DO WE NEED MORE GREEN FIELD SITES FOR INDUSTRY?

Countryside spoilt for Industrial expansion

Readers who take the "Northern Echo" may have noticed a District Council notice last week advertising the proposed change of Whitworth Farm's land to Industrial and Commercial use.

We print the information so that ALL concerned in the area are duly notified that they may make representations or call at the Council Offices at Green Lane, Spennymoor to see the outline plans. Full reports on the proposals including the environmental impact are also available for those who are interested. This project has been part of the industrial expansion planned at

Heighington Lane for a few years, but some people are asking if it is necessary considering the vacant land and empty factories still available on existing sites at Aycliffe. Industrial progress is important and jobs are vital, but is this only obtainable by the steady spread onto green field sites? We have seen Fujitsu take a large chunk of farmland and just down the road towards the AIM another green site is being developed for Motorway Services much to the annoyance of our neighbours whose boundary it faces. The Darlington Borough Council have made clear their objections. Someone should give reasons why we need to encroach further into the countryside. Someone, in the corridors of power, should justify the decisions taken so that we can begin to understand.

It is just not enough to place a Public Notice in a newspaper to say the plans and reports can be seen at the Council Offices. People should be fully informed by all and any means possible. We offer our columns, free, for that purpose!

EXAM RESULTS are in and whether you've excelled beyond your wildest dreams or simply haven't achieved your expected grades - you might be wondering what to do next.

For those looking for opportunities for a year out, or college placement 'Volunteering for a Better Career' contains a list of over 60 current vacancies around the country for BTCV volunteer officers. After spending between six months to a year at a BTCV office, combining training with work experience, many volunteer officers move on to paid employment with BTCV, other organisations, or go on to further studies.

VOLUNTEER BUREAU MUST SECURE MAJOR GRANT OF £17,000 PER ANNUM

SINCE THE town's Volunteer Bureau fund-raising appeal started in June, donations amounting to £2,600 have been received from Trusts, local businesses and individuals. Rosemary, who is employed as temporary Fund-Raiser said "We are very pleased so far, but we still have a long way to go. It is vital that we secure core funding. We will not be reopening until the Bureau's work is supported by a major grant of at least £17,000 per annum. Two major grant applications have now been submitted and are being considered. We should know the outcome of both by the end of October".

Rosemary is also preparing an application for a grant to set up a long needed Gardening/Decorating Service for the elderly. This would be a separate project managed by the Volunteer Bureau. Unfortunately, this grant will not be awarded unless evi-

dence can be shown that the Volunteer Bureau has secure funding. Rosemary said "When the Bureau was open, we were inundated with requests for assistance with gardening and decorating tasks. We therefore know this is a gap in community services and I am fairly confident our application would be seriously considered. However, I cannot submit it until the outcome of our other bids are known".

Another setback is that Rosemary's temporary employment will have to be terminated very soon. Most of the money she has already raised, cannot be used to continue her employment and the Bureau's other funds are getting low. The Management Committee has applied to the Charities Aid Foundation Trust for a 'crisis grant' to extend her post for a further two months.

Letter to the Editor "EACH CHARITY SHOP COSTS THE COUNCIL, AND US, £5,000"

Dear Sir,
Your article in last week's paper in which Mr. Ken Dunning of "Scope" attacked me for an earlier letter of mine, prompted me to obtain their published accounts for 93/94. I said Scope had assets of £35 million and Mr. Dunning said they were less than 10% of that. The actual figure of fixed assets is £34.3 million

Income for that year was £78,092,000 and Mr. Dunning says all donated money is spent on people suffering with cerebral palsy, but £37,499,000 was paid to staff. I could go on quoting figures, but it was never my intention to attack Scope, merely to point out that, like other charity shops, which we once considered 'poor relations' on the High Street, have become rich uncles who still accept hand-outs from their less wealthy nieces and nephews. Every charity shop that opens in our town centre (another one has just applied) costs the Council and us, £5,000 in lost rates. This means a poorer serv-

ice or increased charges, since it is usually the latter other businesses suffer. Dress shops suffer from direct competition particularly those selling second-hand wear and all shops are affected by the willingness of charities to pay the high rents asked by the Landlords. This rent level then becomes the benchmark for all. If the charities behave like the big businesses they are, throwing money at rented premises to bring them up to the corporate image, then they should also be treated that way - without any subsidies. As it is, the Council Tax of Newton Aycliffe residents is indirectly increasing the assets of the Landlords. The SDC could start by charging the 20% rates they are allowed to, any other change has to come from central Government. Yours faithfully, Harry Taylor.
Ed: We spoke to Area Manager Ken Dunning who said the £35 million in 'fixed assets' was correct, but Mr. Taylor implied Scope had cash reserves of that amount, which was untrue.

RETAILERS SHOW INTEREST IN S.D.C.'s PLAN TO DEVELOP DISCOUNT FOODSTORE

A NUMBER of retailers have expressed interest in developing vacant sites in Spennymoor Town Centre to build a new discount foodstore. New shopping development is being encouraged following Sedgefield District Council's recent investment to enhance the centre of the town. The District Council has published a "Planning Requirements State-

ment", to highlight two potential development sites, one to the rear of the High Street, including vacant land, car parks and an existing shop. The other has a direct frontage with the High Street, between Church Street and Thomas Street. Sedgefield District Council believes the proposal for a new discount foodstore will complement existing retail facilities,

make good use of vacant land and widen choice for shoppers. Development must be in keeping with the existing town centre buildings and be integrated with the High Street shopping area. Sedgefield District Council's "Planning Requirements Statement" looks at these and other aspects including parking, access, and the general appearance of any new development. Street Sign Obstructs Motorist's Vision

MOTORISTS USING Sandown Drive, at Woodham are complaining about the sign at the junction of Woodham Way which is sited wrongly.

The sign is placed at eye level, obstructing motorists view of traffic travelling on Woodham Way, forcing them to "nose" into the busy road in order to see what is coming.

"It needs to be brought back a few yards to allow cars to join Woodham Way safely", said a spokesperson.

Help For Disabled Workers

WHEN FREDA Dunnington's health deteriorated there was a fear that she would lose her job with Spennymoor-based Thorn Lighting. Help from the Employment Service's Placement Assessment and Counselling Team (PACT) in Durham has led to her being able to continue in full-time employment.

Although the work that she was expected to carry out is not physically over demanding, there is a need for great manual dexterity and the lifting of small lighting units can put some strain on the upper body over a period of time.

Freda, who suffers from Kyphosis (curvature of the spine) together with eye, lung, and heart problems, was assessed by an occupational nurse to see if she would qualify for assistance under the Supported Employment Programme. Through this programme, employers are able to assess what percentage output of a particular job an employee can handle and will pay them for that level of productivity. The balance of the salary is then made up by contributions from a local funding provider who, in turn, is able to claim this money back from the government.

"Following her assessment by the Occupational Nurse, Freda was thought to be able to cope with about 72 per cent of the work of her colleagues. Her employers agreed to this and so she was able to continue in her employment. The Supported Employment Programme from the Employment Service is an excellent scheme that can have a real therapeutic as well as financial benefit for people such as Freda", he said.
