

However, in indicating that the land to the rear of the Police Station is to be used for operational vehicles, he is entirely misinformed.

I have personally inspected the documents submitted to Sedgefield Borough Council for planning permission purposes, which quite clearly state that the proposal is for the construction of a STAFF CAR

As his information is reputed to be from a Senior Police Officer, you may consider that the general public and especially those of us who reside in close proximity to the Police Station are entitled to a clear and authoritative statement from the Police Authority, which I have today requested from the Chief Constable. 
