## NEIGHBOURS OPPOSE CHANGES TO WALWORTH SCHOOL

Proposals to re-designate Walworth School to facilitate day and residential children with emotional and behavioural difficulties is being opposed by nearby residents.

A petition has been raised and County Councillor Tony Moore is supporting the objectors who were not consulted on the change.

The residents believe a more secluded site is

required to accommodate this category of children and they fear some of the problems at the school could spill over and affect them in the form of vandalism, burglary, assault etc. "We believe Aycliffe

already has its share of

accommodating

problem children with the Aycliffe Centre said a spokesman.

The petition has revealed a real concern regarding the proposed changes and the residents are anxious to enlist as much support as they can in opposition.

Tony More, ar

outspoken critic of the Aycliffe Centre problems has promised full support for the residents who border Walworth School.

"The County Council failed to consult the residents on this matter and I will back them in their protest" said Tony.

Poss tubs and flat irons brought out of the attic for VE Day celebrations are wanted for youngsters in County Durham.

A loans service to schools in the County is on the lookout for items from the 1930s and 1940s to help build up stock.

Durham Learning Resources, part of Durham County Council's Arts Libraries and Museums Department, lends books, pictures, video's and museum objects to nearly all of the County's 400 or so schools.

"Both primary and secondary pupils study the 1940s period but we don't have all that much wartime memorabilia apart from ration books and gas masks," said Peter Burns, Youth Services Manager. "While VE Day celebrations are still current, we

thought it was an opportune time to ask for donations which will help future generations of children in their studies.

"All donations will be fully acknowledged and treated carefully and will form part of the museum collection, " he said. Poss tubs and sticks, packaging from the 1930s and 1940s, biscuit and sweet tins, bars of soap and the like, are on the wanted list.

"We would also appreciate war time memorabilia - tin hats, clothing for adults and children, demob suits and hats - all kinds of things.

"We are not too badly off for domestic equipment but we are prepared to look at anything," he said.

When schools are studying a period, the service sup-plies sets of objects for use in class.

"Its more real than looking at them through a glass case. There are so many things we don't use now flat irons for example.

"The objects demonstrate a completely different way of life and while it is enjoyable for the youngsters, they also pick up lots of different messages about

lifestyle," he said.



She was just four when doctors diagnosed a tumour on her spine, but this plucky youngster has made a full recovery after months of chemotherapy and an operation to remove the growth.

"Louise still wears a back brace but that won't stop her walking on Sunday 11th" said her Mum Kay who will be joining the walk with Louise and a group of friends.
"We all know how important the "Yellow Brick Road" is

to children and as all money raised will go to help build a Road to Health for all the children of the region I appeal to everyone to come to Redworth Hall and join in the

The new Medical Research Centre funded by the Yellow Brick Road is now open and Researchers are tackling the whole range of illnesses which cause death and handicap to children in this region.

A great deal has been achieved in four years and with the help of events like the walk more will be done for our children including the campaign to provide a hospice network of services for children with life threatening illnesses and for their families.

At Redworth Hall there will be a one mile "Munchkin Walk" and a four mile route for others, both are suitable for wheelchairs and buggys.
