### **Aycliffe Team Still Looking for First Win**

A penalty goal from Tinkler reduced the deficit to 12 points with a quarter of the game to go. A yellow card after multiple offences by Yarm saw the referee declare uncontested scrums for 10 minutes which negated Aycliffe's advantage, but still they attacked, Niall Kelly was held up over the line, a fine tackle saw David Gibson brought to ground inches short, and Warren Parsonage had a try disallowed. Eventually, the referee blew up with the score 22 – 10 and Aycliffe having barely left the opponents' half for the entire second 40 minutes

Aycliffe were disappointed about their first half display, but credit must go to Yarm for an incredible 'backs to the wall' defence in the second half. ### Return of that Smell? The Need to be Nice

The Newton News welcomes and prints comments and campaigns about local political matters and this is to be applauded. We are almost unique in having such an open platform for people to express their opinions about local issues

What is distressing, however, is when letters are unpleasant and unreasonable. Recent letters about the West Park Lakes have contained factual inaccuracies, and personal misrepresentations and libels. One of them invited people to troll two named councillors. This is not healthy debate.

Neither can it be argued that the accused have the right of reply. Often the range of criticism is so wide and random that it would take three or four editions to reply rationally to every point. Moreover, councillors who 'give as good as they get' are then criticised for 'slagging each other off'.

Officers of the council are in an even more invidious position. They are not responsible for the Council's policies they implement - the councillors who make the policies are accountable for that. Moreover, officers are unable to write to defend themselves so to belittle and libel them is ethically odious.

Two things worry me especially about all this. The first is the impression that all this gives to the rest of the County, where Aycliffe politics are regarded as unnecessarily nasty. Aycliffe's councillors travel all over the region promoting Great Aycliffe's interests. But it is harder to do this when the people they are lobbying have been given the impression that Aycliffe people do not agree with their councillors – and, actively despise them. and, indeed,

Secondly, I am disappointed that some people still think

that the way to get what you want is to be aggressive and to 'go to war'. Experience in our personal lives and relationships shows that this is usually counter-productive, and nobody gains by such vitriol; everybody comes out of it demeaned.

In the past this was not such an issue. The Labour government allocated grants on the basis of need, so it did not matter how we looked. Nowadays, however, the future of the town lies in the businesses we can attract, and the partnerships we can build.

A climate in which our leaders and partners are regularly held up for vicious hostility in the local press will only damage our chances. We need to polish up our community image, not

publicly disparage it.

I am not saying that councillors should not be accountable – readers know that I have been trying for years to promote dialogue about local issues. But I do urge correspondents to check their facts, and to avoid ad hominem attacks on individuals. And – when they have written their letter – people should ask themselves what it will make other councillors, businesses and residents think of Newton Avcliffe.





# **Newtonian's London to Newcastle 24 Hour Bike Ride**

### Personal Story by Fundraiser Anthony Cox



On Saturday 30th August 2014, having woken every hour to check the time, I began to feel nerves and excitement for the challenge soon to begin. Could I really cycle 310 miles from London to Newcastle in less than 24 hours?

After a quick breakfast I put my kit on, packed my bag and made the short ride from the hotel to the start line. I was greeted by a huge start banner and over 100 cyclists making their final bike and kit adjustments. The countdown to our 10am start began and by now I was itching to get going!

After a quick safety briefing, a few 'selfies' and a final Facebook update, there was a countdown from 10 and we were off! A short spin out of Clissold Park and onto the roads of North London. The first 10 miles were stop-start as we made our way out of the city, but on reaching the country roads we got into a good

My aim was to stay with the front group to minimise the waiting time at each rest stop and to complete the challenge as quickly as possible. The first stage of 43 miles flew by and we soon made it to the first rest station in Royston.

As the ride progressed, rest and food stops were vital. They gave us the chance to refuel, stretch our legs and most of all top up our chamois cream! The second stage of 43 miles also took no time at all, taking us to the first hot food stop in Peterborough for BBQ food and pasta. I was going well and feeling good so far but I knew the worst was to come.

Although the following longest stage of 58 mile proved to be relatively uneventful, if a little quicker than the previous 86, I began to experience my first problems of the day. Although replacing up to 600 calories an hour is essential, exercising and eating over a long ride are not a combination the body likes hence the start of stomach cramps and trapped wind

As night time approached and we reached the 144 mile point at around 8pm, I knew my only choice was to eat anyway and suffer the consequences as without the energy I would not make it through the night. At Lincoln heading, for Goole, the following miles would be the proper start of my challenge

We passed the 12 hour mark near midnight, and there seemed to be no let up in pace from our lead rider Bruce - an ex pro Australian cyclist who had recently cycled 2,800km in a week. How he rode the entire 310 miles at the front is staggering!

The hard pace, combined with my stomach pains and the fact we were in the early hours, made the majority of the night ride very tough. I remember at times thinking it would never end. The thing with cycling in total darkness with just a few bike lights ahead of you is that you have very little concept of time or distance travelled.

We thought we must have gone 20 miles since the last stop only to learn it was just 10 and this dampened my spirits at times. However, thinking about why I was riding helped. I was proud



to be raising money through my challenge for Teenage Cancer Trust and really hope it can make a difference.

At the 5th stop in Easingwold and with just one more stop until

the finish, I reached my lowest point. Having cycled over 230 miles so far and still being awake at around 3am. I felt as though I'd been for a night on the town. I was certain by now that I would never attempt a similar challenge again. I stopped eating because it was causing too much pain - something which would eventually catch up with me as energy levels dropped. Even drinking water was making me feel sick. The only thing that really kept me going was knowing that during the next stage we would pass just a couple of miles from my home town Newton

Aycliffe where a huge moral boost awaited! As we approached Sadberge, a local photographer, Dave Stox was waiting ready to get a few snaps. I also knew that further along the road at Hardwick Park were my girlfriend, Mam and Stepdad waiting to cheer me on and then my sister and niece waiting at the next stop in Coxhoe.

This gave me a huge energy boost and I was soon riding at the front as we pedalled along familiar roads. I honestly think that without the support I would have struggled to complete the final stage of the ride. In the toughest moments ahead thinking of them gave me the slight edge I needed. Arriving in Coxhoe there were just 26 miles to the finish line in Newcastle.

Before this ride I never thought it would be possible to fall asleep while riding a bike, but by the time we reached Durham, I was starting to wonder if I could stay awake at all!

The following miles through Gateshead and Newcastle was a painful blur, and the finish line was almost within touching

As we turned up the road towards the finish at Heaton Manor School, I began to get a lump in my throat. Am I really about to finish the biggest challenge of my life? All of those hours of training, the pain and fatigue during the previous day of riding. All I could think of was my loved ones waiting at the finish and all the kind words of support and donations - some from people I've never even met

Then finally, I had finished - relief that I didn't have to turn the pedals again after the longest and toughest night I have experienced. I could relax and enjoy a few well needed hugs! I had cycled from London to Newcastle, a total of 311 miles in 22 hours 8 minutes.

To date I have raised around £1,450 for Teenage Cancer Trust and I really hope I have done Mark and my Grandad proud. I'm not sure if I will ever achieve something like this again, but I am sure that if you put your mind to something and work hard enough, then most things are possible!

# **Fire Service Consults on Cost Cutting Proposals**

consultation launched on 1st September aims to help County Durham and Darlington Fire and Rescue Service plan for the future in light of further cuts to government grant funding.

Reductions during the past four years have meant the Service had to find over £3.5m of savings from its budget since 2010. Achieving these savings meant making significant changes to how services are delivered and so far this has been achieved without increasing risk in local communities.

The next three years are likely to be even more challenging as a further £3.6m of savings has to be found to meet the expected reductions in funding. The options available to balance the budget for the

fire and rescue service will difficult to increasingly implement and the Service needs to think differently about how it delivers services. As part of the Service's latest three year strategic plan 2015/16 – 2017/18, five proposals and questions have been posed and comments are sought from people living and working in the area. # **Move to Tackle Violence Against Women**

Labour has appointed its first ever shadow minister for prevention of violence against women and girls (VAWG). # **DON'T LOSE THE RIGHT TO VOTE**

Nearly 43,000 people across County Durham are being urged not to lose their right to vote following changes to the way the electoral register is compiled.

The introduction of Individual Electoral Registration means people are now required to register to vote individually, rather than by household. The new system also allows residents to register online.

While the majority of residents in County Durham have automatically moved on to the new system, 42,806 residents are not registered because they need to provide additional information.

Durham County Council is urging anyone who has received a letter telling them they were not automatically transferred to visit www gov.uk/register-to-vote

register online. Colette Longbottom, Durham County Council's electoral registration officer, said:
"Many County Durham
residents will have received a letter from our electoral services team telling them that they have automatically moved onto new registration system.

"However, some residents were told that they needed to provide extra information in order to register under the new system. It's important that they now do this.
"This is the first time that

people can register to vote online and it's quick and simple. This should appeal to many young people and students of Durham University so if you've just turned 18 or you've not registered before; get online to register to vote."

The new system has been introduced with the aim of making the electoral register more secure.
