I am disappointed and angry at the poor state of our town centre. As much as anyone else in Newton Aycliffe, I want to improve it. Since I became Chairman of the Environment Committee on Great Aycliffe Town Council we have set up, and I have attended, "The Town Centre Forum".

Progress is painfully slow. But, in the long term, it is a much more likely way forward than threats and empty posturing.

At the moment, the Forum is discussing how to make Christmas a more joyful occasion in the town centre. As a gesture, the Town Council has offered to organise live outdoor entertainment during the Christmas period. Now we look to our partners on the Forum to match our initiative.

The town centre is private property. The rights there of County, Borough and Town councils are strictly controlled by law. There is no magic wand to turn this pumpkin into a royal carriage - in the real world, as we all know, things are never so

It is not very glamorous, and it does not gain instant publicity, to attend meetings, to discuss and persuade, to chip away at a problem. But that is what I am doing, and I believe that this reasonable pressure will slowly bring real results. Yours faithfully Terry Hogan






