Instead of running away, why can't we take a group of representatives from the area and meet the kind


of people who intend living here.

Aycliffe **Nature** Park Report

Those of you who have had the opportunity to visit the Park lately cannot fail to notice that many of the plants, having survived the Winter month either as seeds or in a dormant state are now coming into flower. Even areas which have suffered from the recent attention of a 'fire-raiser' are recollonising

the burnt ground remarkably well.

In the damper areas by the A167 the pink flowers

of ladies smock are to very noticeable. This plant is also known as cuckoo flower as it is supposed to start flowering around the time of the arrival of the first cuckoo! As usual at this time of year, cowslips are flowering all over the Park. These plants are becoming quite scarce in some places but seem to find this area to their liking and they are growing on most of the roadside verges.

In the woods we have a very good display of common dog violets and barren strawberry. It is amazing the way plants vary from year to year. Last year, although these plants were present, it was quite difficult to find them, this year it is difficult

Another fairly showy plant which can be found in the more overgrown areas is the greater stitchwort. This plant which scrambles around amongst the other vegetation has fairly large white flowers. The name stitchwort comes from an old remedy for the pain in the side which is known as a stitch.

Apparently, one took a tumbler of wine, ground up greater stitchwort and acorns in it and then drank the resultant mixture! Another use for the plant resulted from the so called Doctrine of signatures. It was believed that God had put plants on earth for the benefit of mankind and that He indicated with a sign the use He intended us to make of them. Greater Stitchwort has very brittle stems therefore, according to the rather strange logic of the time, it must be intended for curing broken bones!!!

How this was done, I have no idea. The pear tree beside the pond has just finished flowering but our two apple trees are now looking quite attractive as are the flowers on the goat willow. Actually the flowers on this last named species are insignificant and the attractive appearance is due to the yellow pollen bearing stamens (the male part of the

On a recent visit to the park I identified 35 species of planting flower, although some, such as the grasses, hedges, rushes etc, need searching for, so there is plenty to see. There are signs that the common spotted orchids are starting to spring into life. We have so many of them on the site that they really are spectacular when in flower.

The birds are making quite a racket as they go about rearing another generation. Some of these are very easily indentifiable, others are less easy and I am certainly not qualified to accurately identify birds from their song alone. Even an untrained ear however is able to distinguish a good many different kinds of song. We seem to have about 15-20 different birds on the site at the moment although this figure will vary considerably as summer visitors arrive.

The life in the pond has been seriously affected by the fact that some misguided, ignorant or malicious person has introduced large numbers of fish into it. Some of these fish are quite large, there is insufficient food for them and consequently anything which even looks like food including spawn from frogs, toads and newts, is being consumed. Dragon-fly larvae etc, have very little chance of survival unless we can get the fish out. Over the next few weeks we can expect to see considerable changes as the Park reacts to the (hopefully) warmer weather and it is well worth while making the effort to visit it occasionally, hopefully I will meet some of you down there from time to time.

In reply to the neighbours of Walworth School who suggest it is too near residential property.


May I remind them that the school was on a secluded site before they started to build the houses they now live in. I used to live in Cumbrian Place and the residents there had no problems with




