CARE CENTRE FOR TOWN TO BE COMPLETED BY NOVEMBER 1998

The Pioneering Care Centre will be built in the Cobblers Hall area of Newton Aycliffe and will be run by a Charitable Trust 'The Pioneering Care Partnership'.

The members of the Trust are local people receiving health and social care services and voluntary

groups and Statutory Organisations involved in the provision of health and social care services in the

Borough.

The Trust's aim is to: *Improve the health and quality of life of local people disadvantaged through caring responsibilities, disability, age or ill health and reduce inequalities in health*

In order to achieve their aim, the centre will act as a 'one stop shop' for services and support for people with disabilities, ill health and those caring for them in the Borough of Sedgefield and beyond.

The Centre will be completed by Autumn 1998 and has been designed by award winning architects' Jane Darbyshire and David Kendal Ltd. They are known for their expertise in this area of work and have received many accolades including the Royal Institute of British Architects 'Building of the Year' Award in the past. The building is being financed by Sedgefield Borough Council and will be leased to the Partnership on a long term basis.

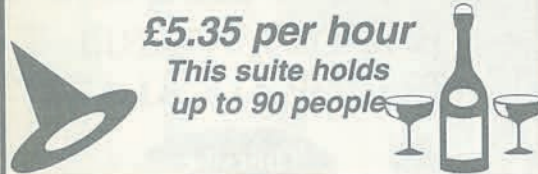

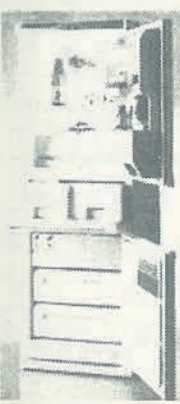

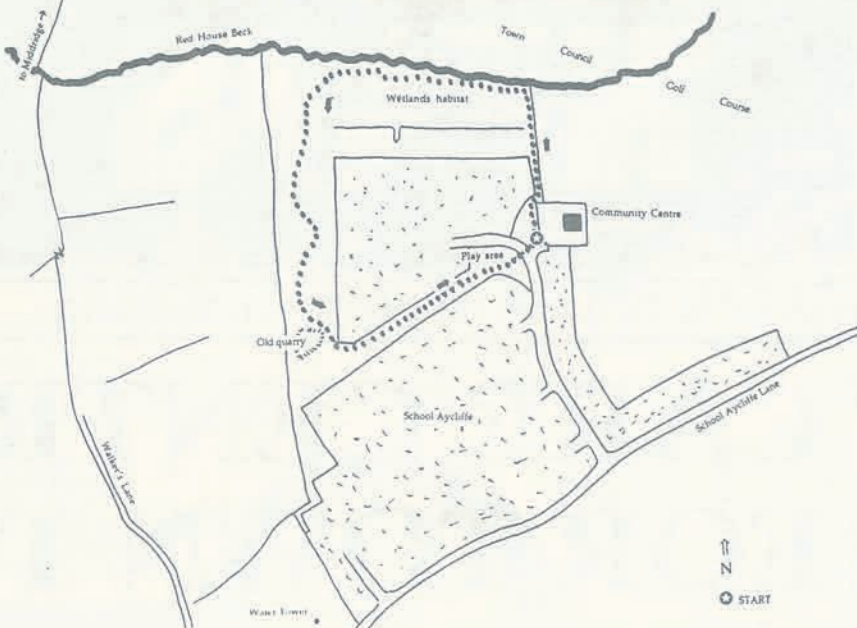

WALK 2: A School Aycliffe Stroll

Trainers - 1 mile - play area - grass/ tarmac/ cinder path. IF THE WEATHER IS DRY, this walk should be accessible to push-chairs WITH SOME DIFFICULTY.



It is widely believed that School Aycliffe is so-called because it was the site of an ancient school. It is more probable that it was named after a Saxon chief called Scula.

This is a short, pretty walk. A good starting point is the car park by the community centre. From here, leave the centre and walk down through the trees beside the car park onto the cinder path which runs alongside the Town Council Golf Course. At the end of the houses, on the left, is an area of rough grass where people exercise their dogs; dog-owners may

wish to walk along here.

Other walkers, however, should continue down on the grass beside the Golf Course to Red House Beck, and then turn left along beside the stream. You are walking through a wonderful, almost unspoiled wetlands habitat. Some of the species of insects and plants here are found nowhere else in south Durham. Duckboards have been laid on the wetter parts of the path.

After about a quarter of a mile, the path bears left and runs up the hill.

Towards the top of the hill you will reach an old quarry.

In former times, many farms had their own small quarries, from which they took stone for building. In this quarry are the remains of an 'ice house'. In the days before fridges, ice was stored there during the winter, to be used during the summer!

Just before the quarry, the path forks. Bear left and take the path up beside the houses. At the top, turn left and follow the tarmac path back down to the community centre. There is a small children's play area at the end of this path.

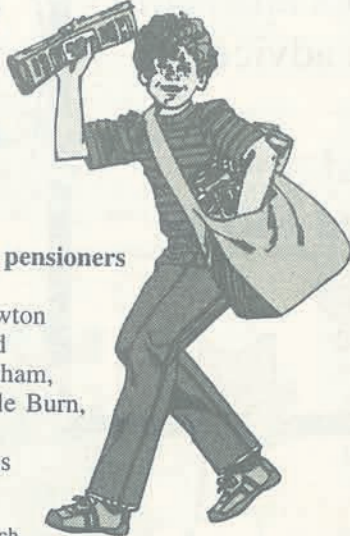

Cycleforce NOTES

WHAT IS ALCOHOL?

It is a central nervous system depressant that slows down body functions such as heart rate and respiration. Small quantities of alcohol may induce feelings of well-being and relaxation; but in larger amounts, alcohol can cause intoxication, sedation, unconsciousness and even death.

ALCOHOL AND DRIVER ABILITY

Driving is one of the most complicated things that people can do on a daily basis. You can't do a good job of driving when you are impaired by alcohol.

The big problem is the effect alcohol has on your judgement and ability to see. These two abilities are the most important to safe driving.

JUDGEMENT

This serves to guide you behaviour in driving and in all situations. It allows you to think clearly and make quick decisions. Judgement is also part of every task in driving. Your judgement works to help you answer questions like: "how fast am I going?" "How far away is the pedestrian?" "Is there time to pass?" "Do I have enough distance?" "Is there room to stop?"

Once your judgement is affected you have two problems: You can't drive safely and you don't ever know it!

ABILITY TO SEE

Alcohol can affect your ability to see without you being aware of it. When eye muscles are relaxed by alcohol, light is not directed properly and focusing on a scene becomes difficult. Ability to see at night is reduced by more than half. Alcohol also causes each eye to get a slightly different picture, hence double vision. Drinking and driving has lasting consequences:

- * Living with your conscience;
- * Living with the knowledge that your irresponsibility has caused death, injury or severe distress to innocent people;
- * Causing distress and shame to your family;
- * Legal consequences:

Offences: Causing death by careless driving whilst under the influence of drink or drugs brings a penalty of a maximum 10 years imprisonment and a disqualification of at least 2 years; Driving or attempting to drive whilst above the legal limit or unfit through drink will give a maximum of 6 months imprisonment plus a fine (£5000) and a disqualification of at least 12 months;

In charge of a vehicles whilst above the legal limit or unfit through drink, gives a penalty of a maximum 3 months imprisonment, plus a fine (£2500) and a disqualification; Refusing to provide a specimen brings a penalty of a maximum of 6 months imprisonment, £5000 fine and a disqualification of at least 12 months.

The only safe course is not to drink and drive.

These filthy places should be removed and replaced with pelican crossings.

Friends living near the subways complain of the continuous hassle of noise, bad language and abuse and the police do a good job, but can't be there all the time.

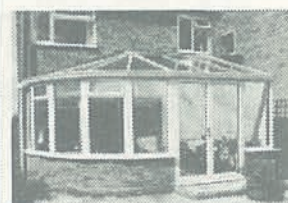

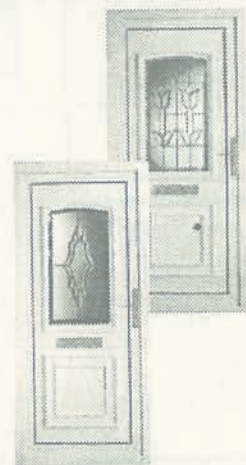

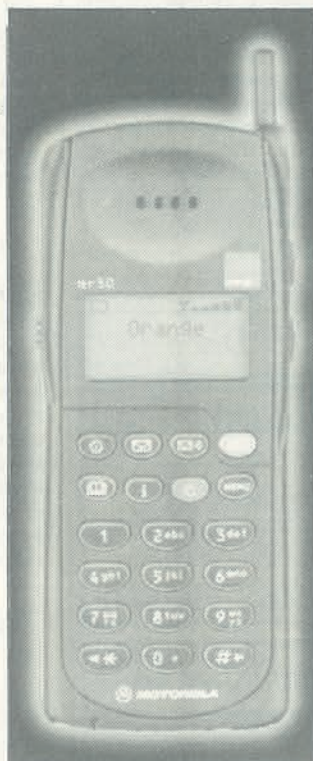
