THREE MORE TOWN CENTRE SHOPS CLOSE

By the end of the month almost a FIFTH of our Town Centre shops will be vacant, yet the remaining tenants still wait for a reply from their London landlords requesting a meeting to address the problem.

Escom is the latest to pull out with Fabrica closing soon and "Kookies" shutting down this weekend. Some shopkeepers can't wait to be at the end of their lease to get out of the clutches of greedy Landlords. This does not bode well for the future of our Town Centre and the service it should provide to residents of the second largest town in the County.

In this issue we print a small survey taken by children in a school project on our Town Centre. It's findings are very interesting and bear out all the claims made by shopkeepers.

Kookies Cafe has tried very hard to provide a service, and in a town of our size it should be a viable business, but there are just not enough people and passing trade in our Town Centre to make enough money to cover the high rents being demanded.

And it is this main point which the landlords cannot seem to grasp. Shopkeepers cannot pay the asking rent if they do not get enough cash through their tills. People will not use the Town Centre if it does not have a good mix of shops . . . (continued on page 2)

Pupils from Stephenson Way Primary School have been studying the development of Newton Aycliffe as a new

In order to gain some up to date facts and figures they interviewed residents to discover their views regarding our town centre and its amenities.

Once the children returned to school with their questionnaires completed entered the information into a computer database and were able to draw some interesting conclusions:

76% of people questioned felt that the range of shops available in the town is

Nobody at all praised the shopping area.

60% identified Gateway as the shop they visited the

32% of residents in the survey felt that Aycliffe is very short of clothes shops.

The young researchers agreed strongly with this, maintaining that they often end up wearing identical clothes as their friends because of the limited choice available. Other shops identified as lacking included, food shops, gift shops, music shops, and D.I.Y. stores. The children asked people where they go to do any special shopping, if perhaps they have a little

extra money to spend. 64% travel to Darlington. 32% to Bishop Auckland 4% to Newcastle.

They read with interest the article on the front page of Newton News (June 22nd) concerning shonkeeners petitioning landlords to improve the town centre, and felt that the results of their survey highlighted some of the concerns mentioned.

The children enjoyed having the opportunity to question local residents and conducted their interviews with keen interest. They quickly learnt how to enter the facts into a computer database and how to interpret these.

Using "Real" figures which they had compiled themselves certainly made their studies very relevant and informative.
