DISTRICT RESIDENTS OIN UP

People in Sedgefield District are being invited to join up and improve their quality of life in the launch of five local advisory groups for the Health Alliance, starting this month.

The Health Alliance, a partnership between the District Council, the Health Commission and Social Services in the Sedgefield area was officially launched by Tony Blair, MP in November 1994.

'Launching the Local Advisory Groups is the second major step to providing residents in Sedgefield District with a healthier life", said Jane Hartley, Health Alliance Co-Ordinator.

The groups will act as the voice of the public uin identifying what the community needs from the Health Alliance, such as a new drug abuse programme or improving access to services.'

The Health Alliance also promotes a healthy lifestyle and envionrment as a way for residents to achieve a better standard of health.

Spennymoor, Shildon, Newton Aycliffe, Ferryhill and Chilton and Sedgefield and the Trimdons are the five areas where the advisory groups will be set up. They will act as advisers to agencies, responsible for services relating to health and social care, on issues which affect Sedgefield District residents quality of life.

The majority Advisory group members will be local people who have lived or worked in the area for a number of years and know it well. There also representatives from the District Council and Social Services, known as Local Advisers, and GP surgeries who will support community members in their work. ENTERPRISE WORKSHOPS **CELEBRATE 10th** INIVERSARY

Venture which started in the wake of disaster this week celebrates ten years of putting business on the right tracks.

The new Enterprise Workshops were set up in Shildon in 1984 to offset some of the devastating effects of the closure of the town's railway coach building industry

Funded by a partnership between Sedgefield District Council, British Rail, Central Government and the EEC, the New Enterprise Workshops have gone from strength to strength since they officially opened on February 8th, 1985.

The aim was to encourage new industry into the area, and create employment for redundant railway workers.

Offering purpose built accommodation for new enterprises, technical administrative support and business counselling, the Workshops have attracted tenants ranging

designers and light engineers to a firm producing reproduction Victorian toys.

Almost 80% of the companies who started at the workshops have gone on to bigger premises as businesses grew.

Other businesses from the area have also benefited from the services on offer at the Workshops - in the last year alone, they helped 43 new businesses setting up under the Enterprise Allowance scheme.

"Part of the success is a tribute to the team who set up and now, ten years on, are still here running the Workshops" said Manager Gary Chaplin, who is the only member of staff who was not there at the beginning. "Some of the original companies are now well-

known names and have won small business awards. It's not just ourselves who are celebrating our tenth birthday, but all the business people who

have been helped over the decade.'

There are 16 factories, each 500 sq. ft., supported administration services, and a unique feature is the availability of a range of machinery in four communal workshops.

With the help of County Durham TEC, training can be offered and help given with business planning.

Companies which started in the units include Aclet Electronics, winners of a small business award, Fabrication, manufacturers of metal portable cabins, Halls Upholstery, Ken Warne and Russ Sanderson who manufacturers reproduction antique toys.

Plans are underway to expand the facilities available to new companies, with additional training and an open access Information technology facility on the premises.


