



AVENUE SITE CAN NOW BE SOLD AND REDEVELOPED

At last, the way is now clear for the Avenue School site to be marketed for redevelopment

The site which formerly the large housed Comprehensive School measures 16.3 acres and is well located at the heart of the town.

Sedgefield Borough Council went out to public consultation earlier this year with a draft planing brief, providing guidelines for potential developers.

They were delighted with the level of public response and now many of the comments and concerns of local people have been incorporated into revised guidelines for the site.

These amendments were approved this week and the project can progress to the next stage.

It is essential to have a high quality design, urban in character and catering for a variety of uses. Sedgefield Borough Council see it as a unique opportunity to create a major new commercial development, making a long term contribution to the vitality of the town and community life.

The main changes arising from the consultation is the deletion of housing from the scheme and retaining a park and football pitches.

It had also proposed to close part of Greenwell Road to vehicles and allow building and pedestrian links, but it is felt more appropriate to keep the road for bus links into the central area and access for emergency vehicles. Pedestrians will have priority and the carriageway will be narrowed with 20mph speed limits.

The draft brief also had provision for community facilities and meeting rooms, but these have been changed to give a single events/

meeting room contained within a redeveloped Library and a new Cubby building.

Kester Noble, Chairman of the Borough Council Development Committee said:

"We are proposing a high quality mixed development and more shopping units integrated with the existing town centre, leading to a Town Park and recreational area. The next step is for Durham County, who own the site, to put it on the market. I hope a suitable developer will soon be found and the plans can become reality" said Kester.



Fake Danger

Local Labour Euro MP Stephen Hughes voted this week for extra curbs on counterfeit and pirated goods and warned Newton Aycliffe shoppers not to buy them

Stephen Hughes Labour Euro MP for Durham and Blaydon said "Most think of counterfeit goods as fly by night traders selling dodgy perfume, fake watches or pirated CDs, but counterfeit goods can be dangerous. All counterfeit goods represent bad value for money since they are invariably poor quality and the consumer has no rights if the goods go wrong.

He added "The profits from many counterfeit and pirated goods goes to organised crime. It is big business for people who are also involved in drug muggling and gun running. Shocking examples of counterfeit goods found in Britain include:

Washing powder with highly caustic ingredients which caused skin burns; Aircraft made from mild instead of tempered steel; Health drinks which contained ten times the recommended safe level of ephedrine; Bus brake diaphragms which burst after as few as eight applications; Hand tools made of such brittle steel they broke into razor sharp fragments.

The EU has already got border controls allowing counterfeit or pirated goods to be seized entering or leaving the EU. The extra curbs agreed by the European Parliament - and supported by Stephen Hughes include extending the system to patented goods and allowing goods to be seized in a wider variety of situations.
