S.D.C. **APOLOGISE OVER** RUBBISH REMOVAL

CARING Sedgefield District Council has confirmed that it is happy to take away large amounts of rubbish and unwanted household goods free from any home in the district - even if it means going into someone's garage, in certain cases.

There has been concern that Council employees wouldn't enter garages or sheds to remove unwanted furniture and large items of rubbish from the elderly.

The Council is grateful to one lady who highlighted a case in last week's "Newton News". A misunderstanding meant that her rubbish wasn't removed, the Council said that in future that shouldn't be the case and it has apologised for the misunderstanding and her rubbish has now been disposed of. Sedgefield District Council's Technical Officer, Bruce Adams, said that in the past staff had been wary of going into people's houses, but says there is no question of the elderly or infirm being told to bring large items into the streets themselves.

"If it's near the front of the garage and we have the householder's permission, and they are able to watch, we are happy to go in and pick up any large items" said Mr. Adams.

I would like all decent people in Aycliffe who are sick of having their property and belongings vandalised or stolen to be more observant and report on those who steal and damage.


Did a pot of marigolds suddenly appear in your neighbour's garden on Tuesday, this week?

I have just had a meeting with Mr. Taylor the Manager of Aycliffe Sewage Works when we discussed the awful smells coming from the plant.

The smells are so bad you can almost taste it! The Village people and workers on Aycliffe Industrial Estate are constantly complaining of the foul odour.

I was informed the smell is due to a breakdown at the plant and no assurances can be given that it won't happen in the future.

He puts the blame on pumps and pipes which are now 23 years old and in urgent need of replacement.

The Manager has requested Northumbria Water Authority replace the worn out equipment and is awaiting a reply.

As one of the highest rated areas I hope it won't be too long before the new equipment is installed and the smells eradicated.

They have just announced an enormous increase in profit and they need to spend some of it at Aycliffe. I will continue to press

our case in the interests of everyone living and working in the vicinity.

This in fact only applies to the Newcastle Walk as the Redworth Hall one begins at 2


However those walkers who turn up at 10.30 am at Redworth will be able to start their walk as the Rotary Club have made hasty plans to accommodate them.





The peripheral Blood stem Cell Harvest is a new method by which the Doctors hope to improve the treatment for several common types of cancer. It is similar to a bone marrow transplant, but is safer, easier and more useful to pa-

Most drugs used in the treatment of cancer damage the bone marrow, so doctors cannot always give a high enough dose to kill the cancer.

Bone marrow produces red and white blood cells also platelets, which are necessary for life, but it also produces

stem cells. These produce all types of cells found in the blood. enough to restore bone marrow should it be damaged by anti cancer

The procedure information tells us it is no more painful than a blood donation. Once the stem cells are stored patients can be treated with several courses of intensive chemotherapy. After each course some of their own cells can then be given back to restore their bone marrow.

The running cost of the unit is estimated at £100,000 per year.






