## Newtonian Returns to Open an Aycliffe Brewery



Nick Smith, a Science graduate and teacher, has

moved into premises behind the Blue Bridge Centre in Newton Aycliffe, trading as "The Steam Machine Brewing Company". The chemistry teacher left the classroom to open his new business and brew his own craft beer.

Former Newtonian Nick, and his wife Gulen, returned to live in Aycliffe Village, and have invested their savings helped with a start-up loan from Virgin. The new brewery will produce quality keg beer, currently very popular throughout the country.

The enthusiastic couple have already made great progress building up their client base of local pubs and restaurants. Nick spent two years perfecting his recipe by experimenting with different kinds of hops obtained locally and abroad.

### LIGHTING REDUCTION

The Leader of the Town Council, Bob Fleming, thought he had won a victory over the removal of A167 lights by Durham County Council. He negotiated a deal whereby they will stay and become the responsibility of our Council when ratified. However the sting in the

tail is another proposal, under the same policy, to remove lights within the town itself along a section of Burnhill Way, north of the Cobblers Hall roundabout. The Street Lighting Energy Reduction Project approved in 2012 agreed the removal of 7,000 street lights not required by British Standards where it is safe to do so. Technical Services intend to remove 11 street lights where Burnhill Way runs alongside Agnew North Plantation.

Residents are asked to comment if they feel there is a safety issue and along with the A167 lights will be considered by the Town Council Environment Committee at their meeting on Wednesday 1st July at 7.15pm.

Members of the public are invited to attend the Council Meeting at their offices on School Aycliffe Lane.

This is a cost saving exercise by the County Council who believe the removal of lights complies with British Standards and will not compromise road safety.

The question everyone asks is why are the lights there in the first place?

## Town Student Receives Prestigious Award

Woodham student, Lillie Bell, has received the Durham schools' Physicist of the Year Award at an awards ceremony at Durham University. The awards ceremony, which took place on Tuesday night, recognises the talent of the most promising young physicists in year 10 or year 12 in schools in the Durham area, and was presented by Professor Carlos Frenk of the Institute for Computational Cosmology.



Lillie's physics teacher at Woodham, Phil Dennis, said "Lillie demonstrates not only a great passion for physics, but also great skill and dedication. She has developed her understanding of core concepts and been able to apply them well outside of their original contexts. In doing so, she shows an aptitude for abstract thinking, coupled with mathematical fluency which is beyond her years. I hope she will be a great asset to the physics community in years to come." This is the second year in a row that a Woodham student has won this award. Last year Daniel Hoare (now taking his GCSEs in year 11) was the winner.  
The Durham Schools' Physicist of the Year Award not only recognises the talent of young physics students, but also qualifies them to apply for the generous Ogden Scholarships which pay towards the university fees of the most promising physicists of the future.


