

Works - Woodham Way to Woodham Burn.

On the face of it, the proposed landscaping would seem like a good idea, but one can only wonder how long mindless, moronic vandals will allow it to survive.

What will happen to the great quantity of saplings planted about two years in the area between Woodham Way and the Burn? The last straw was the imposition of a manufactured path this year which I doubt will still be in evidence in another fifty years from now. We still prefer to walk in the grass as the loose grit surface makes the path feel unsafe as feet skid away on the downward slope.

If we must have this path, can it be tarmac like the one from Agnew to Woodham Way?.. I left to it's own devices, can do
