## COUNCIL MOVES TO SLOW TRAFFIC THROUGH MIDDRIDGE

### BUT NO IMPROVEMENT FOR REST OF C35

Councillor Tony Moore has been informed by the County Council that a traffic calming scheme is to be implemented in Middridge Village, along the notorious C35 which forms the High Street.

Existing signs will be highlighted with the new yellow backed boards which are appearing everywhere now.

Damaged and vandalised signs will be replaced and red anti-skid rumble strips will be provided at both approaches to the village and at two other locations within the village.

Tony Moore welcomes any improvement to this road, but waits anxiously for news of improvement to the stretch from the Golf Course roundabout to Rushyford which gets more and more congested each week.

One lady, who works in Durham, told "Newton News" she starts work at 9am but needs to leave home at 7.30am due to traffic jams along the C35. The journey should take only 30 minutes.

This is the sort of comment one expects from motorists living in London and is unacceptable in a rural area. And while all these people are stuck in this traffic the house-building in the northern area continues at a rapid pace, creating more congestion!

# EXCELLENT YOUTH PERFORMANCE OF "OLIVER"

With house full notices for every performance, I was one of the lucky ones to get a ticket for the opening night of "Oliver" presented by the Spennymoor Youth Theatre Group. The cast of 120 filled every empty space in the hall as they sang their hearts out in "Food, Glorious Food".

Opening night, as always is family night when mothers, fathers and relations come along, ready to forgive mistakes caused by nerves. If they were looking for mistakes they were disappointed, what they got was a first class show. Everyone of the cast was determined to enjoy themselves and be a star. The Designer/Director had made clever additions of scaffolding to the set. With the limitations of the size of the stage these additions gave additional area and height, which meant he could keep the set simple. All changes of set were carried out by the company which kept fluency throughout the show.

The principal role of Oliver was taken by Aaron Sproat. Although nearly fifteen, his small stature and shy clear looks made him an excellent choice. His other great asset was his clear treble voice which he used to full advantage in his performance of "Where is Love".

In contrast to Oliver the part of the Artful Dodger was played by Sam Gair. He has natural acting ability and played this part to perfection. A rogue, but a likeable one came across to the audience and this was supported by a good singing voice in his rendition of "Consider Yourself".

Mr Bumble played by David Galloway and Widow Comey, his accomplice had the task of creating the comedy. A well matched pair they kept the audience well amused.

Paul Forster at seventeen had the most difficult task in playing Fagin. This part calls for stage experience, great acting ability and a really mature singing voice to cope with extremely difficult songs. I felt that in Act 1 he was holding back and just did not quite get into the part. In Act 11 however all was forgiven for his excellent rendition of "I'm Reviewing This Situation".

In the leading lady role we had Leslie Waring as Nancy. She talked this part well giving full support to the other principals. The audience took her to their hearts however for her rendition of the song of the show "As Long As He Needs Me".

Supporting Nancy and the villain of the piece is Bill Sykes - Marcus Johnson got right inside this character and although a small part it is so important to the whole story. I'm sure he will leave a lasting impression as not only frightening those on stage but part of the audience as well.

Although limited for space the choreographer had struck a good balance giving enough movement in the dances to support the mood and continue the movement.

Praise must also go to the minor principal roles. They all blended into the story giving it the right kind of support. The orchestra, situated at the back of the stage gave a sympathetic support to the young voices.

This was an excellent show, even more so as it was the first night. The cast coped well with the confines of the stage and the large audience. For such a young company, only formed in 1995, they certainly have the right formula for producing not just good shows, but excellent ones.





Tracker Caught Abductor

The culprit in a child  
abduction case was sentenced  
to eight years jail by  
Wolverhampton Crown  
Court this week, following a  
pioneering move by Avon &  
Somerset Police involving  
stolen vehicle recovery
