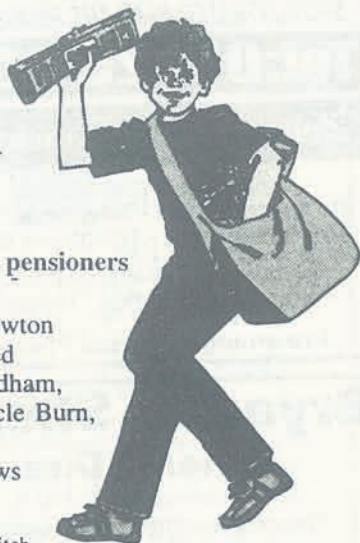

The game was split into three 20 minute periods and during the first period the game flowed evenly from end to end with Andrew Hartley in goal for the home side making two good saves to keep the score goalless.

The town boys exerted strong pressure for an equaliser and the highly talented Kieran Megran hit the post after an excellent piece of individual skill. The bus, with the destination board for Aidsensfield from the top TV drama Heartbeat, will be part of the DLI Museum's Bank Holiday Fair on Sunday and Monday, August 30 and 31.

It will be on hand at County Hall, Durham, where the largest ever militaria fair is being held, to take visitors on a five minute ride to the DLI Museum and Durham Art Gallery for the biggest ever Military Vehicle Rally which this year is celebrating its 25th anniversary.

Decked out in United livery, the historic bus has been preserved and restored by Aycliffe and District Bus Preservation Society, and has featured in the ITV series carrying the cast around the moorland above the fictional village of Aidsensfield.

Nicky, who donned the ATS uniform, works at Durham Art Gallery where visitors to the fair can have a last opportunity to see the Beryl Cook exhibition which has attracted record-breaking attendances this summer.
