"£2000 FINE FOR DOGS WITHOUT I.D. DISCS"

N.A.S.S.L.
REPLY TO S.D.C.

Dear Sir

Deerness Kennels are used by most Councils in Co. Durham and these are the Councils who are unable or unwilling to attract a charity committed to a non-district policy for unwanted, stray or abandoned dogs such as operated by the Canine Defence League in Darlington on behalf of Darlington Borough Council and Stockton Borough Council.

In regard to the 10,000 dog tags supplied by SDC I would like to know the method used to advertise this serve as I have not seen it promoted in 'Newton News' or any other local paper including 'Inform', or posted in rent offices. Cllr Waters stated in last week's 'Newton News' that he trusted his letter "clears up any misunderstanding" - the misunderstandings all belong to the Council as illustrated in a letter I received from the Chief Environmental Health Officer, dated 17th February 1987 and I quote "There is no legal obligation upon owners requiring identification discs to be worn by their animals". SDC were ignorant of the law on the 17th February 1987, although the 'Control of Dogs Order' dates back to 1930. Can the informed Councillor tell Newton News readers how many prosecutions the Council have brought to date, bearing in mind the maximum penalty is a fine of £2000 for not having ID on a dog? N.A.S.S.L. have recently dealt with a Mrs Porter of Guthrum Place, Newton Aycliffe who visited Deerness Kennels on the 5th July and took possession of a cross-breed puppy having paid the fee of £28.30.

"ENFORCEMENT OF DOG IDENTITY REQUIRED"

The following day she rang her veterinary surgeon because of her concern for the puppy. She tells us the puppy was in a very bad state with severe diarrhoea and very lethargic. She then rang the Council describing the condition of the puppy, to no avail, they were not interested. Cllr Waters claims that the Council provides a number of services for injured or sick dogs obviously this puppy was not one of them. The R.S.P.C.A. and N.A.S.S.L. jointly paid £60 towards the veterinary treatment. When Mrs Porter collected the puppy from the S.D.C. approved Deerness Kennels it was laid on a concrete floor with no bedding and no water bowl in evidence. Cllr Waters stated "The

District councils will write to the new owner again giving advice on dog ownership and the benefits of neutering". To date, six weeks later, no such letter has been received by Mrs Porter. It seems a pity that a Council committed to doing "legal duty" could not have promoted their service better at venues like the Great Aycliffe Show over the past fourteen years. The case of Mrs Porter is not an isolated one, we have on file the names and addresses of a number of people who have taken dogs from Deerness Kennels and had no approach from the council in respect of identification or spaying and neutering. The poop scoop scheme, although useful, is only cosmetic. All the animals coming out of this establishment, certainly bitches, should be spayed. The council officials should check on the owners that this has been carried out subject to veterinary advice. This Charity would be willing to help with the financial cost of such a programme. We need a registration, enforcement of the identity laws, and restriction on breeding - Fewer dogs, cleaner streets. R. Mackinlay N.A.S.S.L.

MOTORISTS RECEIVE FREE HELP WITH INSURANCE COMPANIES ON PROBLEM CLAIMS

Good news at long last for Motorists in Newton Aycliffe having problems with their insurance company. A new pioneering organisation called the **Vehicle Valuation Bureau** has launched a free help service to assist anyone suffering at the hands of their insurance company following car theft or severe accident damage.

The launch of the VVB's free service follows years of public dismay over insurance company procedure when handling 'write off' claims. Often the most concerning side-effect of a car's theft or involvement in a severe accident is the behaviour of an insurance company. Unrealistically low trade or auction prices are commonly offered and the claim is dragged on for prolonged periods. Many people are all too often left without transportation for the whole period and are forced to accept prices which are not enough to replace their car with one of similar age, let alone condition.

The main aims of the VVB therefore are to assist everyone to receive a fair 'write off' price from their insurance company and as quickly as possible. Initially they provide a Help Pack which has been designed by legal experts. It answers the numerous questions many people have. It also acts as a guide through the often necessary and prolonged negotiations with an insurance company and includes sample draft letters.

To ensure everyone realises what is a fair price to accept, the VVB also supplies professional and totally independent valuations of cars being 'written off'. These valuations are not based upon the lowest possible trade or auction price, but on the actual amount required to replace a car with one of similar age, mileage and condition from a reputable garage. The actual valuations are on an official valuation certificate and can be used as further evidence to prove a car's value to an insurance company.

As Dennis Birkett from the VVB explains, "We are not interested in the minimum you can buy a similar car for. Our valuations are unbiased and based on the amount someone would need in order to replace their car with an identical one. Not the cheapest possible price someone in the trade could buy one for at an auction. Should anyone dispute an insurance company offer our Help Pack will take them all the way through the most effective way of negotiating the right price, even down to sample letters."

The VVB has identified numerous sharp practises employed by many insurance companies to minimise their payouts. They claim that different companies do vary in their treatment but that on the whole policy holders are not getting a fair deal. Dennis added, "It is disappointing that so many people are dissatisfied with their insurance company. We refer new cases of sharp practise to our legal experts far to often, in order to keep our Help Packs up to date and relevant. As far as valuations go it is indeed a rarity to find an insurance company offering a fair price initially. The tragedy here lies with those people who do not know that they can argue. With us around the aim is to make sure that all those being treated unfairly do argue and do so successfully. Our Help Packs and Valuation Certificates provide all the information and advice needed."






