

BOROUGH COUNCIL LAUNCH COMMUNITY RANGERS SCHEME

Schoolchildren Sedgefield Borough are being invited to sign up to a pioneering initiative to promote good citizenship and reduce crime and antibehaviour social throughout the Borough.

The Community Rangers Initiative was officially launched on Friday, 26th June, by Tony Blair at Spennymoor.


