## A FEW DOG OWNERS SPOIL TOWN'S ENVIRONMENT

Dear Readers,  
I was very happy to read C Parker's letter in last week's Newton News, which I took as a vindication of the Town Council's recent environmental initiatives.

In the 1940s, Newton Aycliffe was conceived as a 'new town' - a new population centre to replace the slum housing in some of the surrounding pit villages, and a new industrial complex to replace the declining coal mining industry. It was placed here, first because there was an existing

infrastructure, but also because the farm-land wasn't particularly rich or precious. It was always understood that the town would grow - grow, in fact, much faster than it has done!

Consequently, we have to resign ourselves to the inevitable growth of the town, both residentially and industrially. This is essential for the prosperity of Aycliffe residents. There is going to be even more concrete over the next fifty years. What we must do, therefore, is to make sure

that new developments preserve 'green' areas, which are properly managed to preserve biodiversity. To this, the Town Council is implacably committed.

I appreciate C Parker's comments about dog-walk areas, and am aware of the many people who drive their dogs to suitable places to let them have a run around.

It is the hope of the Town Council, within its Environmental Plan, to assign specific 'dog run' areas - although I cannot yet say where those areas will be.

If you want to take your dog for a walk, I recommend the excellent set of circular walks produced by John Clare and the GAPS group, and published last year in the Newton News.

However, may I appeal to all dog owners NOT to walk their dogs on school playing fields or public football fields, and always to take a plastic bag with them to clear up any mess, and to use the dog bins.

# TOWN COUNCIL APPOINT QUALIFIED ENVIRONMENTALIST



Great Aycliffe Town Council has recently employed Jonathan Elmer, an Environmental Ranger with a background in nature conservation, teaching and green issues. One of the Ranger's tasks is to help the Council manage parks and grasslands owned by the Council such as Woodham Burn and West Lakes (by for example, increasing the number of wild flowers, butterflies, mammals and birds). The Ranger is presently conducting a botanical survey of Great Aycliffe to provide a record of green sites that are present within and around the town. This survey information will enable decisions to be made on how to conserve and re-create natural areas that will be attractive to visit and will help conserve threatened plants and animals. When the botanical survey is complete the Council hopes to involve neighbourhoods, the community and interest groups in conservation projects on local green areas and would welcome any offers of support. If you would like to help, or wish to support this project in some way please contact Jonathan Elmer at Great Aycliffe Town Council on 01325 300 700. In the near future, the Council aims to provide an outdoor education service to local schools as well as considering wider environmental initiatives such as green route ways and recycling. The proposals mentioned above will eventually be brought together in the form of an Environment Plan describing what needs to be achieved and how the community will work together to accomplish this. Any comments or suggestions on the above are most welcome. Jonathan originates from Newark and was educated at Aberystwyth University gaining a degree in Ecology. Before taking up his post here he undertook short term contracts all over the U.K. He is single, plays football and enjoys Botany, walking and mountaineering. "I think Newton Aycliffe is a vibrant town and has enormous potential. I am looking forward to working here" said Jonathan.

# Should We Abolish Great Aycliffe Town Council?

Dear Sir,  
Councillors (contrary to popular belief) ARE human beings - I winced when this year's Community Charge bill arrived. And as we can see that it does us political harm to put up the rates, it's the LAST thing we want to do.

But, at the same time, Councillors are aware that there is a public demand AT LEAST to maintain the current level of services. Mr Elgey's letter last week is typical. He complained about the increase in rates - and then listed more than seven areas where he wanted the Council to do MORE!

Many of the things Mr Elgey mentioned I cannot comment upon for - as he knows very well - things like roads, police, libraries and rubbish bins are Durham County and Borough Council matters. But I will defend the Town Council's precept vigorously.

It is true that the Town Council have added £30,000 to the rates bill to pay for the toilets. We couldn't afford to take on the toilets without asking for extra money (mainly for wages) - but we asked the ratepayers first if they wanted us to do this!

Also - in addition to its normal services - the Town Council is doing many things EXTRA this year.

It:

- has appointed an Environment Ranger.
- has part-funded traffic-calming measures.
- will celebrate (and pay for) its 50th Anniversary.
- will finish the Great Aycliffe Walkway.
- will make a £40,000 contribution towards the new Greenfield Centre facilities.
- will improve some of its Pre-school Learning Centres (the playgroups) into nursery education providers.
- will provide changing facilities at the Golf Shop.

To simply stand still, the Town Council might have been expected to increase the precept by the rate of inflation. But we didn't. If you don't count the extra money for the toilets, we increased the Town Council precept by LESS than the rate of inflation. So we are trying to do more next year with less money in real terms. Can last week's critics understand this? All this list of NEW INITIATIVES, we will have to achieve next year by increased efficiency and money we have saved.

We ARE aware that people hate paying rates. And I understand how some people lose patience and, in the heat of the moment, say we ought to be abolished.

But if we were to abolish the Town Council, Great Aycliffe would either LOSE services (for instance, the Pre-school Learning Centres, the over-60s trips, fireworks display, the show, Oak Leaf Centre, golf course, and many other things), or we would have to pay the Borough Council to do them (for instance the cemeteries and the grasscutting). Where would we make any genuine savings? Buildings? ~ the Town Council owns its small, economical, out-of-town offices. Wages? - the Borough would need more staff to administer the new services it would have to provide. 'Economies of scale'? - we all know what that means; it involves sacking people, and making the taxpayer pay their unemployment benefit. Those who propose abolishing the Town Council know this very well; they're just flying a kite at precept time, hoping to catch a few disgruntled voters!

It's all about value for money, isn't it? I can only speak officially for the Town Council, but we are frugal and efficient, and will work to improve further.

And they go on to - Note that in relation to other Shire Counties on a sample of service delivery issues, Durham County Council continues to perform well in most areas.

Commend the Authority's management of the process of reorganisation following the Review of Local Government. "In facing the considerable challenge presented by Local Government Reorganisation of the County, the degree of stability afforded by an experienced and long standing group of leading members and chief officers was an important asset in the successful management of the reorganisation process," says the Auditors' report. Council Leader Don Robson said that with Council Tax bills at their highest ever level, it was more important than ever for people to know that their money was being well spent,

that the Authority was being well managed and that the right priorities were being identified.

"This report by an independently appointed firm of external auditors is the most reassuring proof available that the County Council is doing its job right and doing it well," he added.

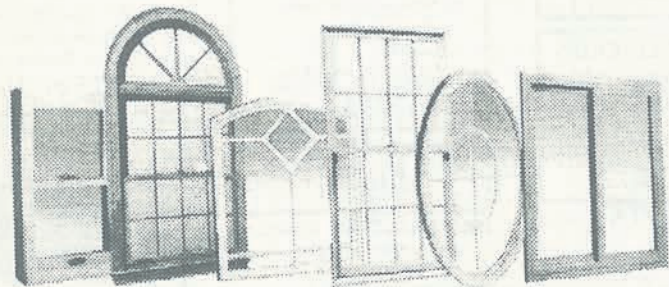
