Aycliffe presented a crystal vase and expressed the hope of all that Mrs Lincoln had a happy retirement. He referred to Mrs Lincoln as the town's "first lady," a title often conferred on the mayor's wife, but he knew she wouldn't mind taking second place.

Cheque

Local soprano Janice Townes sang "The Old Rugged Cross" as part of the afternoon's programme which also included items by Shildon S.A. Band, the Sunday School and the United Songsters of Shildon and Sherburn.

On behalf of the residents Mr Harry Bilton presented a cheque for £230 collected by public subscription, organised by himself. Mr Bilton, a retired ADC officer, remarked how well Mrs Lincoln

had fulfilled the role as one of the leaders the new town needed.

Mrs Lincoln, looking quite ill with a virus infection, remained seated throughout the service. In her response she asked to be excused from making a long speech, but indicated warmly her heartfelt thanks for the tributes and gifts she received, not forgetting a silver tray presented by the RAFA for whom she is chaplain.

Presentation

"Though the game is over for me, I will still be shouting from the touchline," said Mrs Lincoln.

Colonel Dumbleton from S.A. National Headquarters, conducted the service and presented a certificate of appreciation.

In his speech he recalled wartime phrases fitting the occasion. "Carve her name with pride" was apt for the Salvation Army when inscribing Captain Lincoln's name on the retirement certificate.

As the community newspaper we are honoured to record our thanks for Mrs Lincoln's invaluable contribution to the development of community life in Newton Aycliffe.

Since her arrival in 1961 she has been a shining example of all that is good. Her sincerity and love for her fellow man is a warming experience for all who come into contact with her.

We wish her a long and happy retirement.

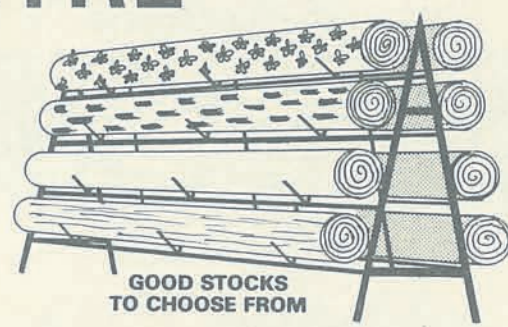
