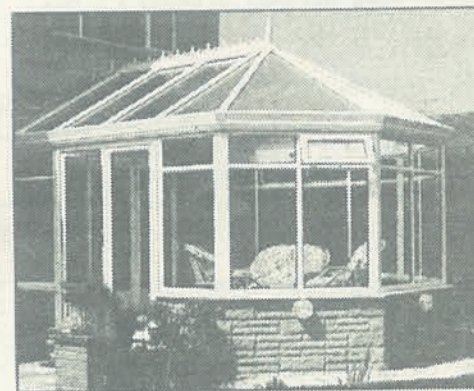

# SOLDIERS FROM AYCLIFFE PEACEKEEPING IN BOSNIA



**Corporal Matthew Clish**

Three soldiers from Newton Aycliffe are playing an important part in keeping the fragile peace in war-shattered Bosnia. They are with the multinational 66,000 strong NATO - Implementation Force. Describing his tour as "excellent" is Corporal Matt Clish, 22. As a telecommunications technician with 206 Squadron, Royal Signals, in the central Bosnian town of Gornji Vakuf, he is responsible for ensuring all the communications in the Divisional Headquarters are working. As well as working hard he is kept busy training for the Army Individual

Boxing Championship when he returns to England at the end of June. He is also planning his wedding in October to Signaller Victoria Sargeant, who is working in the same Squadron. "The most memorable event since I have been out here was when the locals celebrated the end of Ramadan by firing their weapons in the air," Matt, a past pupil of the Avenue Comprehensive School, said. "I will also always remember the happy smiles on children's faces when you give them sweets." Matt's parents, Philip and Dorothy Clish, live in Newton Aycliffe. Another ex-Avenue pupil

working as a radio operator in Bosnia is Signaller Mick Gibson, 23. Based in the northern Bosnian town of Sipovo with 222 Squadron, Headquarters 1 Mechanised Brigade, his job is to make sure that radio links are maintained throughout the Brigade area. This often means driving off to locations miles from anywhere.

"A few months ago I crashed my Landrover," Mick recalled. "I came over the brow of the hill onto sheet ice. I lost control, the Rover went sideways up the embankment, rolled and slid 10 metres on its roof. I didn't have a scratch on me. Where the fuel was leaking out the locals were queuing up with buckets. We let them; it saved wasting it!"

Mick is due home in June. His parents, Les and Teresa Gibson live in Newton Aycliffe. And last but by no means least, Private John Doyle, 24, is a driver and radio operator with 4 General Support Company, based in Kupres. He is one of the unsung heroes of IFOR, often driving for hundreds of miles alone on deserted and sometimes unmade roads to make deliveries or mail runs.

But it is all in a day's work for John who says, "The best thing for me about the tour is getting out and seeing different parts of the country. The worst thing has been the weather, the snow and ice can get a bit scary." He will be reunited with parents John and Mary Doyle when he returns in July.

# KEEP YOUR HANDS OFF PUBLIC POST says our Euro M.P.

Keep our post in public hands is Labour Euro MP Stephen Hughes' message to European Commission President Jacques Santer... and the Governments of the 15 Members Countries of the European Union. Stephen Hughes, Euro MP for Durham and Blaydon, voted in the European Parliament this week against Commission plans to open the Royal Mail and other national postal services to private operators.

Now Stephen Hughes is launching a campaign, with the support of the Communication Workers Union, against the Commission's threat to the excellent and much needed public service provided by the Royal Mail.

Stephen Hughes said "Delivering mail to all homes in all parts of Britain is a public service which only the Royal Mail

will guarantee."

"If the Royal Mail's services are opened up to private operators it would soon cost more to send a letter to Stanhope than to Durham City, and the residents of more remote rural areas like St. John's Chapel could have to collect their post from a central point instead of having it delivered to their door".

He explained "If the Royal Mail lose money to competitors on the profitable parts of their service, then the unprofitable parts - such as rural deliveries and collections - will inevitably suffer."

Stephen Hughes is also concerned about job losses. He said "The Royal Mail employ thousands of men and women in Darlington. Many of these jobs could be at risk if the national postal services are opened up to

competition."

Stephen Hughes will be meeting with Darlington Postal Workers on Friday 17th May.

## Letter to the Editor ANOTHER TOWN AUTHOR'S BOOK PUBLISHED

Dear Sir,  
My first children's book, entitled 'Markie, The Magical Hamster', is due out on Friday May 17th. It runs to about 2,800 words and will be available locally and in Darlington book shops. I got the idea for the book from the name of my daughter's pet hamster, Markie. It is published by Arthur H. Stockwell Ltd., of Ilfracombe, Devon. A 32-page paperback, it costs £1.99. (age range 10-11 years)

Basically, the book tells the story of Markie, who solves other animals' problems with 'Magical Powers' and a bit of twitch of his whiskers! I'm 41 years old and an ex-journalist, born near Ripon.
