



The viking storyteller called Thor Ewing who brought lots of artefacts including furs, weapons, coins, clothing, chainmail and the children gained hands on experience of using them. They recreated a viking court where they then acted as the

criminals.

They also sat on the jury for the trial of Thorstein the Viking. Traditional Norse songs were sung and a dance performed to traditional instruments. Corn was ground to make flour and the children learned about food and daily life. There was a re-enactment of a battle and the Y6 pupils learnt about weapons and warfare. The children's favourite part was when he sliced Miss Sykes' potato in mid air with his sword and fired an arrow across the hall

with his bow. Y4 were thrilled by the imposing Roman soldier who taught them Latin commands. The children dressed up as soldiers in traditional outfits with swords and shields and learned how to position themselves strategically in a testudo formation.

Travelling even further back in time, Y3 pupils enjoyed learning about the Stone Age from representatives from Durham University History Department who arrived with many interesting artefacts for the children to examine.

Younger pupils also enjoyed a royal visit when the "Queen" called into the Infant Department to chat and spend time with the children.

# Join the Heighington **Volunteer Litter Pickers**



Dear Editor,

Your readers may like to know that Saturday 13th September was "World Litter Pick Day" and it coincided with the restart of Heighington Parish Litter pick Group's (HPLG) monthly pick. This movement initiated by Estonia three years ago is now made up of about 30 countries. Volunteers regularly pick up litter and clean up beauty spots and last year over 10,000 tons of rubbish was collected.

Discarded rubbish is a major environment and health hazard around the world and we the HLPG have been doing our bit towards reducing the accumulation by our monthly picks on the verges of roads around Redworth, School around Redworth, School Aycliffe and Heighington since 2005. This Saturday a dozen members, some are pictured, joined in the pick and in the two hours picked 28 bags of rubbish. A few of our Heighington WI members were unable join us as they were on duty manning the produce sale stalls in the

village hall foyer. We were not able to pick during July and August as the grass on the verges was rather tall and posed a hazard. As a result there was a lot more rubbish; cans, plastic bottles, fast food packaging and broken car parts to list just a few elements. The quantity was so great that we had to use "giant bags" for the collections.

We found fly tipping in several places. Some of the dumped rubbish was in black bags. I wonder if these were dumped the roadside because the culprits found the local household waste collection centre closed and they were

reluctant to take it home. Also, we found many discarded banana skins on the road sides. I wonder if people chucking these out of their cars realise that banana skins take many decades to decompose and they are not eaten by any wild creatures in this country But what I find even more disgusting is the actions of some dog walkers. They take the trouble to bag the dog mess but then tie it onto low branches of the trees along station road footpath from Heighington to Newton Aycliffe. These bags are an eyesore, dangerous to people walking past and difficult to take down. I hope this rather unpleasant practice stops soon as darkness comes on earlier each day and walkers cannot

see these bags.
Of course our life would be much more pleasant if people took their rubbish home to bin it. After all we have regular free refuse collections from every home. But miracles are unlikely to happen so the HPLG will continue its monthly litter pick on the second Saturday of each month. I hope you agree that our modest efforts make a difference in keeping our outdoor environment clean and tidy. We welcome more

participants.
Our next pick will be on the 11th October 2014 between 10.00 and 12.00 noon. We have meeting points, where help and tools are handed out, at Heighington Village Hall, at 2 Main Road in Redworth and at Old Farm Cottage in School Aycliffe and at noon refreshments will be served in Heighington Village Hall.





Behind the fast-break play of guards Chris Jones and Panos Mayindombe, the Durham Wildcats defeated visiting Leeds Force in the home opener 80-46 on Sunday evening at Newton Aycliffe Leisure Centre.

Mayindombe led all scorers with 19 points, while Jones delivered 10 assists to his teammates, with Tom Knight collecting nine rebounds.
The Wildcats set a new club

record for fewest points conceded in a match, beating the previous number of 55 versus Surrey United on 24th January 2014.

Head Coach Lee Davie had been emphasising high tempo and aggressive defence all throughout pre-season to his players in order to limit the opposition's possession of the ball, and his team executed this style of play throughout much of the game. The pace of Durham's game on Sunday evening was too much for Leeds Force, playing in their first BBL match in club history. "Our defence was good," Davie said after the match, "even with the limited practices we have had. Our guards were disruptive, and that's all we can ask for. When we make things as difficult as possible for the opposition to move the ball on each

and every possession, that's success for us." Durham's aggressive defence forced Leeds to take difficult shots all throughout the night. The Force shot 17-51 (33 percent) from the field and were limited to nine assists. Meanwhile the Wildcats shot 31-61 (51 percent) from the field and four players scored in double digits. Behind Mayindombe's 19, Knight scored 12, Ralph Bucci had 11 points and John Puk added 10

The first half was a relatively low-scoring affair. With the score 20-12 to start the second Durham's defence really began to create problems for Leeds offensively, who managed to only score seven points before half-time. The Wildcats had a 12-0 run through the first and second quarters and had runs of 9-0 and 14-0 in the second half.

Jones led the team in steals with four, to go with his eight points. Odiba Attah and Sam Martin each had nine points, while Joel Madourie had one basket to go with his three rebounds. New signing David Buchberger sat the game out with a minor injury but is
