



Rumours that Fujitsu is closing its Aycliffe plant have been confirmed

'Newton News' held the front page to wait for the Press Announcement, made today at 12 noon, which ended the speculation over the Company's future at Newton Aycliffe. Everyone braced themselves for the bad news which will have a devastating effect on the 600 workforce, and our local economy.

Since the market price of microchips dropped to 5% of their selling price it was inevitable that people in the industry would suffer.

So it came as no surprise when Fujitsu made the following

Fujitsu has decided to cease production at its Newton Aycliffe plant. The closure will take place in December and redundancy notices are being issued. The plant will be maintained until 28th February 1999 while a suitable buyer is sought.

"The decision to close is a painful one and we do so soberly and with sincere concern for those who will be affected' said Takamitsu Tsuchimata, Head of Fujitsu's Electronic Devices Group. Fujitsu greatly value the contribution made by Aycliffe employees who are a highly skilled and productive resource, and we shall do all we can to help them find new job opportunities." he added.

Borough Council Leader, Brian Stephens said "This is a serious blow to the economy of the whole region. Sadly this is not the first time the area has had to respond to major closures and that experience will help over the coming months. The Council still believes that inward investment will be attracted to this area because we have a first class reputation for our workforce and the quality of sites we can make available. We are starting immediately to examine options for the re-use of the building by others in the electronics industry."

It is sad day for the employees who have staked their future on Fujitsu's success and expansion. Our thoughts are with them and the insecurity they are experiencing at this time.



TOUGHER ROAD LAWS TO SAFEGUARD KI

Northerners are demanding tougher road laws to keep their children safe, including a new, statutory 20 mph speed limit outside all schools.

The findings come in a Harris survey, commissioned by direct motor insurance intermediary Dial Direct, in time for the new school term. Whilst 79% of British people nationally want the limit lationally want the limit lowering to 20 mph to keep children safe, 82% of those surveyed in the north were in favour of this move. Northern counties were also more in favour of installing speed and security cameras outside all schools. Whilst 62% and 71% supported this view nationally, 73% and 82% of Northerners supported these measures. The Dial Direct survey also

showed: * 40% favour on-the-spot fines of £100 for any parent parking on double yellow lines when dropping off, or picking up, children

* 34% feel that lollipop people can no longer keep children safe - compared to national average of 23% who feel this

* 24% would support the cordoning off of all roads around schools to all motorists school rush hours

 64% would like to see a ban on the overtaking of school buses during drop offs and pick ups (national average -

* 66% support a total ban on cars in the immediate vicinity of schools, other than for those carrying disabled children (national average 49%)

Dial Direct's managing director, Michael Bennett, says: "This survey shows that people, particularly in the north, are demanding increased levels of child safety. We hope that drivers will take heed and cut their speed around schools.





Heighington Council Notes

by Margaret Blades Heighington recorded an overall assessment of Very Good, and Redworth Good, in the Britain in Bloom competition. The judges had been impressed with the summer visit when they admired the hanging baskets, gardens and greens. They came across no litter, but effort was required in the Spring

in order to gain marks. A reflective bollard is now in place at the junction to Heighington on the A6072 from Redworth and a reflective

sign is on order. Neighbourhood Watch is working well with several crime ring messages received. Concern was expressed about drugs and any information should be reported directly to the police. A Maple tree is to be planted on East Green behind the George and Dragon, with an expected growth of 30' to 40'. Mrs Nelson, widow of Edgar Nelson (Dentist) who used to live in Heighington had requested to have an Oak tree planted on the low part of West Green. Residents had been asked for their opinions, eight objected. A suggestion the tree be planted in the churchyard and another that Mrs Nelson be asked to reconsider her bequest and donate a seat for the corner of West Green near Buck Square.

The large rock on the corner of Hopelands/Millbank will remain in place. A Planning Application was received for change of use of agricultural land to lay hard-core to facilitate draining, including bounding and landscaping at Direct Worktops Limited, Heighington Parish Council OBJECTED and is

concerned about the drainage as there have been problems in the past with sawdust and contamination in Johnny Best

Consultation by Sedgefield Borough Council of a planning application for an extension involving installation of plant and machinery at George Reynolds Industrial Estate brought an OBJECTION.. Heighington Parish Council insist that a shelter belt be provided before any planning permission is granted as this development is an eyesore and it would be appreciated if the colour of the plant could be changed to a neutral tone. The council is also concerned at the levels of

noise and emissions from this plant. An erection of a two storey side extension, porch and external alterations at The Bay Horse Heighington was

GRANTED. It was stated that kerb stones are loose in Judith Close and Church View and the village seats need varnishing.

Redworth Village Hall needs to improve its facilities, in particular to improve access for the disabled at the rear. The site is to be inspected at the October meeting when it is planned to hold Parish Council meeting. The Redworth Village Hall Committee would like the footpaths map erected on poles on the gravel near the village hall.

Parish Paths Partnership - A report submitted by Mr J Hindley and Mr E Lincoln from the Parish Paths Partnership. - Although the scheme has come to an end they will continue to assist and have offered to be countryside volunteers. They hope that the Parish Council will take an active part in the monitoring, maintenance, improvement and promotion of the paths network.
