ROYAL RECOGNITION FOR FLYMO

FLYMO LIMITED, after intense efforts in the export market have been rewarded this week with the announcement that they are to receive the 1982 Queen's Award for Export Achievement.

Based at Aycliffe, Flymo are now the world's leading manufacturer of lawnmowers. They have concentrated on expanding overseas markets since the mid seventies and now export lawnmowers to more than 80 countries worldwide.

Since 1978 they have penetrated 14 new overseas markets, including the United Arab Emirates, Yugoslavia, Mexico, China and Japan.

Their factory on the Aycliffe industrial estate, where some 780 are employed, is one of the success stories of the North of England Development Area. With 18 robots integrated into the manufacturing process, it is one of the most technologically advanced factories in Britain. About a third

of the factory's output of lawnmowers are exported.

A delighted Peter Bullock, managing director of Flymo, paid tribute to the effort made by the whole workforce: "I regard the award as very much in recognition of the efforts of all our workforce. Since we decided to make our export activities a real priority, we have made very definite investments — both in manpower and equipment. We put top management personnel behind our export drive and made special efforts to design and manufacture machines to cater for specific foreign markets."

Mr Bullock pointed out that while Flymo are very successful in Europe where their market share is growing rapidly, they are now beginning to exploit the markets in South East Asia.

"We are particularly proud of the fact that we have penetrated the Bamboo curtain," he said, "by selling air cushion mowers to the People's Republic of China. And now we've also sold our first machines to Japan — particularly gratifying when you think that the engines on these machines are made by Kawasaki of Japan."

WORLD DARTS CHAMPION GUEST CELEBRITY AT EATON PRESENTATION NIGHT

Jockey Wilson, world darts champion, was the guest celebrity at Eaton's "Apprentice of the Year" presentations this week and, after the awards, played a number of employees from the plant.

The general policy of Eaton at Aycliffe is to hold an Apprentice of the Year Award Presentation Evening where lads who have completed their first year training are awarded with First Year Training Certificates, and those apprentices who have completed their apprenticeship are issued with Certificate of Engineering Craftsmanship. In addition, other awards are presented for outstanding performance in various fields.

This year nine apprentices were presented with First Year Certificates which they earned during the year 1981, a further 15 apprentices received Certificates of Engineering Craftsmanship. Two Certificates of Endorsement were issued to those lads who completed a third module.

Each year all the Apprentices are awarded merit marks for their performance throughout the training year for attendance, standard of log books, performance at the College of Further Education and a short-list of apprentices are interviewed by a panel consisting of management, supervision and union representatives.

The first six candidates for the Apprentice of the Year Award are presented on the evening with tools of varying values. A shield is presented annually to the winner in this section, and Trevor Mann is the recipient for 1981.

Three other awards are made: The Gordon Howard Memorial Cup presented to the best Eaton apprentice in his first year of training, Gerard Cantwell. The Jim Stevenson Memorial Cup, presented for the best module log book for second year apprentices, Tony

Wilson. The Fred Smith Trophy, presented for the best third/fourth year module log book, Brian Wilson.

SISTER TOWN ATTRACTS SEVEN MORE COMPANIES

Peterlee has attracted seven new small companies over the past six months and the number of people employed in the town has risen for the first time in 18 months.

And with the level of enquiries for new premises rising steadily, the prospect for the County Durham new town is bright.

The overall employment level has risen by 56, three female and 53 male, to 5,116. Eight new small companies and two expansions in existing small industries have led to the letting of 24,000 square feet of factory space and a job potential of 82.

The new companies, and the likely number of jobs will provide, are: Freezerfill Ltd., Bracken Hill, distribution of frozen foods and

the manufacture of sausage meat, 40 jobs; Associated Heat Services, Whitworth Road, installation, maintenance and repair of heating systems, 12 jobs; Canvermoor, Whitworth Road, soft drinks distributor, nine jobs; Big Three Lincoln, Whitworth Road, welding services to industry, four jobs; Phillips Services, Whitworth Road, vehicle maintenance depot and body repairs, four jobs; Smith and Poulton, distributors of health foods, four jobs; and Homestead Products, Lister Road, pottery distribution, manufacture of pottery lamps and wooden kitchen items, three jobs.

In addition, Body Repair Services have taken larger premises in Armstrong Road with three additional jobs, as has Swift

Marketing with a similar gain in employment.

Enquiries from industry for premises in Peterlee are also increasing with 140 generated by the Development Corporation's promotional work over the past six months. These have already resulted in more than 80,000 sq. ft. of space being formally offered to companies interested in coming to the town.

"It is too early yet to say that the recession is over but at least there are signs of improvement," said Garry Philipson, managing director of Peterlee Development Corporation. "Our progress over the last six months has been slow but I am greatly encouraged by the fact that we are making any progress at all."

NEW INDUSTRIAL EXHIBITION PLANNED FOR PETERLEE

A new industrial exhibition is being planned for Peterlee this summer — and it promises to be bigger, and even better than the first successful "Industry and You" show held two years ago.

The 1982 exhibition, to be held from May 29-31 in the Leisure Centre in Peterlee, will again be run jointly by the Development Corporation and Easington District Council.

Already, more than 50 local firms and organisations have expressed interest in taking part and presenting their own display stands. The firms manufacture a wide range of products, ranging from ladies dresses and knitwear to camping and leisure equipment

and dump trucks.

As in 1980, the three day exhibition will provide industrialists with an effective showcase for their goods. It will also give local people — and outside visitors — a chance to see at first hand what Peterlee enterprise is achieving.

It could also help to attract new industry to the area, plus the jobs that go with it.

A Development Corporation spokesman said: "We are aiming to build on the success of the first exhibition by widening both the scope and scale of the event. In 1980, some 30 manufacturing firms were involved. This time, we have also invited local service

industries to take floor space; and many have responded favourably.

"In addition, the Peterlee and District Small Business Club, Tees-side Small Business Club and Newcastle's Small Firms Service are hoping to take sections of the exhibition for their own members. So the range and variety should be impressive. In fact, this year's 'Industry and You' show looks like providing a great day out for the whole family."

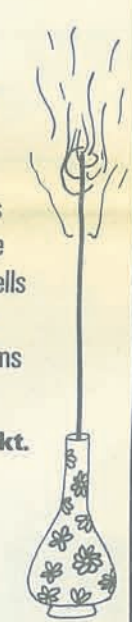

GODSPELL AT WOODHAM COMPREHENSIVE SCHOOL

At the end of April Woodham Comprehensive School is presenting the rock opera "Godspell" by John Michael Tabelak and Stephen Schwartz. The play only became available for amateur production on the first of October last year and thus Woodham will be the first school in the area to produce it. It was the original professional production in Britain, which opened at the Roundhouse in London on 17th November 1971, that brought David Essex to fame and fortune.

Although the actual cast consists of only ten characters we have decided to incorporate a large choir, thereby involving a further 80 children and ten members of staff.

The characters themselves are all played by members of the upper school. Brian Bennet plays the part of Jesus, and the popular songs 'Day by Day' and 'Prepare Ye the Way of the Lord' are sung by Donna Adamson and Peter Simpson of the fifth year.

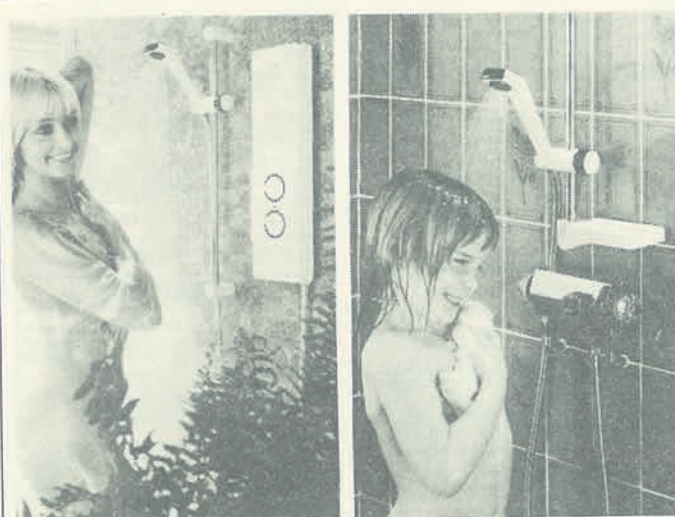
The whole production, comprising cast, choirs, band and back-up team, will involve some 150 members of the school. Although this is not the biggest production the school has ever undertaken it is certainly the most ambitious.

The basic story follows the Gospel according to St. Matthew as it is acted out by a group of

youngsters in the corner of a public car park. The climax of the show is the crucifixion and resurrection of Christ.

Shower power for economy and cleanliness

Showers are quick and convenient — the whole family can each have a shower in the time it takes to have one bath. Showers are economical — you can have at least five showers for the cost of a bath. And showers don't cost much to buy — anything from £50 for a simple model to £150 for the very best available.

There are a number of types of shower available and many different brands. The brand you choose should be based on the advice of your builders merchant or plumber but choosing the type depends more on the existing water heating and supply arrangements in your home.

There are two basic types of shower — the 'instant electric' and the plumbed-in mixer.

Instant Electric showers are essentially no more than rather sophisticated wall-mounted water heaters and require only a single cold mains connection plus a separately fused 30 amp electricity supply. Points to look for include whether the unit has both a 7kw 'winter' setting and a 4kw 'summer' setting, how accurate the temperature control is, what safety features are included and whether the whole heater unit is splash-proof and can therefore be conveniently installed in the showering area itself. Some kind of pressure 'governor' or 'stabiliser' is essential if the heater is to maintain a set showering temperature.

Plumbed-in Mixers are normally supplied from stored hot and cold water. The most common arrangement in UK homes is a cold tank in the loft feeding a hot water cylinder below and if the vertical distance between the base of the cold tank and the shower spray head is 3ft. or more the mixer will deliver a satisfying one gallon per minute shower. This compares to only 6½ pints a minute for an electric and — if your home is heated by gas or solid fuel — works out cheaper in the long run.

The simplest type of plumbed-in shower is a 'bath/shower' mixer but temperature control depends on fiddling with the hot and cold taps. The better 'manual' or 'mechanical' mixers have independent controls for temperature and flow and are a better arrangement, but by far the best type of plumbed-in shower is the 'thermostatic' mixer which offers guaranteed temperature stability. A 'thermostat' inside the unit automatically compensates for changes in the temperature or pressure of hot and cold supplies and, depending on the device used, maintains the set shower temperature more or less accurately.

If you do not have stored hot and cold water it is worth remembering that most mixer type

showers can also be used with some gas multipoint heaters. For example, a manual mixer such as the Mira 8 can be used to give a temperature-stable shower, frequently with a higher flow rate than normal, about 1½ gallons a minute or more.
